<b>SAMU General Membership Fee</b>	SAMU assesses a membership fee to students taking credit-based post-secondary programming on a per credit basis. This fee helps fund The SAMU Membership fee itself is a mandatory fee but helps fund the many student resources we provide, such as Breakfast Club, the Pantry, StressLess, Peer Support, Study Buddies, our SAMU Student Advocacy Centre, the many events that happen throughout the year and much more. <b>SAMU Secondary Membership Fee</b>	Students in Preparation for University and College and English as a Second Language are taking secondary level courses and are primarily funded by the provincial government. The government places a cap on fees that may be assessed to funded students. <b>SAMU Building Levy Fee</b>	This fee comes from a referendum we had a few years back on the prospect of a SAMU building and a part of the referendum was a \$35 mandatory fee that is paid by students to fund the building. The referendum was passed with a 77% acceptance rate. This fee goes towards repaying the loan we took out to build the building.
