

## SPRING STUDENT SURVEY - 2026

### OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

March 16, 2025

**This contest is open to Canadian Residents, excluding Quebec, who are currently enrolled in MacEwan University and is governed by Canadian law.**

#### 1. **CONTEST PERIOD:**

This contest opens at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, March 16, 2026, and closes at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, April 6, 2026. (the “Eligibility Period”). Participants must complete the SAMU Spring Student Survey in its entirety within the Eligibility Period to be eligible to receive a prize.

#### 2. **ELIGIBILITY:**

This contest is open to Canadian and foreign students attending MacEwan University in Canada who are the age of majority in their province of residence, excluding Quebec residents (the “Entrants”). Entrants must be a current full-time or part-time MacEwan student enrolled in the 2025 – 2026 school year. The contest is sponsored by the Students’ Association of MacEwan University (SAMU) (the “**Sponsor**”). Employees of SAMU and MacEwan University, including faculty members, are not eligible to enter this contest.

#### 3. **HOW TO ENTER:**

No purchase necessary. Only one entry per student. Entrants may enter the draw anytime within the Eligibility Period.

Entrants are eligible to enter the Contest once within the Eligibility Period. To enter, Entrants must complete the SAMU Spring Student Survey (the “**Survey**”) within the Eligibility Period. At the end of the survey, students will have the option to fill out an additional section that requests their contact information. For a completed Survey to be considered an Entry, students must provide their contact information at the end of the Survey (the “**Entry**”). By submitting their Entry, all Entrants are agreeing to the terms and conditions of the contest and these Official Contest Rules and Regulations (the “**Rules**”).

#### 4. **HOW TO WIN:**

Winners will be selected by random draw on April 7, 2026 (“**Draw Date**”), from among all eligible Entries received during the Contest Period. The Early Bird prize winner will be selected by random draw on April 2, 2026 (“**Early Bird Draw Date**”, collectively “**Draw Dates**”) from all eligible Entries received during the Early Bird Contest Period. The winner of

the Early Bird Contest will remain eligible for the other prize draws including the Grand Prize. Only one prize is permitted per person with the exception of the Early Bird prize winner. The Winners will be contacted by email and/or phone. Before being declared Winners, the selected entrants will be required to correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question without mechanical or other aid and sign a Prize Declaration and Release form.

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible Entries received during the Eligibility Period. The Sponsor will make three (3) attempts to contact the Winners by email and/or telephone (using the information provided at the time of entry) from the time the Draw is made through to April 20, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. local time.

If the selected Entrant(s) cannot be contacted or have not responded after three tries through email and/or phone by April 20, 2026 at 12:00 p.m., or there is a return of any notification as undeliverable; then selected Entrant(s) will be disqualified and the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion and subject to time constraints, to randomly select an alternate eligible Entrant(s) from among the remaining eligible Entries.

5. All Entries are subject to verification. The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Sponsor) to participate in this Contest. Failure to provide such proof in a timely manner may result in disqualification.

6. **PRIZES:**

The total value of the prizes is \$2,000.00. All prizes except the Grand Prizes will be presented in the form of digital gift card(s) as awarded by the Sponsor. Prizes, except the Grand Prizes, will be distributed to the winners by email. The two \$500 Tuition Credit Grand Prizes will be arranged through the Office of the University Registrar at MacEwan University. The Prize value does not include any applicable GST or fees. All prizes must be accepted as awarded. The Sponsor reserves the right to substitute any of the prizes with other prizes of equal or greater value if the Prize cannot be awarded as described for any reason. The Prize is non-transferable and is not redeemable for cash or credit, in whole or in part. The Sponsor will award eight total prizes for a value of \$2,000.00.

The Sponsor requires Winners to sign a Prize Declaration and Release form, including a consent to the Sponsor posting the winner's name and/or photograph on its website or through its social media channels. If a winner fails to return the Prize Declaration and Release form within the time specified by the Sponsor, they will forfeit their prize, at the discretion of the Sponsor, and an alternate winner will be selected from the eligible Entries.
