

Blossom Teapot Quilt:

Finished Size is 14" x 18"

- Press the stitchery and remove all basting threads.
- Use a freezer paper template to trim the stitchery to 9 1/2" square.

Cut:

Inner Border:

2 @ 1" x 9 1/2"

2 @ 1" x 10 1/2"

Outer Border:

2 @ 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

2 @ 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"

Block Spacer Strips:

4 @ 1" x 4 1/2"

Ohio Star Blocks:

3 @ 2 1/2" squares

12 @ 1 1/2" squares

12 @ 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles for flying geese

24 @ 1 1/2" squares for flying geese

Backing 22" x 26"

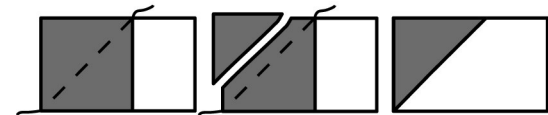
Binding 76" 2 @ 2 1/2" x WOF strips

Add Borders:

- Sew the 1" x 9 1/2" inner borders to the right and left edges of the stitchery. Press SA toward the borders.
- Sew the 1" x 10 1/2" inner borders to the top and bottom. Press.
- Sew the 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" borders to the right and left edges. Press SA toward the borders.
- Sew the 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" borders to the top and bottom. Press.

Make 3 Ohio Star Blocks:

- Make 12 flying geese blocks. Begin by marking the backs of all of the twenty-four 1 1/2" flying geese squares diagonally across the back of the square from corner to corner. This will be your sewing line.
- Place one square RST on the left side a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle. Sew along the marked line. Trim, leaving a 1/4" SA. Press open.



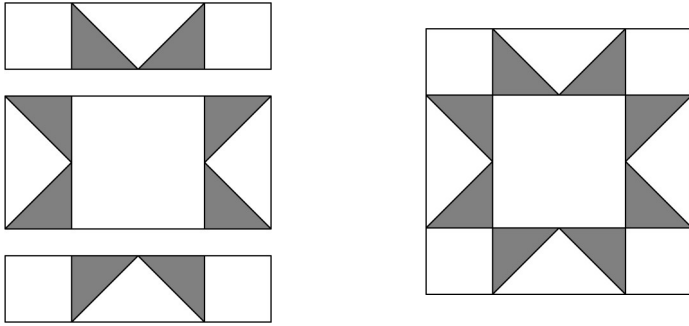
- Place one square RST on the right side the 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle. Sew along the marked line. Trim, leaving a 1/4" SA. Press open.



- Make 12 flying geese.

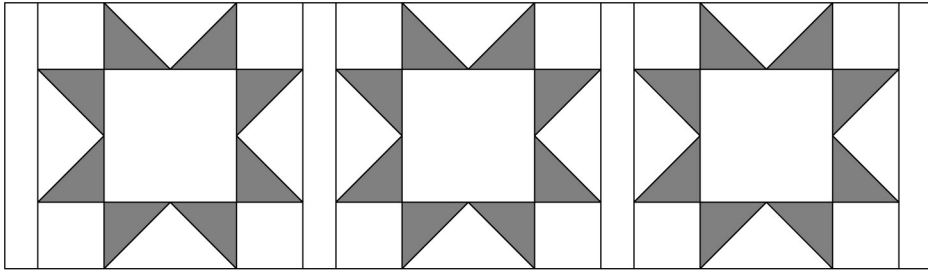
Make Blocks:

- Sew the rows together as shown to make three 4 1/2" blocks. Press open.



Assemble:

- Sew the spacer strips to join the Ohio Star blocks as shown. Press SA's toward the strips.



- Sew the Ohio Star block row to the bottom edge of the bordered stitchery portion.
- Press the SA toward the top border.

- Layer the quilt top, batting and backing.
- Quilt as desired.
- Bind.
