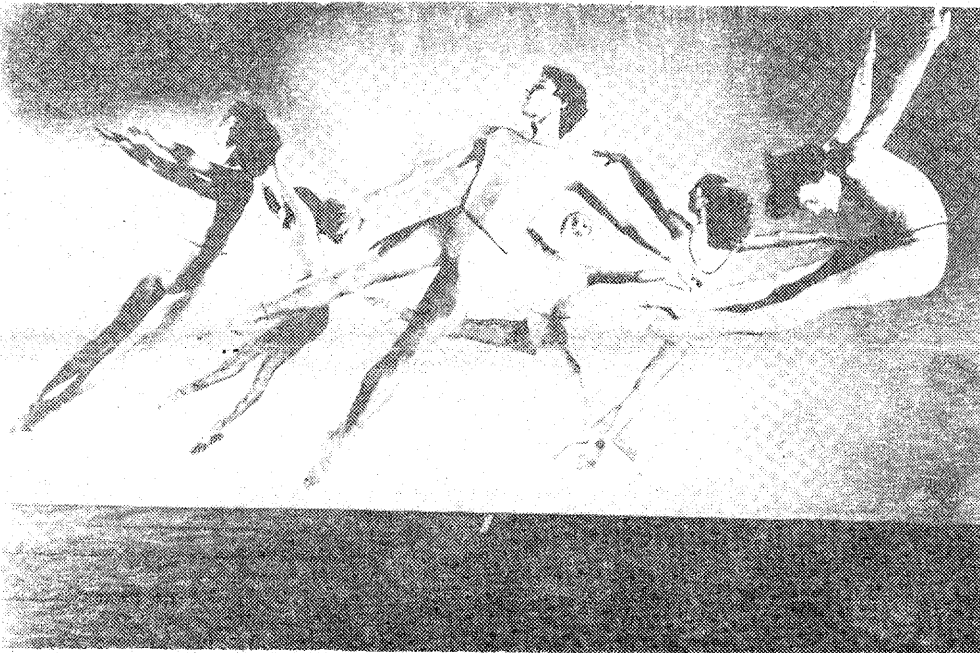

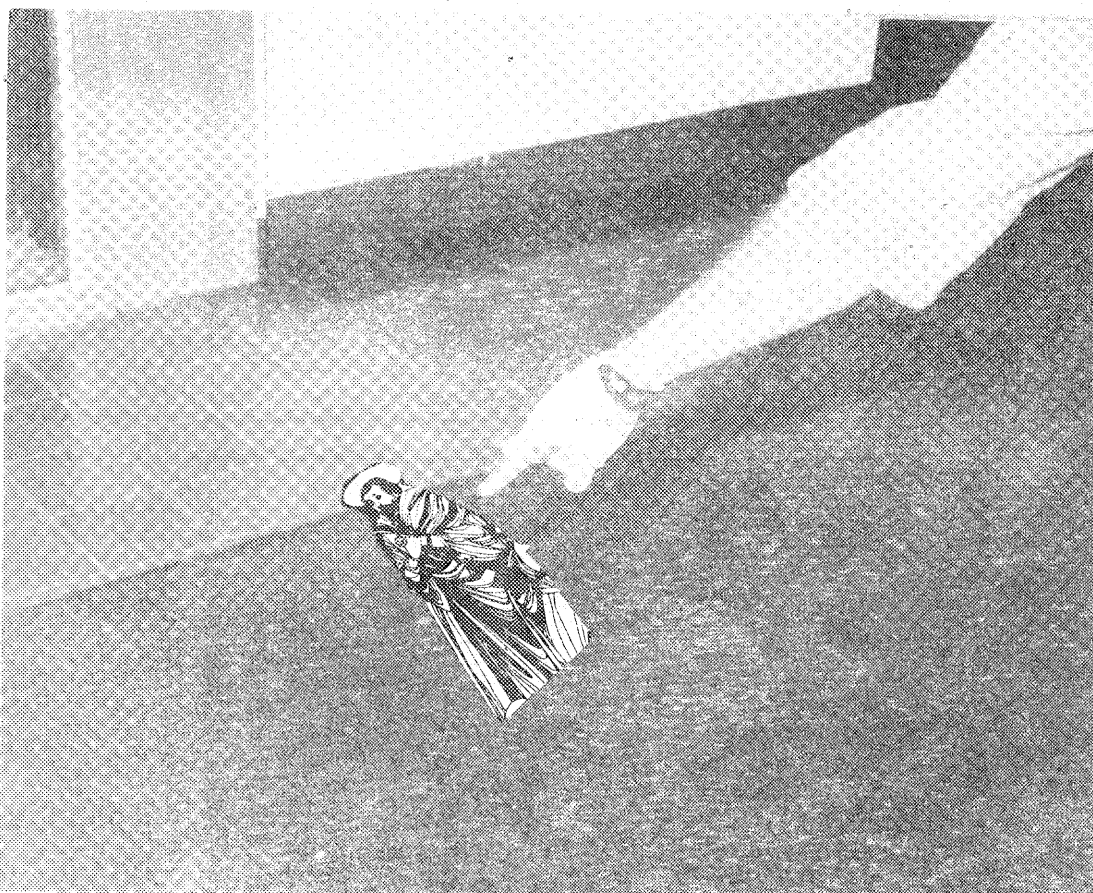

"I couldn't believe it!" said one exasperated fan,

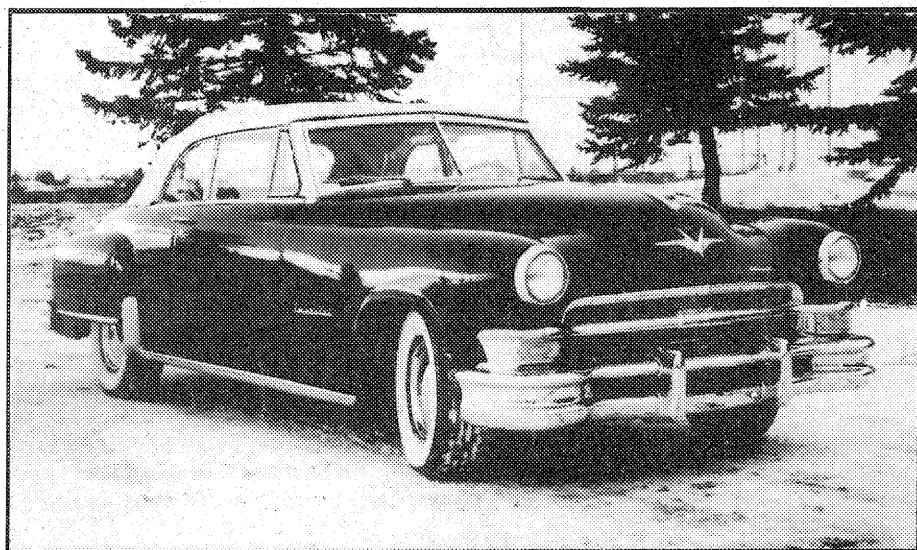
"Margie is everything a Prime Minister should be. She's just sooo lovely and elegant!"
