Demand For Students At Placement Center

The NAIT Placement Centre has more jobs than it can handle. This is good news for students looking for summer, part-time and full-time employment, but it is providing the Placement Centre staff with several difficulties.

The first is space. Although jobs are posted at various locations around campus and are updated regularly to reflect changes, the volume is simply too great to handle.

Jerry Cossitt, Manager of the Placement Centre, compares the heavy load this year with the boom days of the early Eighties. Most of the employers come from the Resource-, Construction-, and Business-/Computer-related industries. As well, service industries have increased their orders over last year, and it is expected that they will continue the incline.

Compared to last year, there is an estimated 60% increase overall with a 77% increase over 1986. In actual numbers, the estimates currently are: 160 full-time, 100+ part-time and summer positions with more expected to arrive. In addition, there are over 200 positions on hold, or awaiting interviews. There also have been more on-campus interviews in 1988 than in the last four years.

According to Cossitt, a number of employers want people immediately and thus have a short closing date (of

five days) on the ad. This means that students can expect a quick interview on these postings, which is advantageous as you know that the employer is not going to be as choosy.

Cossitt attributes the reason for this huge volume to several factors. First is, of course, the strong upturn in the economy. The second is Careers Day, which not only helped students get acquainted with employers, but gave employers an idea of the complexity and diverse function of NAIT. As well, the Placement Centre has been advertising in professional publications throughout Canada, promoting NAIT graduates as a valuable resource.

As for advice on how to obtain a job for the summer, or a more permanent full-time position, Cossitt offers some advice:

- If you feel you meet the qualifications listed in the ad, apply for the position regardless if the job appeals directly to your technology or not.

- Check the boards around NAIT. Some jobs are immediate and the orders there are updated daily.

- Look at more than one source. The NAIT Placement Centre is one agency, but there are the government employment offices, Hire-A-Student (which opens on April 27).

- Do not be wary of taking a STEP position for less money. When they are government positions, STEP can be an excellent way to get your foot in the door for a later full-time position at a higher salary.

- Come to interviews—even those on campus—dressed properly and prepared with a list of references. Most people say "references available upon request" on their resume, but never come prepared to deliver them. Even if the interviewer does not ask for them, have a sheet handy.

- Use reference materials and telephone calls to find out about a company. What does it do? How long has it been in operation? Will it go under soon? All these can be answered by you making discreet inquiries.

- Use friends and contacts to obtain jobs where possible.

With this positive outlook for the Summer 1988, it appears job opportunities are here. It is merely a question of finding the one you are most qualified for.

Body Language

All through high school, I used to sit and yawn when girlfriends/classmates discussed weight loss and diets. I didn't know what a weight problem was - I'd always been active in track at school and in ranch work at home. It wasn't until I finished high school, left home and got into a more leisurely lifestyle that things changed.

Imagine my shock when an "acquaintance" walked up to me one day and bluntly told me "You're fat!" I went home, looked in the mirror and promptly launched into an intense weight-loss program. I cut my food intake by a drastic 75%, took up power walking and floor exercises on a daily and increasing basis - and in one month lost 20 lbs! Ironically, it drew only silence from my acquaintance. I swore that no one would find an occasion to call me fat (or thunder thighs) again.

But then I went to the other extreme. I became anorexic; that is, I ate very little when I ate at all and often I would go for two or three days without eating. I was at 5'5 1/2", about 100 lbs - a sack of bones. Right now, I weigh about 115 lbs and carry about 9% body fat - you can only imagine what I looked like then. Total strangers would come up to me and tell me to "gain some weight"; it made me furious. For two miserable years, I struggled

and starved - and still saw myself as fat when I looked in the mirror.

Things got worse before they got better - but they did, fortunately, get better. I was one of the lucky ones.

I got into aerobic fitness, with which I carried on a love-hate relationship for the first six months, and I gradually developed much healthier eating habits. I gained ten pounds and felt much better for it. I became less hyper and eventually gained another five.

My day no longer falls apart if I step on the weigh scales to find that I've gained a half pound. In fact, my weigh scales are more a bathroom decoration; the fit of my clothes are my guide. I have since then finally absorbed the very real value of eating right and of (aerobic) exercise / being active.

The bottom line is "control your weight, don't let your weight control you" - be proactive, not reactive.

When it comes to diet, exercise and weight, I've done my share of messing up. It's my feeling, in the final analysis, that over-reacting and too little action are each as bad as the other. Perspective is the key. Better to trim down for summer by thinking "exercise" than by thinking "diet."

For the love of life - get active!

Letters to the Editor

Dear Editor:

The amount of attention *The Nugget* has devoted to the recently implemented model for the evaluation of instructors by students is gratifying to see.

In the March 17th issue, however, the second of your two articles, "A Chance to Cut Away Instructional Deadwood," appears to rest on three false assumptions.

First, you imply that instructor evaluation is just now beginning at NAIT. Such evaluation has always existed at the Institute: the demonstration of satisfactory performance is a condition of continued employment for instructors. What is new is a process for consistent, system-wide evaluation of instructors by students. Such process of evaluation acknowledges the view that students have a valid contribution to make to performance appraisal. In the second place, your editorial implies that this part of the evaluation would be sufficient grounds to "eliminate the incompetent ones." Not so: the evaluation by students is only a component in the process for the use of the instructor and the program head.

Finally, your emphasis upon elimination and "chopping" is contrary to the spirit of this initiative. If I may quote from the Academic Council minutes of the January 18th meeting, at which the evaluation model was approved, "It was emphasized...that the primary objective was the improvement of instruction; the secondary objective, the evaluation of instructors." (item 39.2.1)

Thank you for allowing me to clarify the matter. As noted in my opening, *The Nugget* is to be commended for its coverage of important matters at NAIT. Your staff has done one of the better jobs at this of any newspaper staff during my term at the Institute.

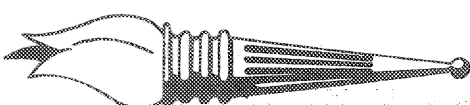

Show Some Restraint

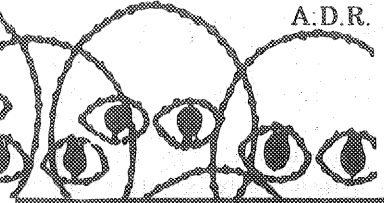
Well I am sure that by now most of you will have participated in the Instructor Evaluation Program.

Safety Alert -- Eyes Beware

Following an eye injury to a racquetball player who was wearing Hardex lenses in his glasses, Dr. Grant--Eye specialist of the R.A. Retinal Unit--states he sees four serious eye injuries a week from this sport.

His recommendations are:

1. Glass and Hardex lenses should be banned from the courts.
2. All players should wear C.S.A. (approved) sports frames with closed polycarbonate lenses (he recommends BAUSCH & LOMB).
3. If players require glasses

they should:

- A. Have contact lenses with C.S.A. sports frames.
- B. Have sports frames made up with their prescription lenses.
- C. At the very minimum if they cannot afford the above, glasses with plastic lenses in very strong frames. (C.S.A. approved Safety Frames are fairly cheap and strong.)

Hale Optical in Kingsway Garden Mall will give NAIT Staff and Students a 15% discount for glasses, etc.

WHERE TO FIND

Job Leads

J. Michael Farr



Most job seekers use a traditional approach when looking for jobs. The methods they use include:

- Answering want ads
- Filling out applications in personnel offices
- Sending out resumes
- Looking for leads at the local state employment agency (often called the "unemployment" office)

Some people — about one third — do get jobs using these traditional methods. The other two thirds don't.

The Hidden Job Market

Most jobs are never advertised. In fact, as many as 85% of all jobs are not. Traditional job search methods overlook most available jobs and many of the best ones. Given that, here are some non-traditional job search methods to uncover the hidden job market.

Friends and Relatives:

Probably the best source of job leads available. List all your relatives, then the people who you have been friendly with and contact them directly. Tell them what kind of job you want and what skills and other qualifications you have to offer. About 18% of all people find their jobs this way.

Acquaintances:

These are people who you don't know well but who you've had some contact with or have something in common. Ex-classmates, people you used to work with, neighbors and fellow church members are some examples. List as many names as possible. Contact each one and ask for his/her help in thinking of employers who might need someone with your skills and experience.

Walk Right In:

Even without an appointment, you can usually ask for the person in charge and get to them with no problem. This seems more common for small organizations where there are fewer people between reception and the boss to screen you out.

Let Your Fingers Do The Walking:

The Yellow Pages lists virtually all organizations that hire people. Use the index to identify types of organizations that you might be interested in and contact each one. Ask to speak to the person who is most likely to supervise you in that organization. Avoid personnel departments, if possible. Introduce yourself, mention the position you seek followed by your key skills and experience. Your objective is to set up an interview or, failing that, to get a referral.

Go To Small Organizations:

Most people work in businesses and organizations considered small (less than 50 employees). They are excellent places to gain experience and make quicker advancements. Don't overlook them.

Use Special Services:

If you have access to a school or other placement counselor, he/she can be an excellent source of referrals. Check into any community programs to help you find a job. Begin with the telephone listings under local government agencies and ask for what's available. If they don't know, ask who else might.

Traditional Methods

Want Ads:

Read the want ads but do not depend on them. About 14% of all people find their jobs here, so it is worth some time. Sunday's and Wednesday's papers have the most ads. Read them in the evening and follow up on anything interesting but realize that a lot of other people will be doing the same thing. The competition is fierce.

Private Employment Agencies:

Unless the employer pays the fee, expect to pay up to 15% (or more) of your first year's salary. That is a lot of money for work you can usually do yourself. Consider using them if your skills are highly sought after or if you are presently employed and have little time available to look yourself. Only one out of 20 people who use agencies get jobs from them.

State Employment Agencies:

They don't charge a fee, but only 5% of all people get jobs this way. In most areas, they will not know of 90% or more of the jobs available; however, a weekly visit is worthwhile. Get on friendly terms with an employment counselor and ask to see that one each time. This will help him/her think of you when a job lead comes through that fits.

Personnel Offices:

They are found mostly in larger organizations and their job is to screen you out. Try instead to get directly to the person who would supervise you. Sometimes personnel is unavoidable. If you do use them, go out of your way to make yourself memorable.

Resumes:

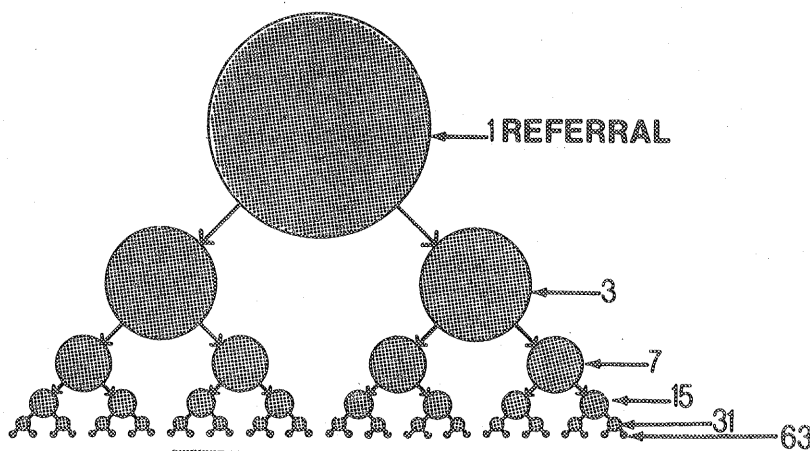
Sending out resumes hoping one lands on some interested person's desk is likely to be a waste of time and stamps. A resume can be a useful tool once you've made contact with a potential employer but it is often unnecessary.

Follow Up

Send a simple, sincere thank you note to all people who help you in your job search: friends, people who interview you, people who gave you a referral — anyone. It is a nice touch and they will be far more likely to remember you later!

You should follow up with all your employer contacts every one or two weeks. Create a reminder system for this using 3 x 5 cards arranged by follow up date.

These are some brief tips to find job leads that I hope will help. Do realize though, that finding a job is a job. Plan to spend at least 25 hours a week at it and try to get two interviews a day. It is possible. Good luck!



Get Referrals:

Whenever you talk to someone in your job search, always ask them if they know of someone else you can talk to who might:

- have a job opening in your field, or
- know of someone else who would.

To get the most out of this method, get at least two referrals from each person you contact. Starting with just one contact, you can develop hundreds, even thousands of contacts using this simple technique.

The NAIT Athletic Program can look back with pride on the 1987-88 season. Although there were disappointments, there was also great success.

In the fall of 1987, the NAIT soccer team became the first ACAC team to win a Canadian Colleges Athletic Association national title. The work of the coaches and the players brought NAIT their second CCAA gold as a major team sport.

In the spring of 1988, NAIT received its second gold of the season when the NAIT women's curling team, skipped by Sherry Lothian, won top honours at the CCAA National Championships in Medicine Hat.

The NAIT men's doubles badminton team also returned with hardware from the nationals. Rick Kosowan and Bruce Clarkson were silver medalists.

The NAIT women's volleyball team became the first women's team from NAIT to make the playoffs. Unfortunately, the powerful Red Deer College Queens eliminated the Oaks in the semi-finals.

The NAIT men's basketball team, which had hopes of a trip to the nationals when the season started, saw their dreams fall short. In the final game of the season, the Oaks lost to Grant MacEwan. The Griffins later went on to win a bronze at the nationals.

The NAIT women's basketball team won the consolation final in the Blue-Gold Classic. Guard Kathy Prochnau also became the all-time leading scorer in ACAC women's basketball.

The NAIT hockey team led by All-Canadian Darren Schmidt finished first in the regular season. An upset playoff series win by the Red Deer College Kings ended the Oaks four year reign as ACAC champions. Red Deer later lost to the team that would bring the national title back to Alberta, the Mount Royal College Cougars.

The teams that are winners usually enjoy themselves and have few conflicts. In 1988-89, it will be interesting to see if a positive, fun attitude will return to some ACAC dressing rooms.

NAIT Ladies Win ACAC Curling Gold

A very confident, determined team skipped by Sherry Lothian captured the Ladies Title at the 1988 ACAC Championships.

A total of seventy-eight games were played in the tournament hosted by Keyano College (Ft. MacMurray) at the beautiful MacDonald Island Curling Club, February 4-7. Grande Prairie won the men's title and Medicine Hat captured the mixed. All these teams represented Alberta in the CCAA National Championships on March 23-26 in Medicine Hat.

The mixed team of Randy Johnson, Carla Bodie, Barry Reid, and Lori Kaupp made it look easy in qualifying out of "A" for the playoffs. They beat Keyano College 13-6, edged CLC 10-9 and GPRC 7-6, and qualified by cruising by GMCC 9-4. They lost their black magic in the playoffs. GPRC beat them 7-3 and GMCC edged them 7-6 for the bronze medal.

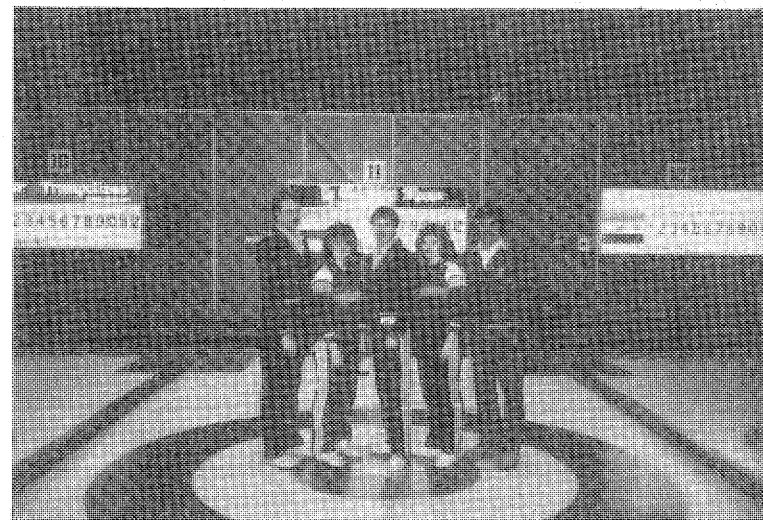
So speaks Lothian--who hails from Taber--as she analyses the misfortune of the team after three dismal losses.
