

Get a Team Together for: the 16th Annual BRIDGE BUILDING CHALLENGE



LAST YEAR'S FUN

The NAIT Building Construction Engineering Technology (B.C.E.T.) is gearing up for its 16th Annual Alberta Bridge Building Challenge on September 24, 1988.

The bridge building competition was originally held in 1964 between Architecture and Civil Engineering. In 1965, the event was opened to all technologies.

"In the next few years, BCET won the competition four or five times" stated Robert Blakeman, a spokesman for the competition. In 1973, BCET was awarded the "Bridge Building Challenge" and has organized the competition

since.

The Bridge Building Challenge consists of teams competing to construct, cross, and dismantle a rope bridge across Whitemud Creek.

The twenty member team is split with 18 members on one side of the creek and two on the other side. A lead rope is used to drag a heavier rope across. The ropes are secured and the 20 members must cross and return. One member must be carried on a stretcher.

No mechanical means or sawed lumber may be used. Time penalties are awarded for touching the water and for piling the ropes wrong.

Practise times will be scheduled one week prior to the event depending on the number of teams entered.

Prizes will be awarded to each member on the team. In addition, the name will be engraved on the Alberta Bridge Building Challenge Cup. There are also awards for the female teams.

The entry fee is \$10.00 per member and includes admission to the race and to the cabaret that follows.

2 Week Loan Material

due date + 4 wks = \$20
due date + 6 wks = \$30

3 Day Loan Material

due date + 6 days = \$10
due date + 12 days = \$20
due date + 18 days = \$30

Instructional Reserves

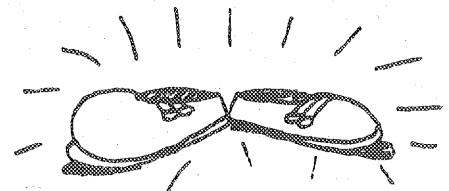
due date + 2 days = \$10

GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR ENVIRONMENTAL RESEARCH

Who may apply?

Any person, institution, corporation, or society may request research funds. The Trust will give preference to private sector applicants, including individuals, for environmental research which might otherwise not get done. The trust will give preference to any applicant who can supply joint funding with industry.

Special recognition will be given to technical research in all aspects of water quality in Alberta. Anyone contemplating an A.E.R.T. application should review the list of similar projects which can be done by consulting the A.E.R.T. annual report, or the Library of Alberta Environment. Applications should involve specific objectives with tangible potential benefits for the Environment. The proposed research should reflect an innovative concept or approach. The need for Research must be demonstrated.

Deadline date for submission of application for grants is October 31, 1988. Early submission is advised. All applications are reviewed upon receipt by the Grants Advisory Committee. Applicants will be notified as to the Board of Trustees' decision by February 1, 1989. Research projects should be planned to start after this date.

In August, the sportsworld was shocked when the Edmonton Oilers traded, (or sold if you prefer) Wayne Gretzky to the Los Angeles Kings.

The trade is over and nothing can be done. Number 99 is now a King. However, Edmonton fans, in an attempt to show their appreciation would like to honour Gretzky by naming something after him.

The true Edmonton sportsfan realizes that naming something after Gretzky at this time is premature. There a number of other individuals more worthy of recognition.

First, most sportsfans fail to realize that without Bill Hunter there would have been no WHA and no Edmonton Oilers. Hunter was the driving force behind the building of Northlands Coliseum. Wild Bill was also one of the keys to the success of the Edmonton Oil Kings.

Second, after being a player with the Edmonton Eskimos, Frank Morris has dedicated his life developing and assisting minor football. Throughout the province, there are a number of untold stories about the generosity of Frank Morris

Third, three players with the Edmonton Eskimos in the 1950's stayed in Edmonton to make this place a better community by becoming leaders in the educational field after their playing careers were over. Rollie Miles, Johnny Bright, and Bob Dean all became school principals and continued to lead by example.

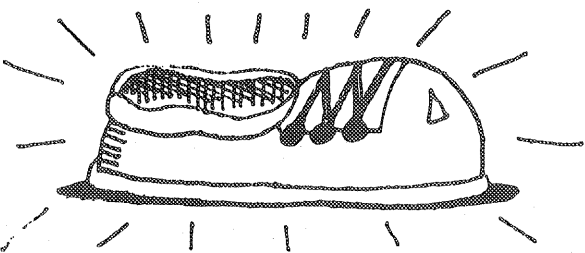
