# Demand for Students at Placement Center

The NAIT Placement Centre has jobs for students. This is good news for students looking for summer, part-time, and full-time employment.

Jobs are posted at various locations around campus and are updated regularly to reflect changes. The last issue of the Career Section will be May 11.

Jerry Cossitt, Manager of the Placement Centre, compares the heavy load this year with the boom days of the early Eighties. Most of the employers come from the Resource-, Construction-, and Business-/Computer-related industries. As well, service industries have increased their orders over last year, and it is expected that they will continue the upward trend.

According to Cossitt, a number of employers want people immediately and thus have a short closing date on the ad.

Cossitt attributes the increase to several factors. First is, of course, the strong upturn in the economy. The second is Careers Day, which not only helped students get acquainted with employers, but gave employers an idea of the complex and diverse function of NAIT. As well, the Placement Centre has been advertising in professional publications throughout Canada, promoting NAIT graduates as a valuable resource.

As for advice on how to obtain a job for the summer, or a more permanent full-time position, Cossitt offers some advice:

If you feel you meet the qualifications listed in the ad, apply for the position regardless if the job appeals directly to your technology or not.

Check the boards around NAIT. Some jobs are immediate and the orders there are updated daily.

Look at more than one source. the NAIT Placement Center is one agency, but there are the government employment office, Hire-A-Student (which opens on April 27).

Do not be wary of taking a STEP position for less money. When they are government positions, STEP can be an excellent way to get your foot in the door for a later full-time position at a higher salary.

Come to interviews--even those on campus--dressed properly and prepared with a list of references. Most people say "references available upon request" on their resume, but never come prepared to deliver them. Even if the interviewer does not ask for them, have a sheet handy.

Use reference materials and telephone calls to find out about a company. What does it do? How long has it been in operation?

Will it go under soon? All these can be answered by you making discreet inquiries.

Use friends and contacts to obtain jobs where possible.

With this positive outlook for the summer of 1989, it appears job opportunities are here. It is merely a question of finding the one you are most qualified for.

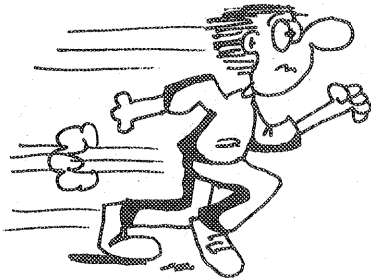

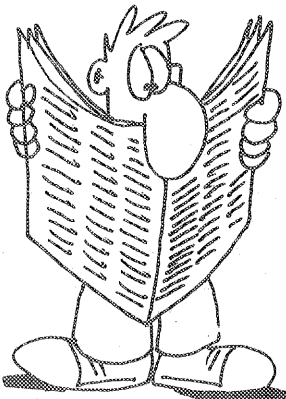

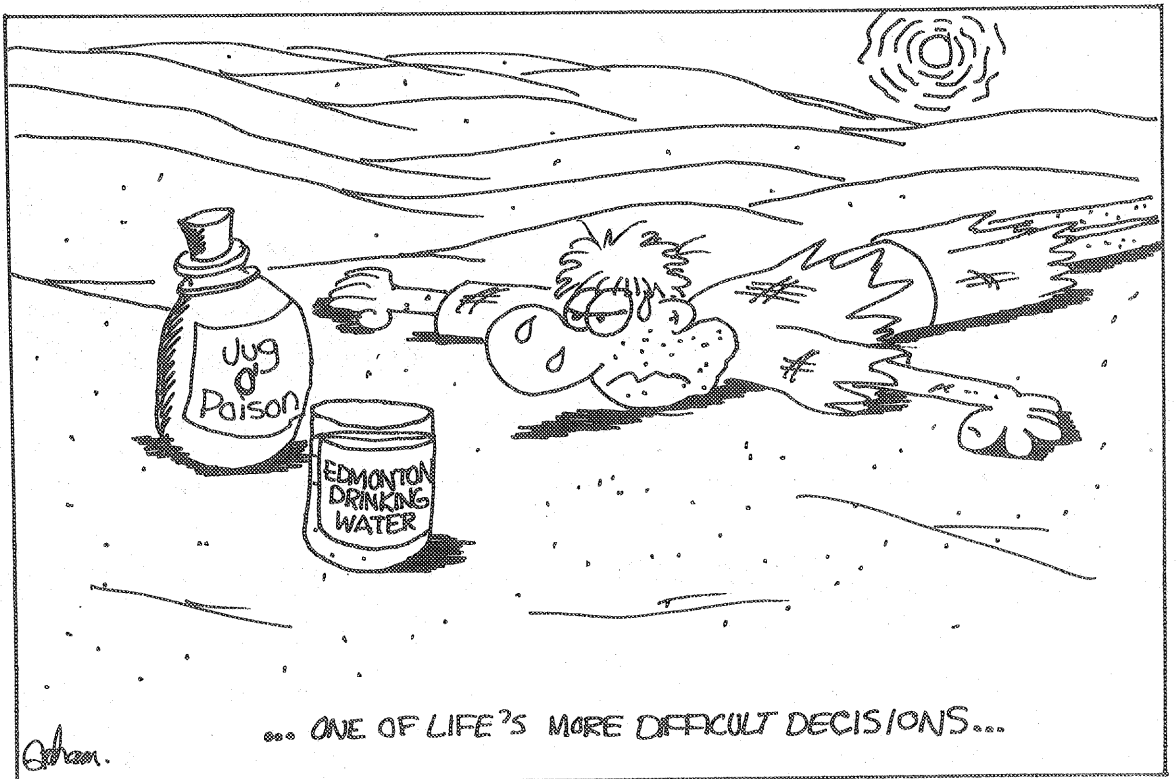

## Bylaw Violation Causes U of C Election to be Overturned

Calgary -- Campaign material distributed during regular voting days has resulted in a The Students' Union Judicial Review Board decision to nullify the majority of races in the recent Students' Union General Election.

A petition lodged by a presidential candidate immediately following the March 22 and 23 voting period initiated the review process by the autonomous judicial board. In light of the board's decision yesterday, the current Students' Legislative Council has voted to hold a by-election in September. A motion was also passed by

Council to reimburse March election candidates up to a total of \$9,000 for their campaign expenses.

"The Students' Union recognizes the inconvenience that the Review Board decision may have caused but

it is the board's mandate to insure that the integrity of the organization's bylaws are not compromised," said Tony Clark, V.P. Academic and Acting S.U. President. "With insufficient time to prepare for an election before classes end April 12, the council chose to hold a fall by-election."

The by-election will be limited to candidates that ran in the overturned election unless withdrawals cause a position to be uncontested in which case, nominations from the general student body will be accepted.

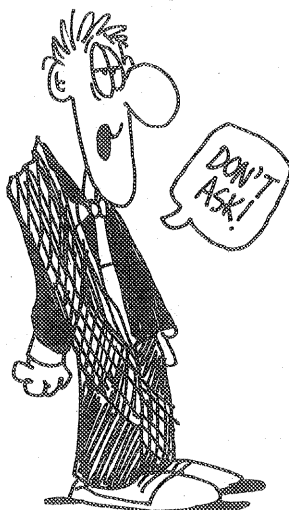
Until the by-election can be held, the 46th Student Legislative Council will operate with existing members. Current members will be given the opportunity to resign their positions with any resigning executive members being replaced from within their commission.

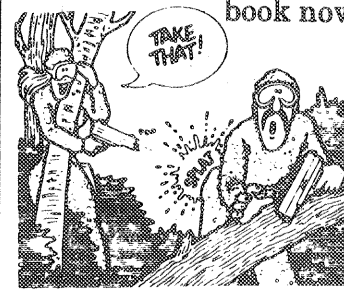

On December 23, 1988, William Sinnema, an instructor in the Electronics Department for 22 years, passed away in a drowning incident in Victoria, British Columbia.

Instrumental in development of the Electronics program, particularly courses in the communications field, Bill has also played a key role in supervision of department staff, as well as being highly involved in student project

activities. In addition, he has authored, and co-authored: Electronic Transmission Technology and Digital, Analog, and Data Communications (respectively), two widely used college level textbooks. Work on a third was underway at the time of his death.

As a tribute to Bill, the staff at NAIT are

participating in a campaign to raise funds used to recognize outstanding performance by a student graduating from the Electronics Engineering Technology program.

The award will be established through donations. The funds raised will then be matched by the Province of Alberta.
