



NAIT's 25th Annual Graduation to be Held on April 15

This year's graduating class of some 3,200 students is the largest in the history of the institute. These graduands will be joining the ranks of the more than 40,000 individuals who have graduated from NAIT since it opened its doors in 1963. Happily, quite a few of these individuals have maintained contact with the institute over the years in a variety of capacities and it is hoped that you, as a new graduate, will follow suit.

The graduation ceremony itself is a special occasion that you will probably want to share with your family and friends. However, because of the limited seating that is available, students are asked to invite only two people to the ceremony. The doors to the auditorium will be opened at 12:45 p.m. and 1900 seats will be made available to guests on a first-come-first-served basis. In order to avoid any disappointments, tv monitors will also be set up in the main lobbies to transmit the proceedings. Please remember to tell your guests that there is a \$2.00 charge for parking at the Jubilee.

The ceremony itself is scheduled to start at 1:30 p.m. so graduates are asked to line up according to the signs, by technology, between 1:00 and 1:20. The general outline of the proceedings is as follows: President's report, guest

speaker's address (Mr. Dave Russell), farewell address and the presentation of the diplomas. (You will actually receive your diploma in the mail but the President will present you with a diploma holder as a gift from the institute.) Once you have received your diploma, please return to your seat until all of the presentations have been made. The ceremony will last for approximately two hours, after which a reception will be held between 3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. for all of the graduates and their guests. Please make sure before the reception ends that you have returned your gown to the main coat-check area.

NAIT AND SAIT RUN TO RED DEER

It may not be marathon season yet, but you wouldn't know it by looking at NAIT and SAIT students.

Petroleum and Petrochemical students from NAIT and SAIT will be formalizing their friendly rivalry by competing in a cross-province charity relay run.

At 6:00 a.m. on Friday, April 7th, students from the two institutes will begin running towards Red Deer, SAIT students from the south and NAIT students from the North. Approximately twenty runners will run four miles each, arriving in Red Deer at around 6:00 p.m.

The joint marathon, conceived by Wayne Hobal of NAIT, has been designed with two goals in mind. First, to raise funds for the Heart Foundation and secondly, to raise awareness of the petroleum programs at the

two institutes.

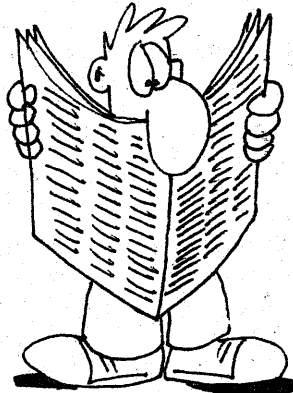

On Friday March 31st a new NAITSA executive was elected. Why did the electorate choose one candidate over another?

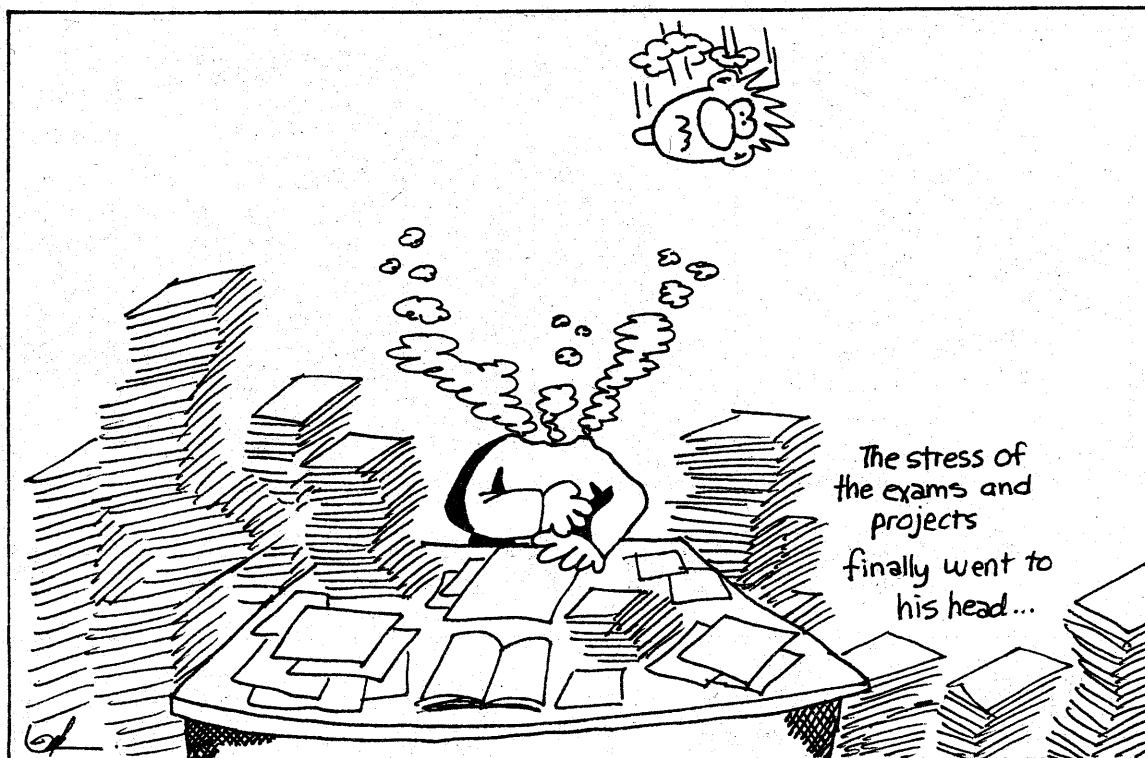
I asked two student politicians how they got elected. Here is their advice:

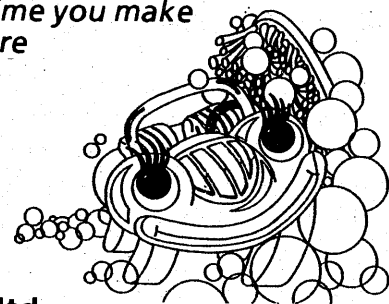

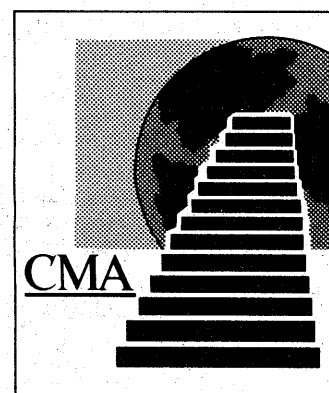

Forest Industry Expands, NAIT Gears Up

Until recently, when Albertans thought of the main engines of their province's economy, they usually thought of oil and gas, agriculture, then maybe petrochemicals, possibly tourism. But for many years, Alberta's forest industry has ranked third in gross domestic sales, and now there is little doubt in anyone's mind of its governing importance.

Several major projects have got under way within the past year - such that by mid-1991, six new or expanded mills, mostly pulp and paper, will be producing in northern Alberta. Mill expansions are also occurring in Saskatchewan and British Columbia. NAIT suspected, before the end of 1987, that a booming demand for skilled forestry manpower would materialize.

But how much demand,

and for which kinds of training? To find out, early in 1988, the Institute undertook a survey of major companies in Western Canada. Armed with a detailed questionnaire, to gain accurate data on training needs, Forest Technology Program Head Thor Knapp visited 55 companies in the four western provinces. A typical response to his interviews was: "It is very nice to have educators ask us what we want, rather than simply assuming."

NAIT's Forest Industry Training Needs Study by Thor Knapp and staff of Program Development Services (July 1988), revealed that nearly 5,000 employees would require training over the next five years in these 55 companies alone. Of urgent concern is that half of this training would be needed by 1991. The needs cover ten

sectors or skill areas of the industry.

Many of the needed programs can be developed by modifying elements of NAIT's extensive capacity in mechanical, electrical and other programs. Logging-truck drivers, for example, require training in preventive maintenance, a subject in NAIT's heavy-equipment programs. Power Engineers require training in thermal oil heating, a subject within Mechanical Engineering Technology. Pulp-and-paper workers require a whole range of training for which the Institute has capacity.

NAIT will co-operate with other institutions, industry, and government to provide appropriate programs, whether offered in-house or on-site, for this major growing sector of Alberta's economy.

Taking Stock

Definition: Safe path to becoming a multi-millionaire.

Mutual Funds on RRSPs

We have covered both of these topics separately, now it's time to combine the two. To review RRSPs, remember that a contribution can be in cash and can remain that way, or can be invested in "RRSP-eligible investments". Remember also, that 90 percent of the book value of the RRSP must be in Canadian-based investments. There are a number of medium-risk, Canadian mutual funds which meet these requirements. Also, at the present time, the maximum contribution to an RRSP is \$7,500 or 20 percent of earned income, whichever is less.

To follow the strategy of investing in mutual funds within an RRSP, bear in mind that all RRSP investments are tax-free, hence the rapid growth in the RRSP's value as demonstrated below:

Assumptions:

Value of RRSP = \$0.00
Age at first contribution = 30
Age at last contribution = 55
Annual investment contribution = \$4,000
Total funds invested = \$100,000

Not adjusted for inflation and no withdrawals.

Value of RRSP at age 55 if invested in:

Other	Mutual Funds
(10%)	(20%)
\$ 436,727	\$ 2,269,511

As you can see, there is a wide disparity between the two amounts. This is because the investments compound annually, but the fund is at a much higher rate.

At age 55, one of the options you have is to "roll" the RRSP into an "RRIF" (Registered Retirement Income Fund). An RRIF is essentially the same as an RRSP, except that you are required to withdraw a portion of the RRIF every year until you or your spouse turns 90. Only the withdrawn funds are taxed. The funds remaining in the RRIF continue to accumulate tax-free.

Of course, the mutual fund RRIF begins with relatively low annual income payments,

and ends with the last payment in excess of \$37 million.

You may choose to "index" the RRIF. This means you can choose a percent (0 - 10) by which your annual income will be calculated - in excess of the minimum withdrawals shown in the previous example. The same RRIF (MF @ 20%), indexed at 5 percent, would provide the following income:

And yes, despite the 'crash', there are mutual funds available which generate compound annual returns of 20 percent and have averaged this rate over a period of years - up to 25 and more. Do bear in mind that the 20 percent is an average return - some years will exceed this return, others will be less.

Still, it's a hefty return for what can be less than an annual car payment.

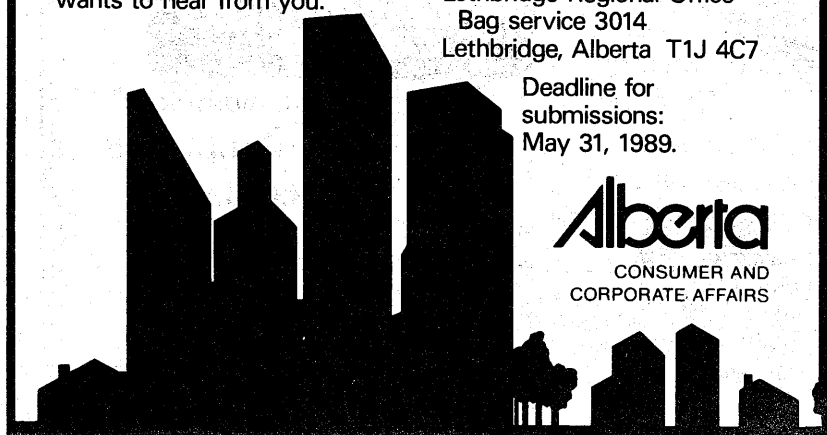

NAITSA Election Results

An unofficial total of 985 students voted on March 31 for the NAITSA election. 15.1 percent of the 6500 students that attend NAIT full time participated in the selection of the NAITSA '89 - '90 executives.

Brad Diemert, Roxanne Beubien, Kevin Wimpney, and Justin Dahlen all had their work cut out for them to attain a position on NAITSA. The four day campaign took a lot out of the nominees, and the election day itself was a nail-biter for some.

The unofficial margin for President was 53 votes. Two recounts were held for the position of Athletics Director. Mike Pawlenchuk gave Justin Dahlen a run for his

money.

There were unsubstantiated rumors of "dirty tricks" during the election campaign. There was talk of poster vandalism and posters disappearing, although no official complaints were lodged by the candidates.

The other positions ran uncontested. Scott Sugden, Imre Bene Jr., and Douglas Orlesky all received a strong "yes" vote, entering their position by acclamation.

Only two candidates were not from Business. Robert Brietzke (Electronics) who last to Kevin Wimpney for Activities Director, and Doug Orlesky (BCET) who was voted in by acclamation to sit on the Board of Governors.

The student's General Council meeting looked like the elevators in the Tower at lunch time. It was crowded. The new student council representatives were introduced and their first taste of post-secondary politics was eventful.

Pat MacEwan, President of NAITSA, chaired the meeting, which was marked by an informal atmosphere. Business consisted of an urgent request by the President concerning the return of the car raffle tickets and a reminder to the technologies involved to attend General Council. There was also a reminder that charity hours for each technology must be in a.s.a.p.

Old business was brought up by Architecture Technology concerning the installation of a television set in Plaza II. Art Hooks, Associate Dean of Student Services, revealed that the initial cost to install cable for that t.v. was outrageous. The only option was a satellite dish which the council felt would be approximately \$8,000. Too steep a figure to fit into this year's budget.

Now, for the real reason everyone was there. Nominations for the position

of Board of Governors were reopened. There are two positions on the Board of Governors. Doug Orlesky captured one during the elections held last week. Another student voice at this level was needed and the speeches delivered by Brian Powell, Lisa Leskow, Martin Maltby, and Kari Dent expressed an overwhelming concern for NAIT and an optimism that they could fill the roll.

Kari Dent won the confidence of the technology representatives and will join Mr. Orlesky on the Board of Governors.

Nominations for academic council were also reopened and Dianne Pilling, Greg Fraser, and Mike Bohnet, who all have had previous experience working with student issues, were voted aboard. Barry Gabruch will be rounding off the list.

New business was brought up by Hairstyling Technology, who wished to see a large turnout at their swimsuit fashion show which will be on April 22. The event is co-sponsored by the NAIT Foundation.

Westwood wound things up with a "beef" concerning incomplete clean-up in the building. Technologies such as Secretarial and Tailoring both agreed something should be done.

Answers to Student Loan Questions

REPAYING YOUR STUDENT LOAN

If you have a student loan you **MUST** start repaying it six months after your period of study ends. You benefit from a six month grace period within which you are not charged interest on the amount owing.

Interest rate at the present time is 10.5%. A new rate comes into effect every August 1st. Within this six month period you must go to the bank which holds your loan and complete a repayment agreement called a Consolidated Guaranteed Student Loan Agreement.

The agreement must be signed within this six month period even though you may feel you are not able to make payments at that time. Payments need only start at the end of the six month period. However, if you choose, you may repay the entire amount within the six month period with no interest being charged.

If you fail to complete a consolidated loan agreement within the six month period, your loan will be declared in default.

Defaulting on your loan without cause will deny you any future provincial or federal funding. In addition, your file will be placed in the hands of a collection agency who will monitor your account and arrange a mutually acceptable repayment schedule.

If you refuse to complete with the agreed commitment to make payments, your account is sent to the department of Justice (monies borrowed are federal and provincial funds) which will proceed to register a judgment in the courts, and

garnishee of wages or salary may follow. Therefore, it is in your best interest to make the necessary arrangements with your bank.

INTEREST RELIEF PLAN

The Interest Relief Plan for Canada Student Loans Program came into effect on September 1, 1983. The purpose of the plan is to assist those individuals who are experiencing financial difficulties due to temporary disability or inability to find employment.

How to Apply

Application forms are available from the local bank branches, Canada Employment Centres, collection agencies that collect Canada Student Loans, and the Student Assistance Directorate of the Department of the Secretary of State, Ottawa.

The decision to grant you "interest relief" will be made by the Student Assistance Directorate. Once you have completed the form, the bank must complete the section dealing with information on your loan, and the bank should mail the form to Ottawa on your behalf.

During the special interest free period, you will not be required to make payments on the principal amount of your Canada Student loan.

At the present time the Alberta Students Finance Board has not matched the interest free period on Alberta loans.

Assistance Provided

The Department of the Secretary of State will inform you of the results of your assessment. If your application is approved, a letter of acceptance will indicate the period for which

interest relief has been granted, normally for three or six months depending on information contained in the application.

At the end of each period, if circumstances remain unchanged, a new application must be submitted, otherwise payment of the outstanding balance will commence. Interest relief is granted to a maximum of 18 months.

REMISSION

The Students Finance Board may repay, on your behalf, a portion of the funds that you are required to borrow for each year of full-time studies. These payments are called remission and under this program the province may repay up to 40% of the funds borrowed each year calculated after the first \$1,000 is borrowed.

For example:

Maximum loan =

\$4,300 - \$1,000 =

\$3,300 eligible for remission

Assuming a 40% remission x \$3,300 =

\$1,320

Repayment =

\$1,000 + (\$3,300 - \$1,320) or \$2,980

How is Remission Estimated?

Remission is estimated when you apply for financial assistance. Calculation of remission is directly related to the amount of savings you have at the start of your program of study.

For example, the minimum of savings expected by the Alberta Students Finance Board is \$1,000. If you do not have the minimum amount of savings and do not offer the Students Finance Board a reasonable explanation, BUT you still need the \$1,000 shortfall, SFB may give the \$1,000 and may reduce your remission by \$1,000.

The same principle applies if SFB estimates you should have saved \$2,000 and you

saved \$500, you decide to appeal SFB's decision and received the \$1,500. Your remission may be reduced by \$1,500.

Parental contribution if you are a dependent, and spousal contribution if you're married are treated the same way. The key here is in providing "reasonable explanation" -- if you do not have any savings because you did not find employment for four months before the start of your studies, you must provide SFB with a documented job search, names of contacts, etc.

If you have satisfied SFB's requirement you may be able to save your remission.

How to Apply

Refund is processed once you begin repaying your student loan and you have submitted an application for remission to the Students Finance Board. Application forms are available from the bank, and must be completed by the bank, and mailed to the Students Finance Board for processing. Processing time may take up to three months.

If you have paid your student loan in full, before you apply for remission, remission will be paid directly to you. If you are making payments on your student loan, remission will be sent to the bank and

applied to your student loan, thereby reducing the principal.

Draft for Dollars

In keeping with tradition, the NAIT Foundation's NHL Hockey draft for the playoffs is on schedule to make a sizeable amount of money for the institute.

The "Draft for Dollars" sold out. One Thousand entries were sold at \$100 each. Prizes for the NHL playoff draft will total \$51,000, with the grand prize being \$30,000 cash. Advertising expenses totalled \$2,500.

This money is eligible for a matching grant from Alberta's Endowment and Incentive fund for post-secondary education.

THE ABCs OF SAFETY

Attitude, Behaviour and Control

Attitude

A safe attitude means staying alert and focused on the job at hand, taking safety guidelines and practices seriously, never horsing around on the job, and not letting emotions like anger and frustration get in the way of job performance.

Behaviour

Safe behaviour means taking safety guidelines and practices seriously.

How you react to a situation is an important part of being safe. Following established safety guidelines and procedures, refusing to take "short-cuts", using personal protective equipment, asking questions when you need more information about the task at hand -- all of these are safe behaviours. Safe behaviour also means helping friends, co-workers, and family members understand the importance of safe practices at work, home, or play.

Control

Control means taking responsibility for making your worksite, home, or recreational facility, a safe place to be. You can help keep your surroundings safe from potential hazards by keeping them clean and orderly. Keep machines in good repair, clean up spills and debris (or report them to the appropriate person), and make sure that walkways are free from obstacles. Store chemicals properly (both at home and on the job) and never switch containers. At work, be sure to report faulty equipment or any potential hazards to your supervisor.

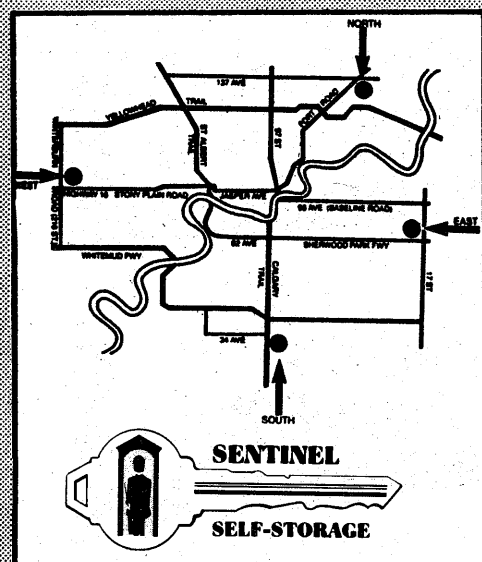
ABCs -- Easy as 1-2-3

Facts About Dental Health

Dental Disease: Dental disease is the most common chronic health problem for Canadians. More people suffer from dental disease than from any other health disorder. At some time in their lives over 95 % of Canadians will develop gum disease: 95-98% will have decayed teeth. Ironically, dental disease is also the most preventable disease in Canada today. Gum disease and tooth decay result primarily from neglect.

Consequences: Dental disease is an important health issue. If left untreated, tooth decay and gum disease can cause extreme discomfort. Moreover, teeth will fall out or will have to be extracted.

Tooth Loss: The major cause of tooth loss in children is dental caries (tooth decay). The major cause of tooth loss in adults is gum disease. Tooth loss has serious consequences: it can affect speaking and chewing ability, alter eating habits, and restrict food choice. It can also detract from appearance, cause deterioration of the jawbone, and generally affect well-being.

Prevention: The key to keeping teeth good for a lifetime is control of plaque, a clear, sticky film of live bacteria that forms constantly in the mouth and acts on sugar to produce toxic acids that weaken the teeth and gums. There are three aspects to keeping plaque at bay. One is home care: scrupulous daily brushing and flossing to remove plaque from the teeth and gumline. Another is sensible nutrition: in particular, limited sugar intake. The third is seeing a dentist at regular intervals for a checkup and professional cleaning.

Fluoride: Fluoride, a naturally occurring mineral, is an essential nutrient. It unites with the tooth enamel, making it more resistant to the acids that cause decay. By even the most conservative estimates, fluoride in local water supplies can reduce children's cavities by 40%. Children who don't live in an area with fluoridated water should be taking fluoride supplements. And *everyone* needs a daily application of fluoride, which is easily available by using a CDA-recognized toothpaste or mouthrinse.

Dentalphobia: Millions of Canadians are afraid of the dentist. For some, the fear is so intense that they never seek professional care; many more stay away until painful dental disease forces them to get help. Many people became fearful in the days before high-speed drilling and accurate anaesthesia. Others developed anxiety as children, either from a bad experience, or because family or friends led them to expect pain at the dentist's. Dentists are aware of and understand these problems. Some dentists specialize in treating anxious patients. A variety of seminars and course -- including a special course in hypnosis offered at the University of British Columbia's dental school -- help dentists care for the fearful.
