




FEDERAL BUDGET SPELLS TOUGH TIMES FOR STUDENTS

How is the federal sales tax (FST) going to affect Student Life in Alberta? The University of Calgary Student's Union expressed doom and gloom in a recent press release, "Students traditionally have little disposable income which will now be cut by 9%, and they are one group who can least afford this reduction," said Susan Lawson, Vice - President of Externals.

As if the FST weren't enough! The federal government is also reducing federal transfer payments to the provinces. This means reduced provincial contributions to Alberta's universities and colleges. Post-secondary education in this province is already in a downhill slide, these cutbacks could be hazardous to Alberta's education system. And, unless the provincial government takes up the slack students are looking at a tuition increase (Oh joy).

With this in mind let's all hope that the Student's Finance Board will review the guidelines it uses to determine the amount of money an individual student receives. In other words. "Get with it!" A realistic assessment of what it costs a student for an education (and a future) would be appreciated.

What can you do as an individual? Post secondary students have been supporting this cause for the past 26 years with the Shinerama fundraising campaign.


