

The Hockey Ooks Celebrate a hard fought victory

This is the first time ever a tournament host has won gold medals in all the events they were hosts to.

In men's basketball, the Ooks started on their path to the gold medal with a 73-62 win over the Trinity Western University Spartans who were the wildcard entry from British Columbia.

The Ooks then destroyed the Nova Scotia Teacher's College Hawks 92-69. The Hawks had reached the semi-

finals with an upset victory over the Sheridan College Bruins from Oakville Ontario.

The Ooks met the Lethbridge Community College Kodiaks in the gold medal final. The game occurred before a standing room only crowd at the Main Gym. The Ooks, who trailed slightly during the first half, went ahead 37-35 with two seconds left, as Wayne Grant scored on a steal.

The Ooks then used a strong defense and offensive

board pressure to open a 77-63 lead. the Ooks then finished off the Kodiaks with an 86-73 final score for the National Title.

In hockey, The NAIT Ooks are the Canadian Colleges Athletic Association National Hockey Champions for the fourth time in eight years with a 5-4 victory over the Red Deer College Kings at the NAIT Arena on Saturday, March

With the win, the Ooks won their first national

championship since 1986 in Kamloops. The Ooks were also national champions in 1982 and 1985.

In the first period, the Red Deer College Kings jumped out to an early 2-0 lead on goals by Murray Toews and Cam Bowles. The Ooks then rebounded to take a 3-2 as Tournament MVP Scott Melnyk notched a pair and John Hart added single. Darren Cota of the Kings tied the contest at 3-3 before the end of the frame.

In the second, the Ooks jumped out to a 5-3 lead as Scott Melnyk completed the hat trick and Randy Wong padded the lead. Chad Kisslinger of Red Deer pulled the Kings to within one before

In the third, both teams had opportunites, but no one could put the puck in the net.

Tournament Goaltender, Rob McKinley of NAIT, blocked 25 of 29 shots. At the opposite end, Glen Raeburn of the Kings stopped 10 of 15 shots including a penalty shot by Robin Dubé of the Ooks.

Red Deer takes home the silver while Humber of Rexdale, Ontario goes home with the bronze. Palliser Campus of Moose Jaw, Mount Royal of Calgary, and the British Columbia Institute of Technology of Burnaby finished fourth, fifth and sixth respectively.



- Graduation seems so close, and yet so far away.







Blizzard Clean-up Costs NAIT

On January 30th of this year, Edmonton was hit by one of the most severe snow storms to ever hit this area.

The city estimated a 3 million dollar price tag. NAIT had its own budgeting to do and it is now estimated that the week cost our institute \$34,450.

The \$34,500 includes hauling expenses and equipment costs of \$18,900 Wage expenses of 263 regular hours, 56 hours time and a half, and 185 hours double time totalled \$14,350. Miscellaneous expenses of \$1,200 rounded off the costs for a total clearing expense of \$34,450.

Canadian Rock History And By Labatt's

Acknowledging the influences of Gary Glitter and The Police, among others, this band began its rapid rise to fame in 1983. The release of a seven song EP, the largest selling in Canadian history, drew the attention of a major record label and with the addition of four new songs, the album "Standing In The Dark" went on to sell double Platinum. With three singles released from that disc, including the title track, the lads garnered a Juno for Best New Group.

In June 1985, the single "Crying Over You" sold Gold in one month and the subsequent album "Alien Shores" sold an astonishing five times Platinum. The Labatt's sponsored Alien Invasion Tour that year was one of the biggest in Canadian history. Other singles released included "Somebody Somewhere" and "Situation Critical." The band was again honored with Juno nominations for Best Group, Best Song and Best Album.

In 1987, Los Angeles was their workplace although they returned to Toronto to finish this, their most recent album. "Contact" was released in 1987, and six singles were released throughout 1987 and 1988 including the title track and cover of The Ohio Players "Fire."
