

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

## NAIT, Kingsway Caught In Parking Crunch



### Empty Stalls a Thing of The Past

This month, amid the excitement and hustle of students returning to classes, one of NAIT's chronic nightmare's once again reared it's ugly head. The lack of parking spaces for NAIT students is painfully obvious to anyone within several blocks of NAIT at 8:00 am any weekday.

Unfortunately, according to Dick Maertens-Poole of Security, there are no plans to expand existing parking for several years. The reason for this is quite simply a lack of available land. Although the problem is currently before

City Council, changes will not come soon enough to help any current NAIT students.

NAIT does have a priority system to deal with the parking overload. Anyone with medical problems is placed at the top of the list, followed by students who must drive in from outlying areas. Car pools are third on the list, and then come students who require their cars to get to work, daycare, or who must use large pieces of equipment for their courses. Last on the list are those with easy access to public transit or who live near NAIT.

To add to students problems, Kingsway Garden Mall is threatening to crack down on students who leave their cars there during the day.

The reason for this, according to William Blackburn, the store manager at Sears, is that each parking stall represents \$50 of revenue per hour for the Mall. Therefore, if a student's car occupies one stall for eight hours, it is denying \$400 to the Mall. There are also unconfirmed rumors that throughout next week, Kingsway will have several

tow-trucks at the Mall to tow any car whether the owner has received a previous warning or not. In fact, as of November 17th, Sears employees will no longer be allowed to park at Kingsway Garden Mall either.

With only 1604 student parking stalls to service all campuses it is easy to see where the parking problem starts. However, until large scale plans are drawn up to relieve the parking congestion, there is no telling where it will end.

## LONGER READING BREAK IN '90

At the first Board of Governors meeting of the new school year, several items were discussed that should interest NAIT students. The most immediate news concerns Reading Break, which was officially changed from February 22nd - 23rd to the 15th and 16th to coincide with the province's new "Family Day" holiday. The change effectively gives students a five day weekend from February 15th to February 19th.

The other piece of news that students will like is that NAIT is currently negotiating with the city to acquire more land for parking. At the September 12th council meeting, Alderman Bruce Campbell tabled a motion on

this subject on NAIT's behalf. Unfortunately, no changes will occur for several years, so students shouldn't get too excited just yet.

At the meeting, the new NAIT flag was unveiled by Wally Romenko. The flag displays a white globe and gold triangle in the lower right hand corner of a blue flag with "NAIT" in blue letters on top of the globe and triangle. Also, it was revealed that Minister John Vogel will be returning to NAIT this year. He visited the institute on June 24th after classes had let out for summer, and so plans to return to meet with students and discuss...whatever.

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

## NAIT's Library on 'Leading Edge'

The library at NAIT is undergone some major upgrading of the current facilities. The first step, and one of the most time consuming in total library automation, is the barcoding of the books. Helga Kinnard is in charge of all the functions on the 3rd floor of the library, "We have a bit of a nest egg in that 80% of our barcoding is completed."

Fifteen months ago the Nait Foundation supplied the library with the seed money to begin a move towards a high tech computerized Library System. There will no longer be a need for a card catalogue once this system is in operation. The system will work much like that of any major department store in that each barcode is passed over a scanner and processed and recorded in a matter of seconds. "The barcoding is in place, but we are now waiting for the funds to attain the hardware," says Helga Kinnard.

When the library is completed obtaining a book will involve sitting at computer terminal, punching in related topics and then receiving a computer print out of titles and codes. Then it's just a matter of checking it out

over the laser scanner.

Other advances available now are the Compact Disc ROM Read Only Memory Search Computer. These two machines can access the periodical indexes and give you a computer print out immediately. These discs are now available in the library: Business, Science and Technology, Medical, Reader's Guide, Agriculture. There is also a self-learning tutor computer with software entailing everything from designing pipe systems and fluid mechanics to Grammar and Business Programs. The IBM PS/2 computer is available to any student producing a NAIT card. Appointments are necessary. The NAIT library now has access to the books of the University of Alberta through the "U of A on line catalogue." If NAIT does not have what you are looking for they might.

There's no doubt Helga Kinnard has had a helping hand in the upgrading of NAIT's library. "We are on the leading edge of technology and through the years we've tried to make our library as friendly and accessible as possible to our students".

As you can tell, these people are not exactly patriotic to the American constitution.


This is probably something that the American's are going to have to find out "the hard way!" Some people say that this is the best way to learn. I'm glad I don't have this problem.

The Calgary Flames gambled in November of 1981 when they traded for Lanny McDonald from the Colorado Rockies. Cliff Fletcher, the General Manager of the Flames, did not know whether he was receiving an old Lanny or the Lanny of old.

Lanny never led the league in goals, assists, or points, but he led the league in heart. The man who wore number nine for the Flaming C's meant a great deal to his team and to his community. Conversely, the community and the team meant a great deal to Lanny.

Off the ice, Lanny has been involved with Special Olympics sixteen years. The bond between Lanny and these athletes was and still is special.

Entering the 1988-89 season, Lanny had the opportunity to reach the 1,000 point plateau and the 500 goal plateau. As the games passed, fewer and fewer observers thought that Lanny would be able to reach both of these illusive milestones. However, as the season was drawing to a close, Lanny played with passion and reached the second of the milestones.

For the man from Hanna, these individual goals had significance, but there was a more important team goal--the Stanley Cup. In May of 1989, Lanny

scored his last goal where he scored his first--the Montreal Forum. The goal was the turning point that gave the Flames Lord Stanley's mug in six games.

When Lanny, spoke at the ceremonies on the Saturday after the cup victory, there was not a dry eye at Olympic Plaza.

With the announcement of his retirement, Lanny will be missed on the ice. However, the memories will be etched in our minds forever.

on Friday night, the Ooks go to Akinsdale Arena in St. Albert to play the Saints in a 7:30 p.m. match on Saturday night.


