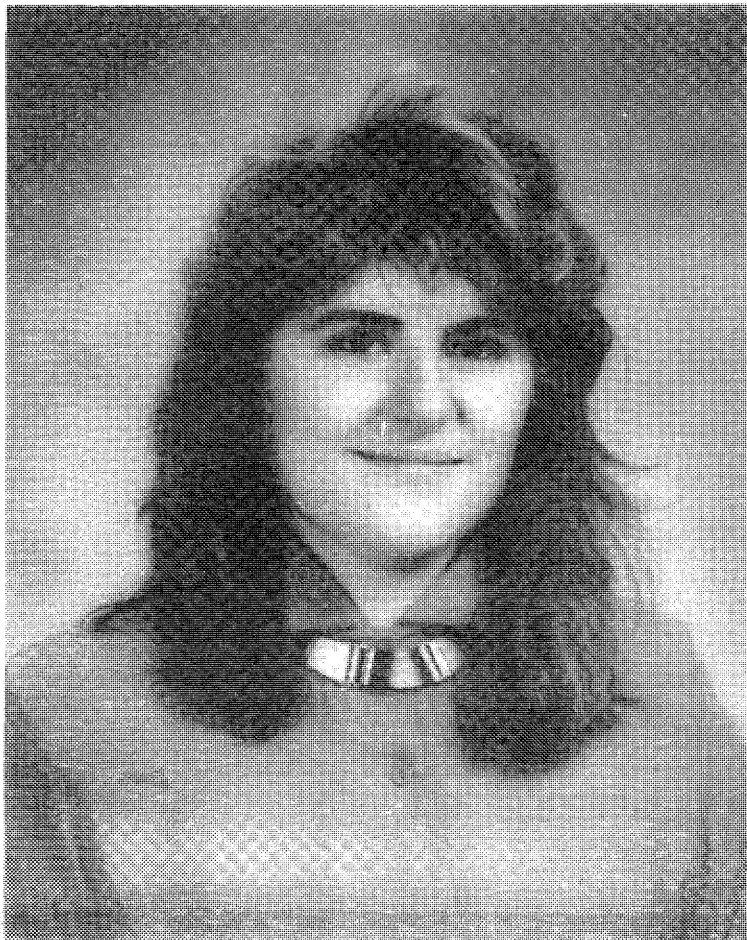


NAITSA PROFILE: VICE PRESIDENT

Nugget: "What exactly are the Vice President's duties?"

Roxanne: "Organizing Shinerama and King/Queen week, the Chief Returning Officer for the 1990 NAITSA Elections. Which means I help set up voting stations, do promotions, count ballots, etc. I also do external and internal PR for NAITSA, act as a voting member of ACTISEC, and handle any of the President's duties in his absence. Also, I'm a member of the Activities Committee, as well as, Alcohol Awareness Committee."

N: "Do you find NAITSA difficult to fit in to your scholastic schedule?"

R: "Very! But, I guess a more realistic description is that I have peak times throughout the year. Right now I'm very busy with Shinerama."

N: "How do you think holding this position will contribute to your future career?"

R: "I want to go into Marketing which is PR based, so I'm learning alot towards that. It's teaching me how to deal with other people and the public. And

how to (or not to) deal with stress!" (laughs) "It's also helping me to make valuable connections."

N: "What do you hope to accomplish in the upcoming year?"

R: "I would like to see NAITSA a more visible organization within the school and that students become more aware that we exist and the different ways in which NAITSA can be used by students. I want to do my job the best that I can."

N: "Do you feel the Student Executive operates efficiently?"

R: "I think we're more efficient than we are effective, at this point."

N: "What would you do to change this?"

R: "I'd like to see the Technology President's get behind NAITSA on some of the events that we do. Also I feel some of the positions within NAITSA could be reevaluated... The amount of responsibilities attached to some positions could be redistributed to even the amount of work."

N: "Are you predicting Shinerama to be a success? And how much do you think the students of NAIT are capable of raising?"

R: "Definitely. I think we have a good group working together. \$20,000 is our goal. And so far, our numbers are up from last year, so I'm sure we'll reach or surpass our goal. But, I'm still relying on the students to come out and support this worthy cause, which is a 19 year NAIT tradition."

N: "Would you recommend becoming a member of the Students Executive to first year students? What characteristics do you feel are necessary to run for council?"

R: "Absolutely, running for office is a great way to meet other students, become involved in your community and have a lot of fun. The most important thing about running is to do it for the right reasons. Those being: willingness to learn, and wanting to make NAIT a more enjoyable place for students - and not for the perks that come along with the job."

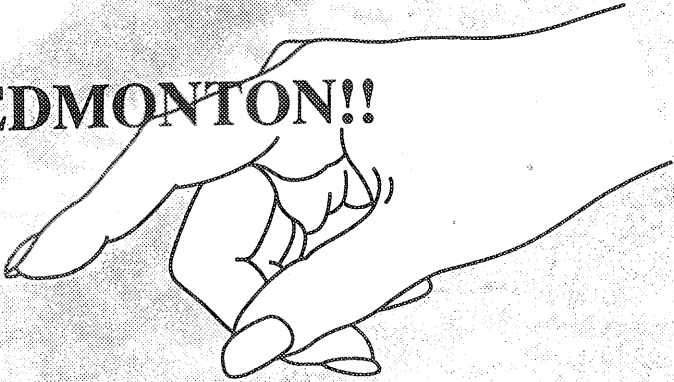

NEST TO CLOSE ON SATURDAYS!

Due to a lack of business on Saturdays, the Nest may be forced to close down on weekends. According to Gord Matthew, Assistant Manager at the Nest, not enough money is being brought in Saturdays to cover costs. With three servers, a bartender, a cook, and a manager on duty at various times during the day, more money is going out through wages than is coming in through food and drink sales. Although it is not known when a final decision will be made, indications are that it will not be long.

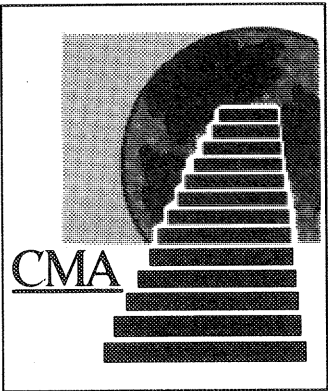
Of course, the Nest will stay open for special events, that happen to fall on Saturdays, such as: Queen Week Gala Ball. Apart from that though, the outlook is bleak. An attempt to entice movie goers at the Little Theatre to the Nest by offering a 10% discount on food has not helped due to an average movie attendance of 24 people per show over the last two weeks.

As the Nest already closes on Sundays, it would not be a major problem to close for the entire weekend. It appears that only a dramatic increase in weekend business could change the current situation.

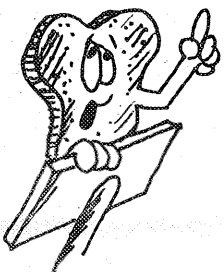


TOASTMASTERS COME TO NAIT

Following a scoreless first frame, the Oaks led 2-0 after two periods and added two more in the third for a 4-1 win.

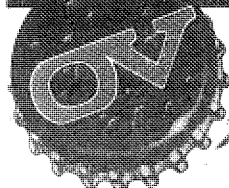
The busy schedule continues for the Oaks when they play host to the NAIT Blue Gold Classic Hockey Tournament this weekend.

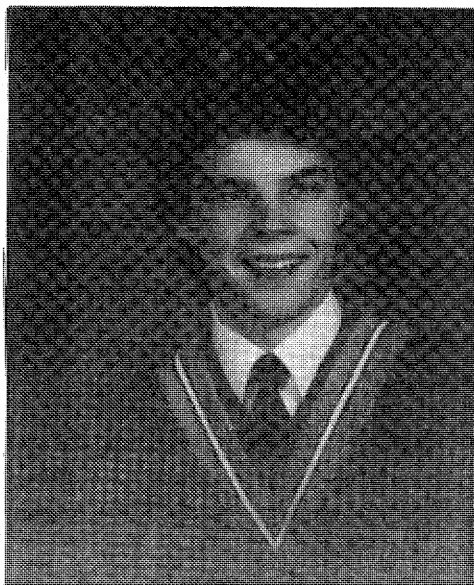
On Saturday, September 23rd, the U of A plays Red Deer at 3:30 p.m. while NAIT battles Camrose at 7:30 p.m.

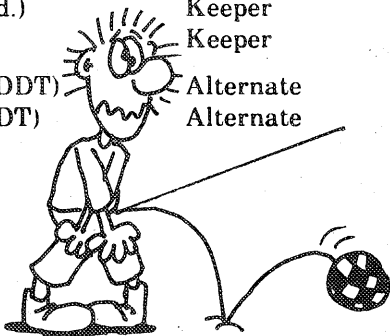
SOCCER OOKS WIN HOME DOUBLE HEADER

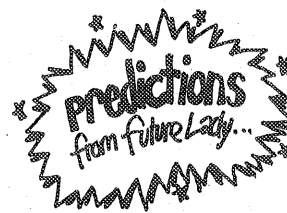

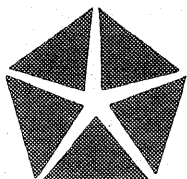
