
The Conolly family plans on keeping the Corvette for the time being, but may sell later on and put the money towards a mortgage on a house.

right to left: Lil Bowes (CST Assistant Program Head), Helen Banks (past Program Head), Ava Kajrenius (CO-OP Student)



Changes such as these can only help improve the high standard of NAIT education. Best of luck to


