## CHAMPIONS

### Ooks Retain National Title in OT

For the second time in their history, the NAIT Hockey Ooks have won back to back national titles. The NAIT Ooks captured the CCAA National Championship with a 2-1 series victory over the Humber Hawks of Rexdale, Ontario.

The conquest was a difficult one for the Ooks as the Humber Hawks gave the Ooks all they could handle in the confines of Westwood Arena in metropolitan Toronto. All the games were decided by one goal and two of the games extended into overtime.

In game one of the best of three on Wednesday, March 21st, the Ooks needed triple overtime to squeak by the Hawks 2-1 in triple overtime.

The Ooks' Greg Geldart netted the game winner on the powerplay at the 18:53 mark of the third extra period from Ivan Krook and Todd Lorenz.

NAIT gained a 1-0 lead when Ivan Krook found the mark on the powerplay at 11:37 of the first period.

Blaine Peerless and Greg Geldart assisted on the play.

Ian Collins of Humber set the stage for overtime as he tied the contest with 10:17 elapsed in the third.

In game two on Friday, March 23rd, The Hawks handed the Ooks their first loss in playoffs as they downed NAIT 2-1.

Following two scoreless periods, the teams combined for three goals in the third period. Humber's Jim Way opened the scoring at 8:25 of the final period, before Ivan Krook pulled the Ooks even at 12:37 on a play with Mark Hilton and Greg Geldart. Gino Lostracco of Humber then netted the decisive goal of the game at 16:24 to break the deadlock.

In a winner take all finale on Saturday, March 24th, the Ooks came from behind to score a 4-3 win over the Hawks in double overtime.

Mark Hilton's tally at 14:44 of the second overtime period gave the Ooks their fifth national title. Ivan Krook assisted on the play.

The Ooks took a 1-0 lead at the 19:35 mark of the first when Greg Geldart pocketed his second goal of the series

from Todd Lorenz and Randy Wong.

The Hawks moved in front in the second when Sean Davies and Paul Jackson rifled in bullets at 2:14 and 7:03.

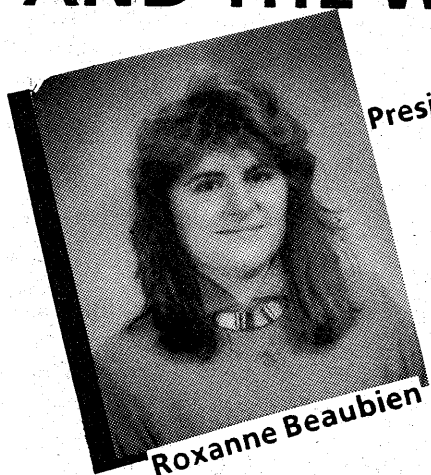
The Ooks then fought back in the third. Greg

Geldart tied the contest at 2-2 with 12:33 gone in the period from Craig Sterzer and Todd Lorenz only to have Gino Lostracco give Humber the lead on a shorthanded goal a short time later. With 4:03 left in regulation, Craig Sterzer completed the Ooks comeback notching his first

goal of the series from Lonnie Spink and Mark Thiessen to send the game into OT.

Both Rob McKinley of NAIT and Mike Noonan of Humber went all the way for the teams in net and provided solid support for their teammates.

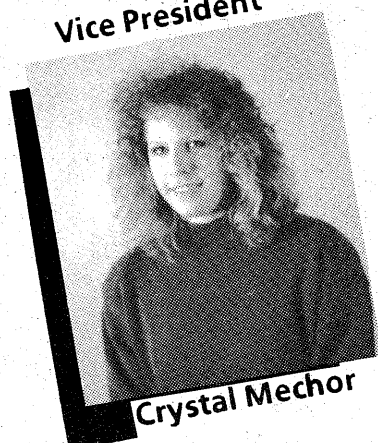

Behzad Fakhari--Dental Technology--Disagree, because we are living in Canada and should accept Canadian standards and rules.

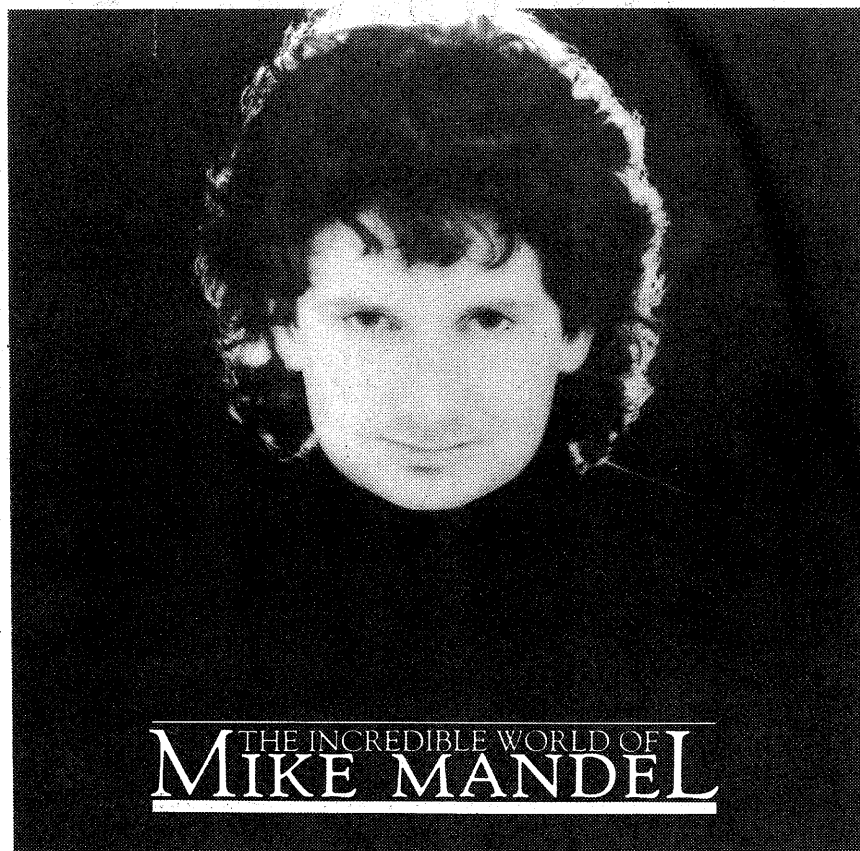

## COUNCIL MEETING

### HAS IMPORTANT AGENDA

Although the Tuesday March 20th General Council meeting had several important items on its agenda, the Council did not manage to pass any resolutions. The reason was that less than 20 technology representatives were present to vote. Twenty is the minimum number set out in the NAITSA by-laws for a quorum.

The problem was noticed on the second reading of a proposed addition to the by-laws. The final vote was 17 to 1 in favour of the change. With only 18 votes, the addition had to be sent back to first reading. There are not enough meetings left this year for the addition to be approved.

Also disallowed were the recommendations to NAIT to make the NAITRIUM completely non-smoking and the motion to accept in principle the recommendations for a new instructor evaluation system. Discussion about the new NAITSA hiring policy was also halted.

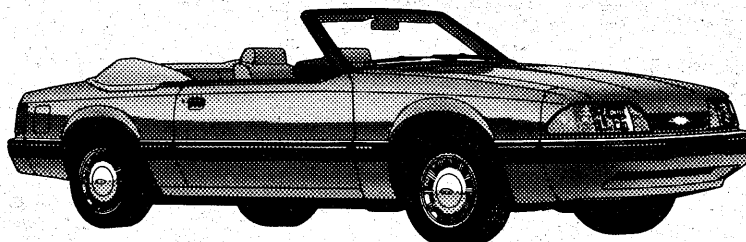

During Thursday's NAITSA campaign speeches, at Westwood Campus, a question was asked of Vice-Presidential candidate Michelle Haylow that demonstrated a couple of problems with people's thinking around here. The question was basically whether Michelle's relationship with former NAITSA Activities Director Kevin Wimpney would affect her decision making ability if she were elected.

This question displays two glaring flaws in logic. The first is that it assumes guilt by association. The questioner seemed to feel that since Michelle's boyfriend was accused of something, her integrity is compromised. Such an attitude is not only harmful, but also insulting. The person who asked the question seemed to give Michelle no credit at all for having a mind of her own. From recent events at NAIT, it is obvious women can think for themselves and are quite prepared to do so. No candidate deserves a question like that. At least Miss Haylow had the determination and commitment to run for office, something the questioner didn't.

The other problem with the question is that it assumes guilt by association WITH AN INNOCENT PERSON. Many people at NAIT don't seem to want to accept that the committee set up by NAIT, found Kevin innocent. The official report said there wasn't enough evidence to find Kevin guilty. In Canada, that means he's innocent. There's no such thing as sort of guilty. The committee found them innocent, and nobody bothered to appeal the decision. Could it be because there was no real evidence against Kevin? If people can't accept that, then that old phrase should read "Guilty until proven guilty."

Dear Editor:

I know that any newspaper has the right to publish news-worthy information. Freedom of speech and freedom of the press are rights that have justly resulted from long battles with ignorance.

However, along with these hard fought rights come unavoidable responsibilities. Quite often, especially when the intent is to sensationalize, these responsibilities are set aside for personal or materialistic gains.

In the "Grapevine" section of your March 22, 1990 issue, you published a "letter" to a K. Bridges from a "Pissed Bio-Science Student". I have

two points I wish to make totally clear to you.

One, if any adult has a problem with another adult, the mature human being has the right to address the issue with his or her peer. But along with this right goes the responsibility to face this difference of opinion with dignity. Writing an anonymous, defamatory note in a widely-circulated journal shows, in my opinion, no class, no professionalism, and no humanism.

Secondly, the N.A.I.T. Nugget and all other publications must use discretion in their decisions to publish or not to publish certain communication. The Nugget's right to print must always be tempered with the responsibility to publish only those items which fall within the legal and moral codes of the society it represents. On Page 22 of N.A.I.T.'s "Academic Regulations and Procedures" (September 1989) under Section A.2.7 ('Student Behavior') Item I, of "activities (that) constitute inappropriate student behavior" reads:

"Libelous or indecent statements, unfounded allegations and statements harmful to personal dignity."

Disciplinary action for such violations includes "mark penalties in courses up to and including termination/expulsion."

I fear both the author(s) of this "letter" and the Nugget staff have erred in light of the above regulation. Their combined right to print has, I feel, totally ignored their combined responsibility to do what is right for all parties concerned.

On behalf of the Biological Sciences Program staff and students, I wish to condemn the actions of both the author(s) and Nugget staff who chose to take this course of action, and it is my sincere hope that this breach of journalistic ethics will not be repeated.

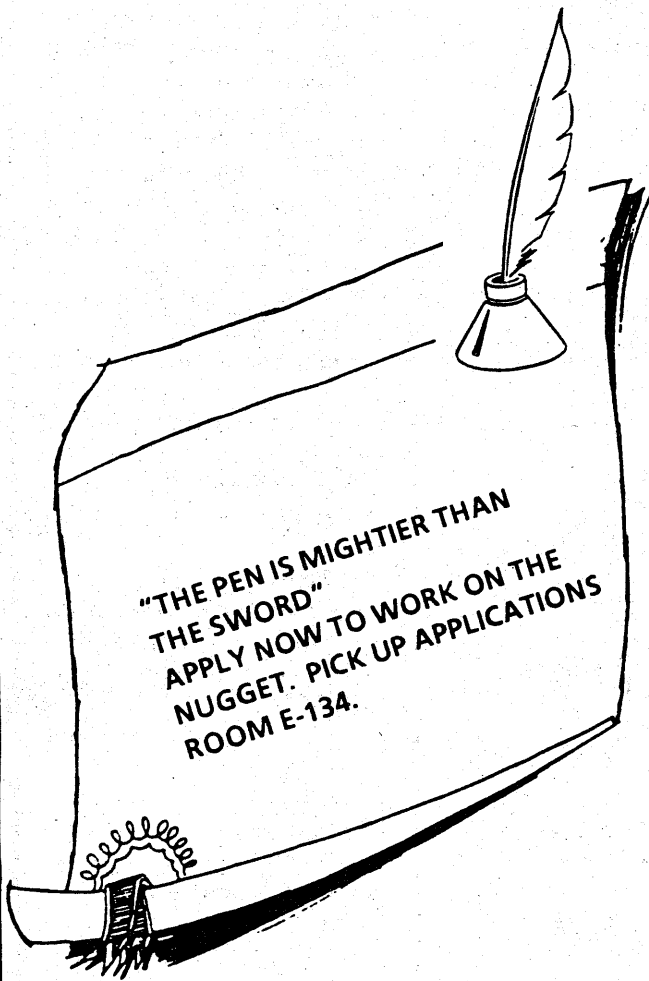

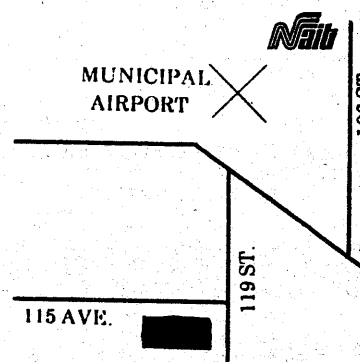

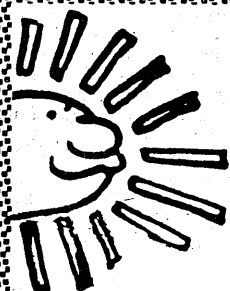

# History of NAIT CCAA Titles

The domination of the NAIT Oaks in CCAA Hockey continued as the team captured their fifth CCAA National Championship in nine seasons last weekend. The Oaks have captured more national titles in hockey than any other Canadian college.

In 1981-82, the Oaks won their first national title defeating the Seneca Braves in the CCAA Hockey National Tournament final played at Calgary.

In 1984-85, the Oaks triumphed over the Victoriaville Vulkins in the CCAA Hockey National Tournament final played at Moose Jaw to bring home their second national crown. The victory over Victoriaville capped off a perfect record of 33 wins and no losses in regular season and playoffs.

In 1985-86, the Oaks etched their name into the CCAA hockey trophy for the third time, after they retained their national title at the CCAA Hockey National Tournament played in Kamloops. The Oaks defeated the Humber Hawks in the final to become the first college to win back-to-back national titles since the Red Deer College Kings turned the trick in 1978-79 and 1979-80.

In 1988-89, the Oaks hosted the CCAA National Championships and captured their fourth national title. In the final, the Oaks edged the Red Deer College Kings to become the first college to win four titles in CCAA hockey.

In 1989-90, the Oaks won their fifth title when they nipped the Humber Hawks two games to one in the inaugural best of three series.

The NAIT Oaks of the ACAC and the Humber Hawks of the OCAA met in the best-of-three championship final series which went down to the wire. All games were decided by one goal and two of the games went into overtime. The hockey was a pleasant change from the lopsided tournament games of past years.

The change was deemed necessary as a number of provinces have stopped

sending representatives to nationals. In 1984-85, seven provinces were represented at the CCAA Hockey Nationals in Moose Jaw. Since then, Manitoba, Quebec, Nova Scotia, and British Columbia have fallen by the wayside leaving only Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Ontario to compete for a national title.

With only three provinces competing in the sport, there are strong overtures from non-competing provinces to drop hockey as a national championship sport. To go ahead with such a motion would be the kiss of death for the CCAA.

Hockey provides the best opportunity for the CCAA to showcase the outstanding talent of players and coaches. If the CCAA would have its wheels going forward instead of backward, the national championships could be televised across the nation. As a result, the CCAA could increase its stature and heighten its profile.

Keep the national championships and get rid of the deadwood at the CCAA.

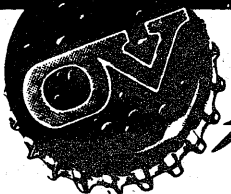

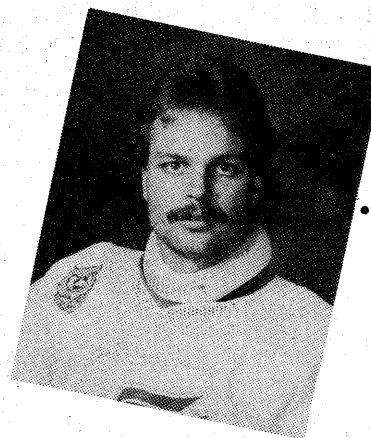
