Once again the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology and the University of Alberta are organizing Shinerama to raise funds for cystic fibrosis research.

### What is Shinerama?

Shinerama is a National fundraising event involving more than 60 campuses across Canada and representing 20,000 students. Last year over \$617,000 was raised Nationally to support the Foundations programs. This year at NAIT we hope to raise over \$15,000.

### Facts About Cystic Fibrosis

- cystic fibrosis takes the lives of more Canadian children and young adults than any other inherited disease, primarily attacking the lungs and the digestive system.
- one in 25 Canadians carries the gene for cystic Fibrosis.
- there is no known cure or control

for cystic fibrosis.

• those living with CF must undergo rigorous therapy programs every day just to stay alive. In order to achieve our fundraising goal at NAIT we need volunteers!!! Shinerama is a great way to meet new people, support a vital health charity, and have serious fun. Shinerama week runs from Sept 18 to Sept 25 with several events planned as follows:






# Don't Get Your Bike Ripped Off!
