
The hot microwave issue has been discussed with Food Service and Nutrition. A letter is to be written to Tara Tanguay, President, to install another microwave in the North lobby.



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

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

This race was an opportunity for the team to look at the ACAC Championship course before the event, which will be held in two weeks on Oct. 18 in Grande Prairie. Things are looking up as we get faster and faster each week. Maybe there is a medal possibility for us at the ACAC Championships. Next weekend we travel to Lac La Biche for the last of the exhibition races.







A few weeks ago there




