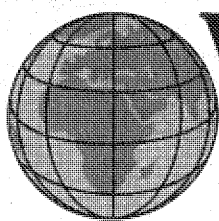

Saturday, September 22, just before midnight the sound of a smoke detector in an apartment near 119th Ave. and 103rd Street alerted Phong Ka. He awoke his sleeping roommate, Nathan

Buzik, and they proceeded outside where everyone was gathered. Flames and smoke could be seen coming from a basement suite window. Someone believed that there were children still inside the suite. Ka, Buzik and a third person headed back into the burning building to find two young boys sleeping in the living room. Both boys, 6 and 10, were unaware at how close they came to dying.

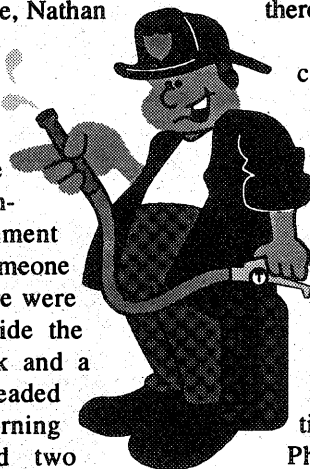
Ka and Buzik had just moved into the building, and had

never met these boys previous to the incident. Ka, a CST (computer systems tech.) student said "It's nothing. Anybody would have done it. We were just there".

The blaze was caused by their 9 year old brother who was igniting paper and rags with the element from the stove. Police said that all three boys were left home alone, and were later taken to child welfare.

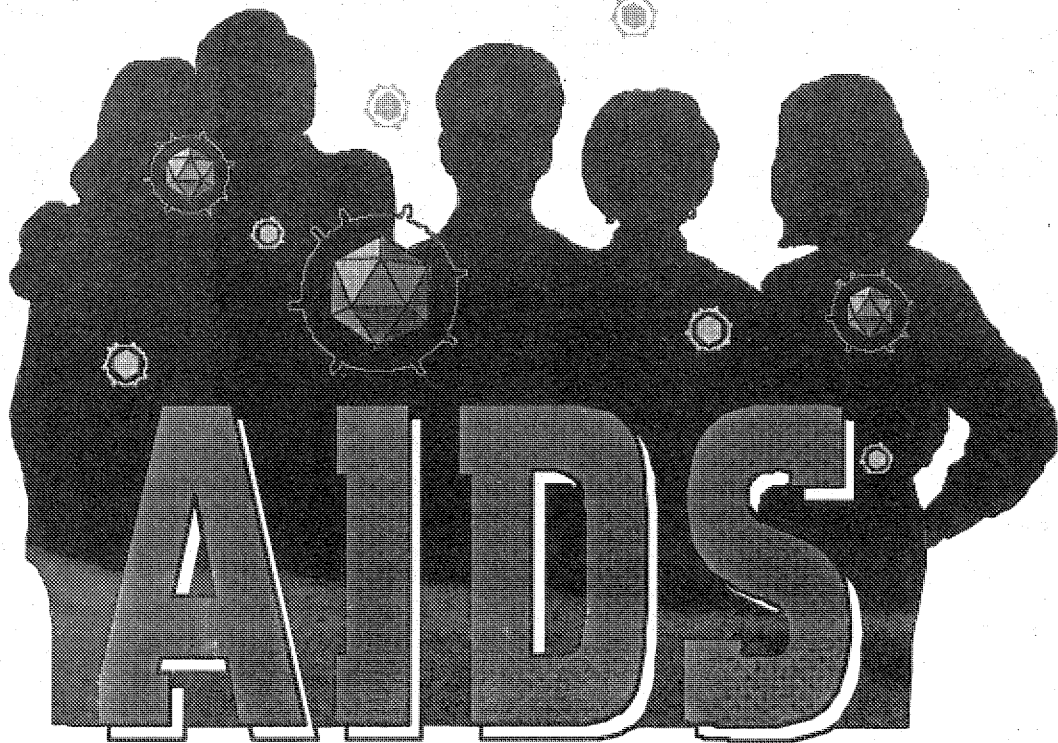

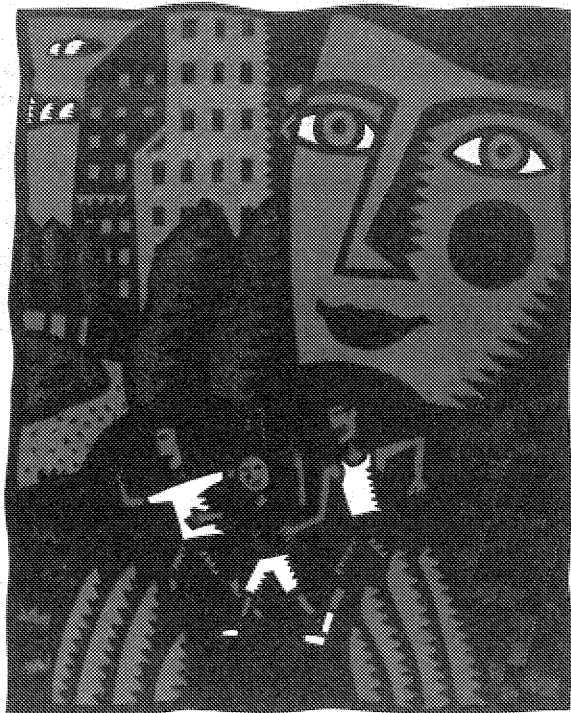

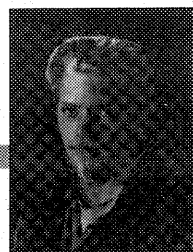
a non-smoking environment. P.S. Hyde, I'd like to see you run a lap around the track. (J.O.)

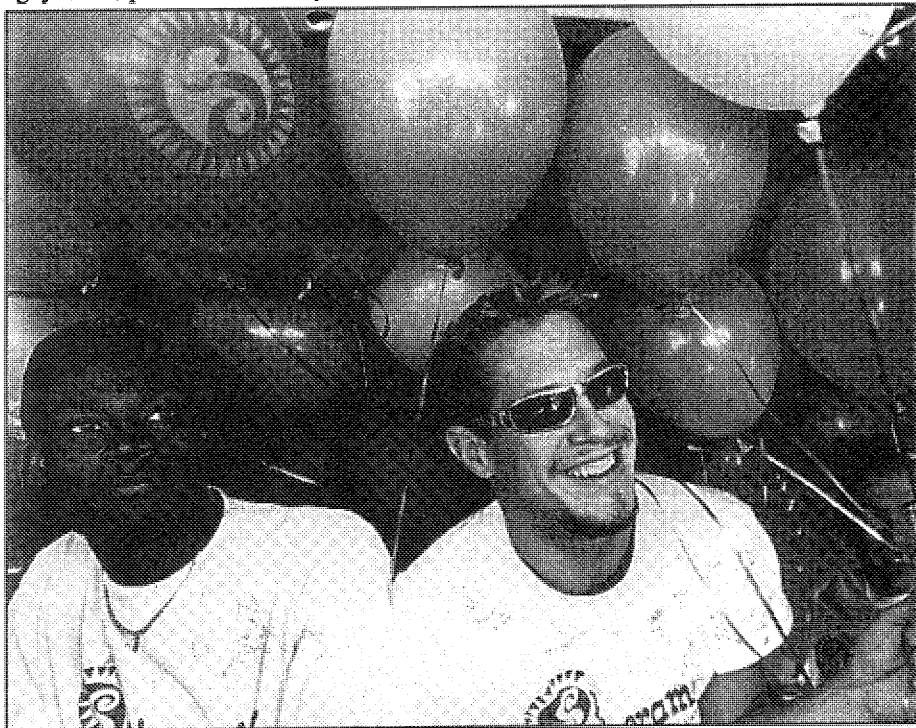

I think that me and Ugly just have some personal differences to work out and only time will tell if we both have what it takes to make this relationship work. Thanks for your letter, Ugly.



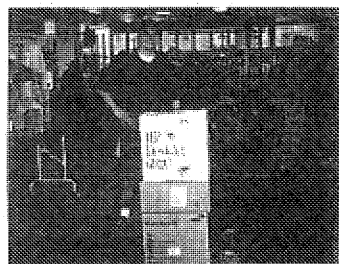

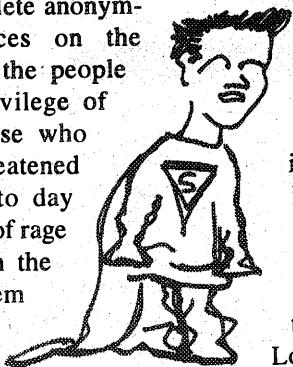

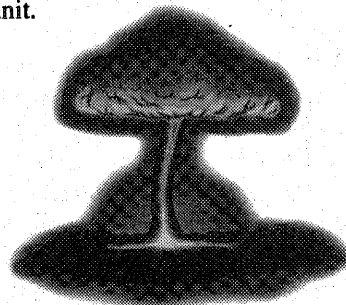
Not while little Billy Gates is around (I heard Billy was quite the D&D player in his day).


Who decides what is right or wrong? What is moral or immoral? What is normal or freakish? The government, that's who.

Book Review: *Dick For A Day: What Would You Do If You Had One?*

Edited by: Fiona Giles, copyright 1997

Book Dedication: To My Dick

"Loved, hated, played with—discussed and disgusting, adored and reviled—the penis inspires controversy and ambivalence as much as it represents the possibility of new life, the best of procreative value, and the worst of patriarchal excess. It can be the magic wand that bestows pleasure and love—or the brutal or indifferent instrument of abuse and pain; women's experience of the penis ranges from the sublime to the ridiculous, from the transcendent to the mundane."

The book, *Dick For A Day*, examines and ponders responses from a group of prominent women (with input from men), asked, "What would you do if you woke up with a penis?" This compilation of opinions poses arguments, fantasies, "gender-benders", and comments on accelerated temporary masculinity. A number of well-known professionals contributed: lawyers, writers, artists, teachers, and therapists. *Dick For A Day* features chronicles, hypotheses, stories, and opinions based on each person's own experience and view of the penis. Each chapter bears a suggestive title as to the content, such as, "Snow White and Her

Seven Dicks", "A Fairy Tale of Tails", "Amy's Inches", "Penis Parlor", and "Superdick". There are also chapters titled after Jackie O and Marilyn Monroe.

It was interesting, yet not surprising, that the most popular response among women was that if they had a dick for a day, they would definitely find another woman to put it into. After all, the penis is a symbol of fertility.

One typical response was, "I'd pee all over the bathroom, the walls, the floor—everywhere! Then I'd make my four brothers clean up, just like I always had to do after them." Another unique response was, "If I had a dick for a day, or any amount of time, I would stick it to my forehead and parade around the way its regular owners do."

Dick does not promote penis envy, yet it does not bash taking pride in a penis. In fact, it is concluded that many men take their penis for granted. *Dick For A Day* entertains an idea, reveals what women really think of the phallus as an anatomical object and cultural archetype, and analyzes its potential to please. The focus is also placed on constraints, freedoms, pressures, powers, and the ultimate mystery of the thing. This is usually left to a woman's imagination, which is why Giles decided to pursue answers. Male anxiety on castration, impotence, and inadequacy is also touched on without shame to men. The subject matter in *Dick* is classically pornographic; the intent was to analyze the effect on personality and social interaction. And it does do this. The results are diverse, which

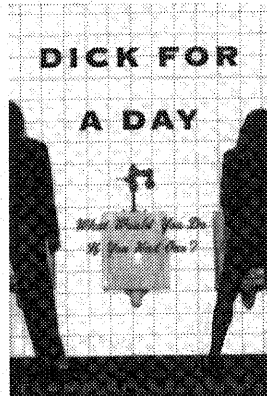
gives this book many dimensions reversing a pattern of females being in the sexual spotlight. "Penis's are rarely rhapsodized about, philosophized upon, or made the subject of love".... "Theories share a weakness—the assumption that the owner of a clitoris or penis signifies—and will always, inevitably signify an opposition of experience and a conflict of interests."

Dick For A Day contains diagrams, artwork, short stories, essays, poetry, cartoons, and photos. The research compiled was very thorough in the preparation of *Dick*. A definite asset to the production of the book is that clinical terms and jargon are avoided. The text is very blatant, and terms are often derogatory; *Dick* doesn't sugarcoat anything. The writing style is strong as well and flows easily with great continuity and consistency throughout.

Although *Dick For A Day* is based on extensive study and re-

search, this book is not for everyone. Even though it contains hints of amusement, it borders smut at times. I also wouldn't say that this book is educational; it is more for curiosity or entertainment purposes. In this case, the title is self-explanatory as to the topics covered. If you wince at reading about excessive ejaculation, masturbation, erections, sex stories, or detailed female/male graphics, then this is not the book to pick up for bedtime reading. However, if you have wondered or wished that you could have a dick for a day, no

other book would be better suited for you. The quotes from professionals in *Dick* are somewhat humorous, but not altogether enlightening. As for the stories, if you go into a locker room or ladies bathroom, you'll hear the exact same thing. As for myself,—(an excerpt from the book)—"If I had a dick for a day, I would sit at home quietly and wait for it to go away."

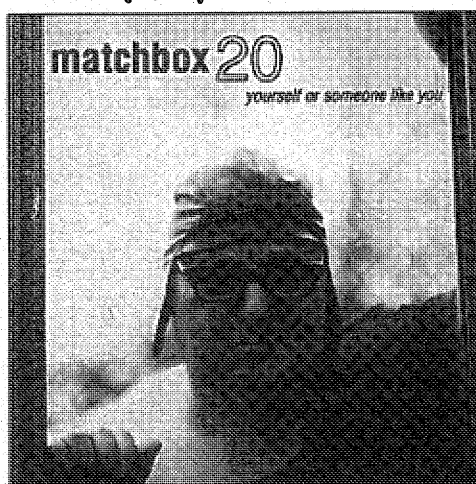

Though the music is not spectacular, the music they play is well suited for the songs they write. I really liked some of their other songs such as "Real World" and "3 am". They have that kind of coffee drinking, bookstore, small-town pub, mel-low and relaxed kinda sound. If that makes any sense.

I would recommend this CD to anyone who enjoys listening to meaningful and happy songs.

Heavenly Records

I first noticed Beth Orton's name neatly hidden amongst the credits of the first Chemical Brothers CD "Exit Planet Dust". She was the mournful, haunting voice on the closing track.

But Orton, on her debut "Trailer Park", relies more on traditional, almost folk, melodies than computer generated electronica.

This is definitely a "stay-at-home" record. Even with production by UK dance maestro Andy Weatherall (who wisely de-emphasizes his role), only the first track (also the first single) "She Cries Your Name" could possibly turn up on a dance floor.

Listening to this CD, Orton's singing voice could be

compared to that of Delores from the Cranberries. But Beth Orton's celtic tone is, by far, more relaxing, reserved and, in my opinion, more beautiful.

This album succeeds as a whole, not just as an experiment to mix trippy beats with folk songs. Every now and then you hear a bit of violin or a splash of mandolin, but it all merges wonderfully with the spacey atmospheric ambience.

Near the end, there is the album's only cover - A great soulful rendition of Phil Spector's "I Wish I Never Saw the Sunshine" and the concluding with the beautifully bleak "Galaxy of Emptiness".

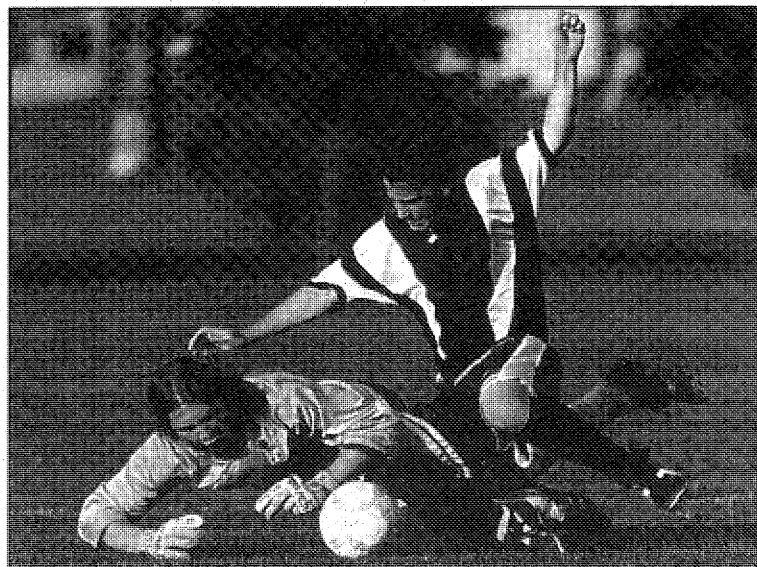

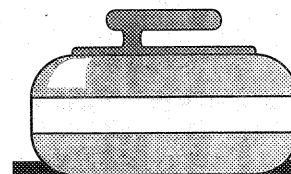
Lady Ooks Tie One Loose One

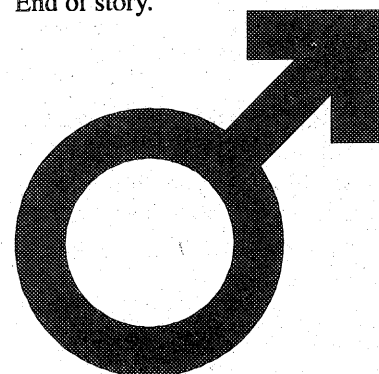
I have always wondered about the origins of jean shorts. Were they a gift to man kind from the Gods, or just some random blessing of the fates?

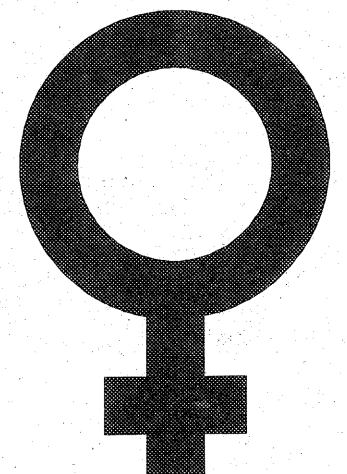

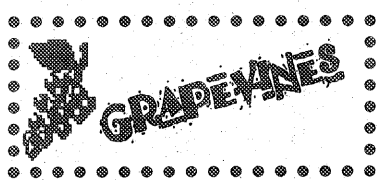
