

she was nervous. Overall, Helene believes that it has been a fun experience, with a taste of what models go through. Helene's boyfriend of two years was not sure of her







Study Skills - Part 1

This article is the first in a series of articles on study skills written by Counselors from NAIT Student Counseling Centre.

Many students go through their entire academic careers thinking they don't have the "smarts" that many of their classmates possess. While there are several reasons for students with similar mental abilities having dramatically different marks in school, a major difference lies in their knowledge and use of study skills. A student who develops and practices effective study skills can reap dramatic improvements in their marks.

Study skills and techniques are the "tools of the trade" for students; however, they are only effective if they are practiced consistently. Give the techniques (that will be outlines over the next few weeks) a try and if they work for

you-keep them. Otherwise, discard them and experiment with a different "tool."

A good place to start before you focus on learning study skills is to first examine your motivation for being in school and be clear on your career path. Students who are the most successful at NAIT are here because they want to be and are confident that the program they are currently taking, will aid them in their career journey. Also give consideration to whether this is a good time for you to be in school in relation to what is presently going on in your life. Are you academically and attitudinal prepared to meet the challenges, commitments and sacrifices that are required to be a successful NAIT student?

Over the next few weeks we will examine many study skills techniques. Here are some of the basics you may want to put in place immediately.

Where to study

Establish a regular study place and time. Choose a study area that is conductive to study. Optimally this should include:

Good lighting

- a comfortable chair (not too comfortable!)
- a space away from interruption and external distractions. eg: TV, stereo, phone. a desk or table space that is used solely
- a study space where you can remain alert (ie. not on your bed)

When to study

- study at a time of day when you are best able to concentrate
- study for as long as you can effectively study between study breaks (not more than one hour)
- » tako 10 to 15 minute study breaks between study sessions which typically range from approximately 30 to 60 minutes
- ouvoid "marathon" studying the longer you study without a break, the less effective your study time will be

What to study

- use your course outline as a guide
- ask your instructor what areas will be covered on the exam
- ouse the table of contents, headlines and summaries in your textbook as guides

As a result of the numerous locker thefts from student lockers in the Cooking Program, staff requested that students be aware of any suspicious persons in the change ar-



Sexual Awareness

ometimes the education process of careless sexual behavior is difficult, but with Sexual Awareness Week (January 12-16th) in place, valuable information available may help save a life. Myths have often been passed down, and it is important to educate and inform people of these misconceptions.

Some misconceptions about birth control, sexually transmitted diseases and sex in general, arise due to lack of education, and misunderstandings concerning mechanical aspects or side effects.

The greatest number of misconceptions reported concerned the three most effective methods of birth controlsterilization, oral contraception, and the IUD. Condoms offer effective protection against not only pregnancy, but from sexually transmitted diseases (STD's), including HIV/AIDS. Health care educators are faced with sorting accurate information from misinformation. The effectiveness of condoms is questioned by some who believe that abstinence or one faithful partner is the only acceptable form of protection. CONDOM BARRIER EF-FECTIVENESS (FLUID TRANSFER PREVENTION) IS AT LEAST 10,000 TIMES BETTER THAN NOT USING A CONDOM AT ALL. There is now a female condom available, which is a polyurethane sheath which lines the vaginal wall. In limited testing, the female condom has been 88% effective in preventing pregnancy and is not permeated by

HIV or Hepatitis B virus.

Sexually transmitted diseases are a group of infections that affect the sex organs and genital areas, that are causes by germs or organisms such as bacteria and viruses. Anyone who has intimate sexual contact with an infected person may develop an STD. Most STD's can be cured, but the best way of preventing it is to be informed about the diseases and to take responsibility for sexual activity. This means knowing the facts about STD's, and seeking medical care as soon as an STD is suspected.

Choosing to be sexually active means accepting responsibilities. Practicing safer sex will help to maintain your sexual health. If you suspect you have been exposed to a sexually transmitted disease:

- seek medical treatment at an STD clinic or family doctor
- do not have any sexual contact until treatment is completed (follow-up exam completed)


This weekend, the mens volleyball team continued in their winning ways, sweeping The King's University college Eagles twice, but it wasn't easy.
