NAIT Business Students Busted by RCMP

Four NAIT business students were arrested last Tuesday after local RCMP units became aware of a black market drug distribution ring circulating around the city.

This was not a typical drug bust though. The police, who had not been informed as to what type of substances they would find, were shocked to discover that the students were selling Viagra without a license.

The RCMPs were tipped off about the distribution ring by an anonymous, disgruntled, former customer of the students. Apparently, they were receiving shipments of "the little blue pill" from Mexico where it is manufactured. Instead of the typical price of \$12 to \$15 per pill, the young crimi-

nals were charging a flat rate of \$10 per dose. The ring had been in operation for approximately three months and had amassed over \$100,000 in cash.

The students, whose names cannot be released until family members are properly notified, range in age from 19 to 23, and were using the parkade building as their place of business.

"I knew something was strange when their beepers kept going off," said one instructor who wished to remain unidentified.

The group was comprised of three males and one female and their court dates will be announced in the near future. RCMP Special Units Investigator Paul Walker was quoted as saying, "This is the worst April fool's story I've heard in a long time." He's probably right.

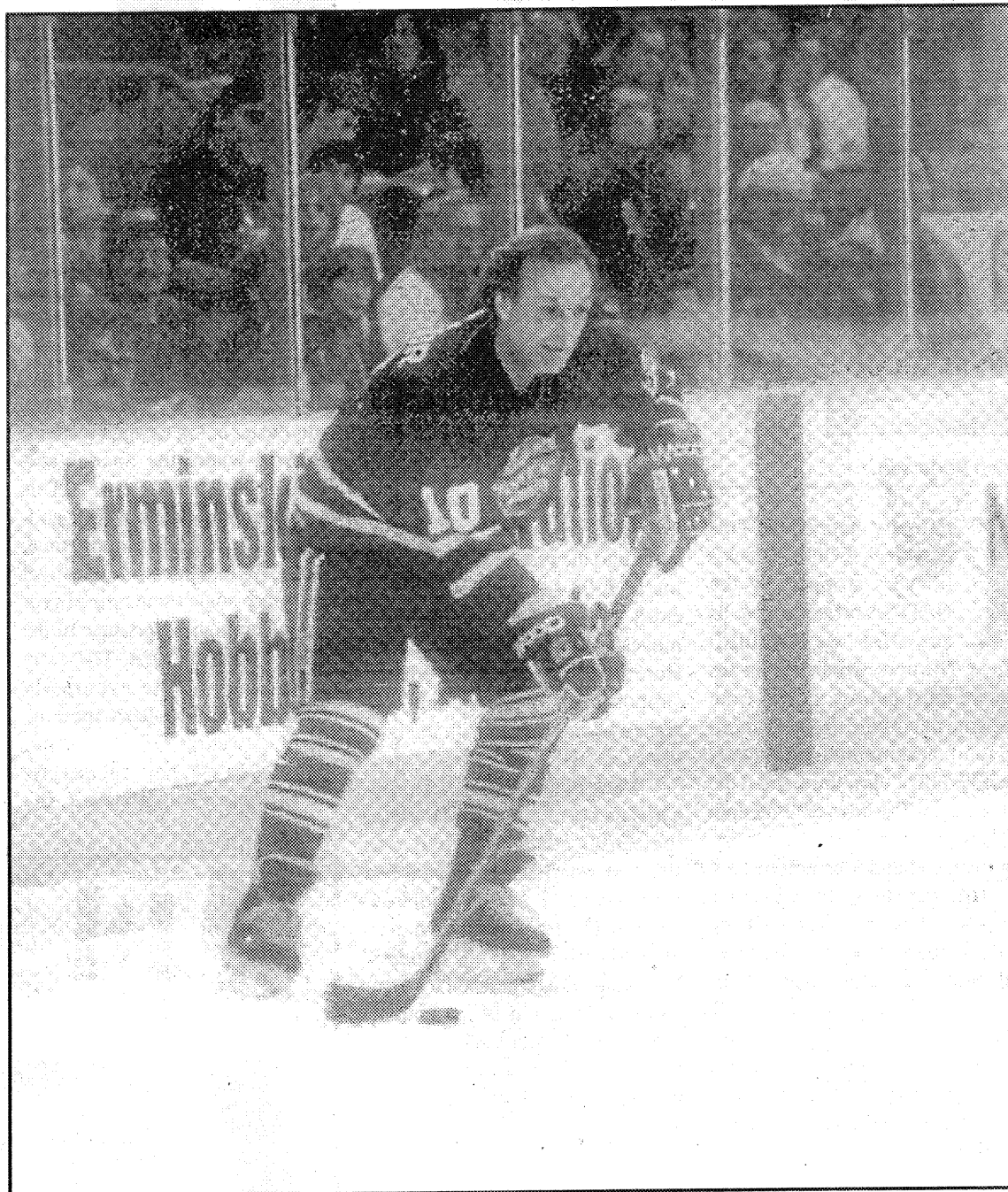

Eggs and Rabbits?

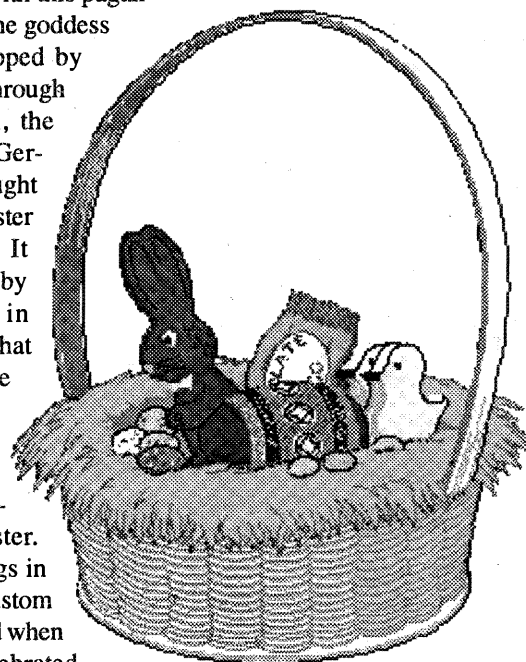

• The Chevy Corvair — Coffin Model?

Three decades after Ralph Nader portrayed the Chevrolet Corvair as a casket on wheels in his book, "Unsafe At Any Speed," an 84-year-old woman was laid to rest in her beloved 1962 model. The widow and mother of three drove the rear-engine white car around the town of Tiverton, Rhode Island, population 14,000, for 36 years. "She just loved the car. She didn't care what it cost to fix. If the car was broken, she wasn't one to ask you how much: Just fix it," recalls one of the owners of the Tiverton Auto Body Shop. Mourners at the woman's burial both wiped tears and grinned as six police officers acting as pallbearers slid the inlaid wood coffin into an opening in the rear of the Corvair, which had been altered to accommodate the casket. The car was then lowered into the ground with a crane. An old handicapped licence plate was then removed and handed to the deceased woman's relatives. While it may seem odd for someone to request being buried in a car, according to the police chief of Tiverton, "it's just normal because she's embedded it in our minds." The woman, up until the time of her death, served as a police matron tending to women prisoners. She will be greatly missed.

• It Pays To Not Eat Hospital Food

A Winnipeg woman has found a way to dine well in a surgical ward — bring in fast food and let the hospital pay. After spending a few days in Concordia General Hospital for minor surgery and complaining that her meals always arrived cold, she asked her husband to pick something up from a fast food outlet. He spent \$7.63 on a couple of burgers and fries. The day after her release, the woman phoned the hospital to complain about the food, and she received a cheque for \$7.63 in the mail a few days later. The woman says when she called she didn't ask to be reimbursed, but thought it was a nice gesture. The executive director at the hospital called it a "goodwill gesture" for a patient who complained. Spokesmen for other Winnipeg area hospitals commented that they certainly

wouldn't reimburse a patient who had brought in food. Guess the woman was lucky after all.

• Gravemate Wanted Ad Too Successful

A divorced London man who advertised for a non-smoking female "gravemate" to share his cemetery plot in Ireland has been inundated with replies. The 65-year-old chiropodist bought the double plot in 1994 when he was still married and he intended that he and his wife use it. After his divorce though, he placed an ad in the local paper titled, "A Grave Sale." It read: "One single grave, unoccupied. Spacious room for two occupants. One half of plot now for sale. Present single owner seeks (at occupancy only) one female gravemate. First one in takes bottom berth. Garlic eaters and smokers need not apply." So far, the man has gotten 23 replies from women across the world who were interested in spending time with him in this life as well as the next one; and though he claims the ad was all a hoax, he's actually thinking of taking one of the offers up.

"I ask what their name is, and I then try to get a sense of what they're like." So far, Finney has blessed a dog's strength, a horse's speed, a cat's mystery, and a rabbit's softness. One couple who showed up at the church with three puppies, marked their 33rd pet blessing. They said their poodle and terrier lived to be 19 and 18 when they had them blessed. Angels In Blue?

Edmonton Police detective Ron Robertson has sent a nation-wide letter which warns police in other major Canadian centres that the Hell's Angels motorcycle gang may have informants within the Edmonton Police service.

The letter, which was dated January 10 of this year, doesn't give out any specifics on the Angels' activities in the Edmonton area but does suggest that "there is

evidence establishing a direct link between certain Edmonton Police Service members and the Hell's Angels or their associates."

Robertson was part of the Integrated Intelligence Section, which is a combined Edmonton Police/RCMP venture. The group

specializes in biker gangs and their activities.

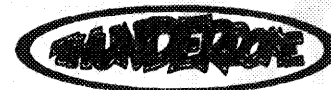

All of these actions are in hiatus for a while because Robertson's superior, Superintendent Hugh Richards, was removed from his position shortly afterwards. He is now facing criminal charges on an unrelated matter.

Investigators from other police groups across Canada say that the letter has made them cautious in sharing any sensitive matters regarding the Angels and other gangs with officers in Edmonton.

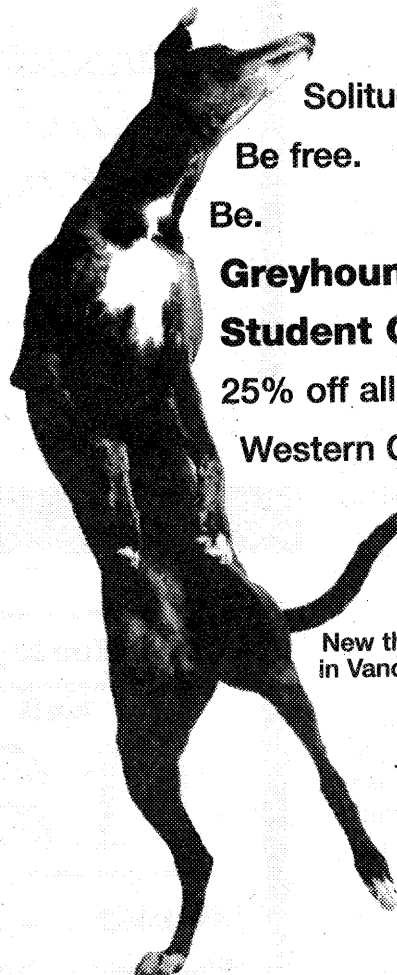
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MURDER OR MERCY —

Does Kevorkian Deserve to go to Prison?

Now that we've had our April Fool's fun, I thought I'd move on to something slightly more serious. I suppose it doesn't get much more serious than euthanasia — otherwise known as mercy killing. In the last five to ten years, it stands beside abortion and, more recently, cloning, as the top ethical and moral debates of our time.

This article comes directly on the heels of a major decision in the U.S., where, last Friday, Dr. Jack Kevorkian was found guilty of second-degree murder in Michigan. Kevorkian helped a 52-year-old man suffering from Lou Gehrig's disease commit suicide.

Kevorkian (referred to by some as Dr. Death), is easily the most famous practitioner of euthanasia in American history. He claims to have helped over 130 people commit suicide with the use of a machine that injects a person with lethal amounts of several different chemicals, thereby stopping the person's heart. This was the fifth trial for Dr. Kevorkian. Three previous times he was acquitted (with one mistrial) leading up to his conviction.

Kevorkian now faces a minimum sentence of ten years and a maximum of twenty-five years in prison. Either way will likely be a final setback in the 70-year-old's fight against the U.S. government.

If Kevorkian loses his appeal, another person will almost certainly take up his plight. Considering that Canada's laws regarding euthanasia are similar to our American neighbours, people such

as Robert Latimer, a Saskatchewan man who ended his permanently handicapped daughter's life by asphyxiating her with carbon monoxide, will certainly face lengthy jail terms.

Is this justice? Who's to say? Should Canada hold a referendum on the issue? If so, would a slim majority be proper grounds for changing the law? These are the issues and questions that will need to be addressed sooner or later. It's a very personal issue where everyone should definitely have an opinion. It's important to each and every one of us because any one

of us could be placed in that situation on any given day. You get hit by a car on the way home today, and, the next thing you know, you can't walk, talk, eat, go to the bathroom, or even breathe without help. You're in pain every waking moment. Would you want to continue living in this condition or would you want someone to help you die? It's a tough question, no doubt about it; but one that we as a society are going to have to discuss and answer if we ever want this to stop being an issue.

The best resource available to those of us who are not elected officials is to write your Member of Parliament and tell him or her your opinion. That's what they get paid for — right? If enough people

make it an issue, the boys and girls on Parliament Hill will have no choice but to address it. Until then, my guess is there will always be a Dr. Kevorkian ending people's lives in an office or basement somewhere.

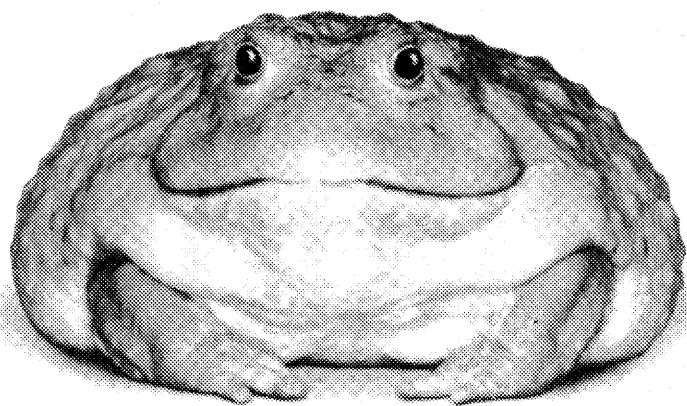

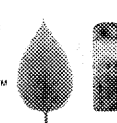

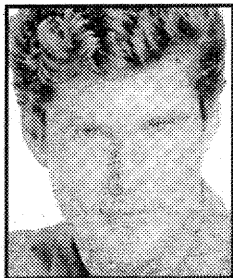

New Activities Centre on the Way:

Sports at NAIT Will Have a New Look in 2000

The last three years of my life, I have studied at NAIT and played hockey for the Oaks. My memories and my diploma in Marketing will keep me going the next few years as I attempt to conquer the so-called "Real World." Now, after attending a brass meeting last week, do I ever wish I was returning to NAIT for another year. Here is what is planned for the

Summer of 1999:

- A complete renovation of the current Activities Centre.
- A complete renovation of the current Gymnasium.
- A complete makeover of the existing soccer field.

The first renovation project will begin as soon as the school year ends. A team from Michigan State University will lead the way, modelling our Activities Centre after their arena, weight room, running facilities, and, new to NAIT — tennis courts. Here are some of the specs:

- The arena will hold 5,000 spectators, with a new concession stand to be built. A new dressing room will also be built for the Oaks with 25 wood stalls, a small weight training area, equipment room, and a games/

study area. The room will also have an attached trainer's room with two hot tubs and four massage tables.

- The weight room will be renovated to ten times the size of the existing cramped sweatbox. State-of-the-art equipment will be brought in from the States. One-hundred new rowers, exercise bikes, and treadmills will also be in place.
- A new, indoor running track will be built on top of the arena, with a see-through roof to overlook the downtown sky.
- The new Activities Centre will now have eight indoor tennis courts with dressing rooms and showers.

The second project begins in mid-May with the complete renovation of the Gymnasium. Here

are the specs for that:

- The new Gym will seat 2,000, with full service concessions. The Oaks' Men's and Ladies' Basketball and Volleyball teams will have new team rooms with an adjacent weight room and players' lounge. The Badminton team will also be fitted with a team room.
- A new trainer's facility will also be put in place to assist injured players.

The last of the three projects will also start as soon as the school semester ends. Here are the final specs:

- The existing soccer field will be torn up and re-done by expert pitch engineers from Brazil.
- A grandstand will be put in place with 1,000 seat capacity.
- Team rooms for both Men's and

Ladies' Soccer will be underground. The rooms will have an attached players' lounge.

The project was a big surprise to most of the people attending the announcement meeting last week. Money, of course, was the big question — "Where did it come from?" NAIT brass proceeded to tell everyone that the money for the project was donated anonymously by an unknown source. A letter came with the donation, specifying to the NAIT president what was to be done with the money. In the letter, the unknown source also explained how they would like to see the project completed this summer. Renovations will begin at the end of April, and man, I wish I was coming back next year! *But, whatever, back to the "Real World" now — Happy April Fools!*

I couldn't be more thrilled to have been handed this disc. It's more than just music to me; it's more like a cultural document. Karl Jenkins, a Welshman, took it upon himself

to focus his sounds by defocusing on just one thing. His first disc, *Adiemus - Songs of Sanctuary* is a collection of ethnic vocals and percussion with a string orchestra accompaniment. Then came *Adiemus II - Cantata Mundi*, which was essentially the same deal with more attention from double woodwind and brass, plus a full symphony orchestra. Yikes! Both albums sold millions, which is not bad for classical, as far as I'm concerned.

Now we have *Adiemus III - Dances of Time*, a journey through the multicultural history of dance. Get this - an African tango, a Viennese waltz, a Spanish saraband (called *Zarabanda*). There's *Un Bolero Azul* (Blue Bolero) which has the sultry bolero rhythms en-

hanced by bluesy 1920's harmonies. Of course, there are other themes like the rain dance and the square dance, but the concept holds true. By showcasing different dance music pieces from around the world from the last six centuries, Jenkins has created a catalogue of both timelessness and timeliness. Having the London Symphony Orchestra back you up doesn't hurt either.

Bear in mind that this is filed under classical with a big "C" but don't let that deter you. It can be a wonderful addition to anyone's collection of eccentric yet enriching auditory stimulation. Put it right next to your Green Day album!

At the very least, you can use it to easily impress dates.

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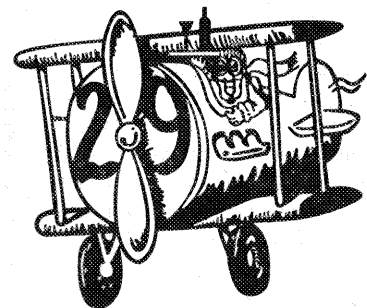
