After hanging up the phone I realized that Roger made me see


Anyway, I apologize to the fans for my resignation but be rest assured this concept album's gonna make up for everything.



Pepsi to Test-Market Marijuana Vending Machines





It's kind of funny when someone sees me writing and they ask me with a puzzled look on their face "You're left-handed?" like it was some sort of crime or something.




Long known as one of Canada's best live bands, the Watchmen plowed through song after song, with little time




spotted dressed in plastic checkered table-clothes. My personal favorite was the already-impressively-drunk guy dressed as a




Video Game Review

that you are someone who is just holding a controller and pressing buttons.







From the Bottom to the Top



Once Ryan finally gets with Ashley, he realizes how much he really doesn't want to be with her. Not only that, but




Hyperdramatic **EMI Music Canada**


Lucas announces; Darth Maul Returns in Episode II




