It is clear that Edmonton's mayor has a soft spot for his birthplace.


If you look at these unedited documents, you can see Iveson's selfish plans to expand the LRT directly to his childhood home in St. Albert.

"Strong" trademarked for all tragedies

Oil & Gas Workers Train Al

In the growing world of Artificial Intelligence, one industry that is blossoming with investment is the oil and gas sector.

Alberta's oil and gas workers are known for their hard-working, can-do spirit.

But, these "intangible" characteristics are proving to be difficult for many of these tech companies to replicate. According to a high-ranking source within a leading oil field company, the operating systems do not experience difficulty with routine workplace tasks, but currently "lack the spirit and pugnacity" needed to fit into these working environments.

To combat this problem, a team of seasoned, non-IT, oil field workers have been tasked with getting these AI systems up to speed in the hustle-and-bustle of a drill-site.

They are called TAINT: "Training Artificial Intelligence with Nasty Tendencies." "One of the things we're teaching them

Lacrosse team bitten

Reptile experts are concerned that the National Lacrosse League's newest expansion team is not representing crocodiles accurately.

The Florida Crocodiles revealed the team's official jersey Saturday night. The emblem depicts an angry crocodile with a man's arm in its mouth.

"It is very rare for crocodilians to attack without being provoked, of course it does happen ... but to make such a blanketing visual statement as the jerseys did, is completely unfair to these beautiful beings," said Dr. Saint-Marie of the Herpetology Institute.

A petition has been created requesting a rebranding of the logo to better represent the corresponding mascot. With over 100,000 signatures in the last 24 hours, this movement continues to grow in popularity.

The first game of the Crocodiles' inaugural season will be against the Columbus Mosquitoes, who have been roped into the controversy due to their branding being portrayed as a particularly peaceful one. One argument has brought up scientific evidence which proves that every year more people are bitten and killed by mosquitoes than crocodiles. Around 700,000 people are killed annually by mosquitoes, compared to only 1,000 by crocodiles.

"Mosquitoes have a long history of colonizing places they are unwanted," said entomologist, Dr. Longboat. "Other qualities of mosquitoes include spilling the blood of others, bringing a gift of disease, and killing species



indigenous to the area, to the point of near-extinction."

Although many agree that the misrepresentation needs to be looked at, some believe that it is a waste of time and resources.

"Having to order and create new jerseys and merch for a couple people to feel better is stupid! Plus the Mosquitoes are gonna kill the Crocs anyways. GO MOSQUITOES!, Whoo," said John Cabot, a Mosquitoes supporter.

The controversy between these teams is not only in the emblems on their uniforms.

Although they are very new to the league, the Crocodiles have already been fleeced in several trades with the Mosquitoes.

"The Mosquitoes have a long history of being greedy and deceptive with trades," said a TSN analyst. "It's unfair, the Mosquitoes already have more than enough resources to thrive – this is a really bad way to start a relationship with a fellow team."

Lacrosse has a storied, and proud history in Florida and a pro team has long been awaited. Much of Florida is not in favour of the poor depiction of crocodiles in their logo, but they do believe a stronger, more accurate representation of their stateanimal would be acceptable. Regardless, with the jersey controversy and the greed of the Mosquitoes, it may be difficult to preserve the traditions of the small-market Florida lacrosse community.

"It's going to be tough for the Crocs to keep the traditions of Florida lacrosse alive if major-market teams like the Mosquitoes keep trying to impose their city's culture on these smaller markets and force them to assimilate within the league," said the TSN analyst.

The league is currently looking into both of the team's emblems and if the history behind them makes them appropriate to be used as a logo.

The entire sports world will be watching to see if the teams will be able to reconcile their differences on their first matchup on Thanksgiving weekend.

Ooks accused of doping

Several Ooks are under investigation after Athletics discovered a locker full of performance-enhancing drugs in a locker room.

The main suspects in the case are various international players, and an athlete recovering from testicular cancer.

The most intricate and well-preserved piece's title was translated to, *Brother Cain Tricks Sister Into Sex While Parents Are Away From Dwelling* – drawing similarities to the work done in modern 'Fauxcest' porn. A 2018 production titled, *Brother Tricks Step-Sister Into Sex While Parents Aren't Home*, features a nearly-identical plot, as do many films in this category.

Fauxcest porn refers to a genre of adult-filmmaking centred on performers role-playing as family members and engaging in sexual acts together. The genre has exploded recently with searches for "Step Mom", "Step Sister", and "Mom" all being included in Pornhub's top 10 most-searched terms of 2017; two of which sit in the Top 5.

And the discovery of Adam and Eve's descendants' adult work has only proven to provoke an even further growth in simulated-incest productions.



Since the public release of the Biblical incest porn, "930 year old dad", "55 sibling orgy", and "Sodom and Gomorrah" were the most-searched terms on Pornhub in September 2018. The searches show a direct correlation between the recent archeological findings and 2018's desire for inter-family rela-

tions, as Adam was said to have lived to 930 years old, and had 55 children.

The artifacts have even shook up the LGBTQ+ porn scene due to pieces depicting acts between Adam and Eve's 33 sons, and between their 22 daughters. "Adam and Steve" has become one of most-searched items on many gay porn sites as of September 2018.

Although controversial, sermons across the world have been incorporating these findings and audience attendance has been increasing.

"Finally a way to relate the stories of early-Christianity to the fast-moving world that we've been waiting for at the church," said a preacher.

While tablet-users only represented nine per cent of Pornhub's site visitors in 2017, the numbers have risen to nearly 30 per cent. It is believed that since stone tablets of the time were used to etch the incestous acts, porn "purists" recognized that viewing Fauxcest videos on modern tablets was the best way to consume this media.

"Music-lovers prefer to listen to their favourite artists on vinyl. We think tablets are the way early Biblical figures would have wanted us to enjoy their work," said the moderator of The Porn Purists Facebook group.

The effect these recent discoveries have had on the adult film industry has been substantial and is continually growing.

"Porn watching Christians are now able to relate to the teachings of divine creation as the serpent could represent the taboo allure of Fauxcest porn and the Forbidden Fruit would be the viewer's family member," said the preacher.



Debate follows pro-life campaign

A group of fetal-actors are outraged over the hiring of an eight-year-old actor in an upcoming pro-life campaign.

The decision has provoked a conversation in the performing arts community over whether hiring child actors is unfair to hard-working fetuses trying to make it in the business.

"It's already hard enough to find good roles for fetuses, but competing against these already-established actors is career feticide." said Abe Ortion, a representative of the SUGMA. Ortion believes that the industry's history of casting grown adults to play high school students has directly led to the trend of grown children being recruited for fetal roles.

The performer worries that these castings will create unrealistic expectations and body positivity issues for fetal actors. He believes if these parts keep going to older and older actors, people are going to lose sight of what fetuses really look like.

"Fetuses aren't flawless, put-together kids with a full head of hair – we're still coming into our own at this stage in our lives! Some of us don't even have fullyformed arms or legs yet ... heck, some of us are still embryos," said Ortion.

Hollywood has seen its fair share of fetal performers struggle under the pressure of this competitive business – many actors not even living to see their second trimester. Ortion tells us he feels the competitive stress everyday that passes in his womb.

"My mom said if I don't work on my line delivery, I won't see my own delivery," he said.

Although most fetuses' eyes are fused


shut until nearly the third trimester, Ortion believes that industry bigwigs are the ones that need to open their eyes to this problem.




