
A total of 643 boys and men from across the district attended. Our speaker was Lee Fogleman, sectional Royal Rangers commander for the Greenville section. Lee is better known to the boys as Prospector. At every district camp Prospector is there trading with the boys . . . he will take rocks and peanuts in trade for items much more valuable. Friday night Prospector challenged the boys to make the Best Trade – to accept the trade that God offered us in John 3:16. Approximately 75 boys responded to the altar call to make that trade and to accept Jesus Christ as their personal savior.
