## Chartering for 2010-2011


The Royal Rangers charter period is from September 1 through August 31 of each year. So it is about time for the Royal Rangers outposts across the district to renew their charter.

The benefits of chartering are designed to make it too expensive NOT to charter! The benefits include:

- 15% discount on national and regional events and training
- 15% discount on district Royal Rangers events and training
- The annual publication Rangers Now for each member of your outpost. There is an age-specific version of this magazine for each group in Royal Rangers
- Annual version of the Outpost Promotional Kit

Not only does your group receive these benefits, but their charter fees provide a significant source of income to the national and district Royal Rangers ministries so that we can continue providing the ministry materials and events your groups need.

## National Training for Leaders

Our district is hosting two national training opportunities for your Royal Rangers leaders this fall. Encourage your leaders to attend one or both of these events.

On August 6-7 we are hosting a World Class Outpost Seminar at Glad Tidings in Austin

This seminar is designed to expose the outpost leadership team to a successful set of practices, methods, strategies, and tools that will enable them to develop into a World Class Outpost. The greatest benefit of this event is achieved when the outpost/church leadership attends and completes this event together as a team.

On October 29-31 we are hosting one of the first ever National Rangers Ministry Camps at the Royal Rangers Camp at Lakeview

This provides instruction in basic outdoor skills and activities providing leaders with the skills needed to take their Ranger boys on exciting outpost activities outside their normal weekly meeting times. Instruction in effectively implementing the team/patrol method will be offered as a means to facilitate junior leadership development.
