Royal Rangers Pathfinder Missions Trip to Hamilton

For the second summer in a row Royal Rangers and leaders from North Texas have helped make-over a church building in our district. During the week of July 25-30, a group of men and boys from the North Texas Royal Rangers descended on Abundant

Life Assembly of God in Hamilton where Jocy Johnson is the pastor. The church building, particularly the sanctuary, needed renovations. During the week our men mentored the dozen boys on the trip in the building trades, and also in sacrificial giving to help this church body. For many of the boys, this was their first introduction to hands-on missions.

By the end of the week the entire group was tired, but they left the church with a brand new sanctuary and much needed improvements throughout the facility. One of the boys who participated stated the week gave him "the opportunity to help a church who needed the help with the repairs. I was able to learn new skills and everyone worked as a team. This showed me that a group of Royal Rangers boys and a few leaders could have a big impact on a church they do not attend."

Bro. DuBose received a glowing letter from Pastor Jocy Johnson. Quoting from his letter: "This letter is being written to commend Brother Art Sullivan for the awesome job that he and the Royal Ranger Department did...Words are inadequate to express the genuine admiration that the Church Body, along with myself, have for the leadership qualities demonstrated... Abundant Life Assembly now has a sanctuary that has been needed at this location for more than six years."



District Winter Camp
