It's dues time again, did you pay your 69 or 70 dues. If there is any question as to how much issue write us.



So. Missouri has the Daniel Boone chapter. A name has been mentioned, the Davy Crockett chapter. Members what do you think?


So. Missouri has over 50 members in their FCF chapter, Okla. has 48 members in their chapter.

NEW STEPS OF RECOGNITION
 IN F.C.F.

The National Royal Rangers Committee has recently announced plans to establish three steps of recognition in the F.C.F. program.
