

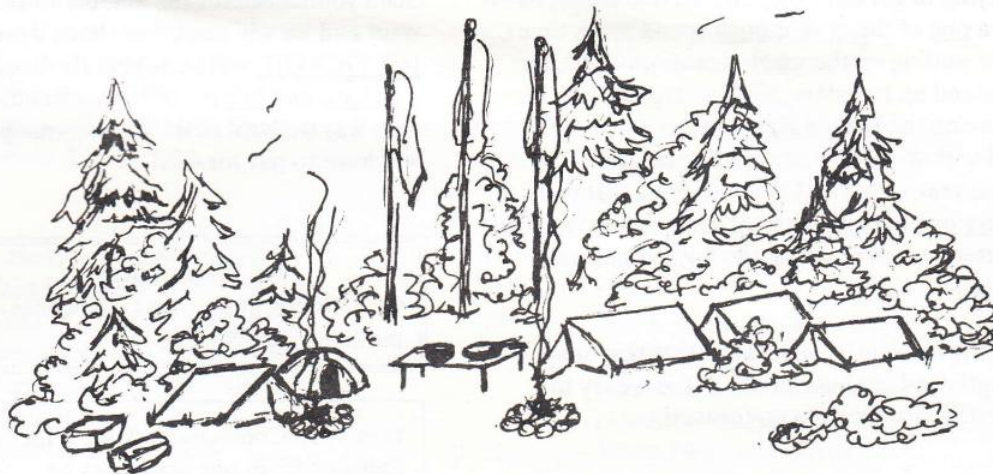

JUNE 14-15-16

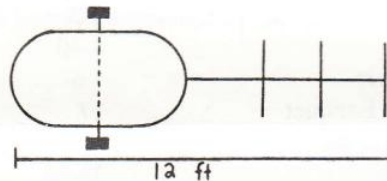
All outposts should be gearing up to bring a full contingent of Rangers to this year's North Texas District POW-WOW. This year's pageant will center around a Mexican theme to highlight this important segment of our Texan heritage and culture. Come prepared to participate in a full weekend of games, campcraft, devotions, and fellowship. Full details will be in the POW-WOW packets to be mailed May 1st.

SCHEDULE: Due to the campout being on Father's Day weekend, the pageant and FCF call out will be held on Friday night rather than Saturday night. This will enable an early departure for those who need to be in their church for Father's Day.

BIG TUB RACE: Each outpost should participate in the exciting BIG TUB RACE! This will be divided into Pioneer, TrailBlazers, Air, Sea, and Trail rangers. There will even be a commanders competition! There will be one tub per section to be used by all outposts within that section.

Rules:

1. Dimensions -



2. Wheels can be any size
3. 6 mules(boys) must pull each tub
4. 1 muleskinner must ride in the tub
5. Each BIG TUB must have a large banner/flag identifying the Outpost/Section

SECTIONAL FLAG DISPLAY: Each section will bring their flag to display at the registration booth. This will provide an exciting visual entrance to the POW-WOW for all the boys. In addition to being displayed at the registration booth, all flags will be honored at the morning assembly. Sectional flags should be 3' X 5' and represent something unique about their section. Bring your pole and bracing.

PRE-REGISTRATION:

- A \$25 pre-registration fee will be required by June 1st. If an outpost does not pre-register it will be assumed they are not coming and their campsite will be assigned to another outpost for that weekend.

- No access to the campsites will be permitted until the outpost has registered on Friday evening.

COST: The fee this year will be \$10 for each Ranger camper. If your outpost does not have a fund raiser scheduled to defray the individual cost now is the time to set one up.

Junior Leadership Training Camp

The purpose of J.L.T.C. is to give boys training in camping and leadership plus the opportunity of outstanding fellowship and adventure in the out-of-doors. J.L.T.C. inspires boys to see the great potential of the Royal Ranger program in addition to equipping and encouraging them to become more involved in service and training.

PREPARE to assume more responsibility in your outpost. PRAY about attending J.L.T.C. to receive:

- Experience in the patrol method
- Camcraft skill instruction
- Leadership skills
- Fun and fellowship
- Overnight backpack trip
- Spiritual growth



REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Because of the limited size and advance cost of setting up camp, a \$25.00 registration fee MUST accompany this application. This fee will be applied toward the total camp fee which will be \$55.00. If for any reason you are unable to attend camp, you must notify our office TWO weeks prior to camp to receive a refund. The dates for J.L.T.C. this year will be July 10 - 13 and it will be at Lakeview Camp grounds.

Greetings from the Roadrunner - We are looking forward to adding several new members to the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship. If you are planning to join, here are some things you should consider:

*** Do you wear a proper uniform? Without a uniform you have no way to display who you are and what you have accomplished.

*** Have you spent much time gaining knowledge of Royal Rangers skills? A top notch Royal Ranger is versed in a general knowledge of Royal Rangers and camping skills.

*** Are you willing to spend more time in Royal Ranger activities? You should not join F.C.F. to discontinue anything you are doing now.

*** Are you willing to spend a little more money? It will cost some money to acquire Frontier items but you must be careful not to spend too much. An outfit can be made for less than \$75.

If you can say yes to these questions you are probably ready to join. To try to join unprepared may cause disappointment if you cannot pass the test or are unable to stay active.
