



Commander Allen Philips of Outpost 439, First Assembly of God at Sulphur Springs reports exciting things happening at their outpost. At a recent campout the opening council fire devotional was about how a fire under control is a very good and useful tool and about how we can be filled with the fire of God's Spirit becoming a flaming fire or a light to the lost. After the devotion one 8 year old boy stood and told how he had recently been touched in church and had given his life to Christ. With the other boys and men gathered around him in prayer - under that perfect evening sky - what had been an unruly boy accepted Jesus into his heart and became a member of the family of God.

The experience of this outpost is a reminder to all and each of us of the power of God to move in the lives of these young boys. We should rededicate ourselves to providing the boys with opportunities such as this to accept the Lord as their Savior. During this new year our goal needs to be to reach those boys who do not know the Lord in their lives and to "Harvest" them while young and ripe for the Lord.


