OUTPOST PATROL FLAGS

At the Pow Wow this year, we would like to encourage your outpost to make or purchase an **OUTPOST PATROL FLAG**. There are a couple of options:

1) Make your own! This can be a project for your outpost. See order form for size and color requirements. You can also make your own staff (it needs to be 7 ft. to be seen above head level.) Fabric glue can be used to attach letters and numbers.

2) These flags are available from ABC FLAG, 913 N. FREEWAY, FT. WORTH, TX 76102, METRO 817-429-0070 or 1-800-288-9625. Be sure to talk to <u>PAM</u>. The cost is \$10.00 for the flag itself and \$4.00 for each letter and/or outpost number. (The letters and outpost numbers are sewn on.) See enclosed order form.

Additional points will be given at inspection for those outposts that have a PATROL FLAG.

A sample of the Outpost Patrol Flag will be at the Commander's Conference in Waco on April 28 & 29.
