Warrior Division Map




8.2 miles on 171 off 240, 14 miles from Jolly Truck Stop

Host Motel: Holiday Inn, Dallas/Ft. Worth Airport South, 4440 W. Airport Freeway, Irving, TX 75062. Their phone number is (214) 399-1010. I have secured excellent room rates of \$56.00 per night for 1-4 people. (their normal rate is \$106.00 per night) Ask for the Royal Ranger Seminar rate when making your reservations. To be exempt from the 6% State tax, an exempt form must be signed and presented at time of check-in. Motel reservations must be made prior to 15 January, 1996 to get the \$56.00 rate. I know many of you wait until the day before the seminar to reserve your room. Let me encourage you to reserve your room before the cutoff date. After January 15th, the Motel will honor the \$56.00 rate if space is available. The motel is an open Atrium Holidome complete with indoor pool, whirlpool, sauna, putting green, game room, toddlers playland, a pizza hut, ice cream shop and more. Call me if you have trouble in getting a room reservation.

If you would like to stay a few extra days, the motel will try to honor the \$56.00 rate. The motel is close to the church, and a major shopping mall (about 1/2 mile from the church).

Bunk-in: Male leaders may bunk-in the Gym on Friday night at no charge. Bring your sleeping gear. (No Showers available.)

<u>Booths</u>: We will have many booths with Royal Ranger items for sale or trade. If you bring items to sell or trade, please contact Randy Claunch or Marvin Lemke to reserve a booth. Note: booths are limited to items useful in the Royal Ranger Ministry. Bring your own table if possible.
