PREAMBLE

DISTRICT GOALS

- Encouraging leaders to reach out to teach and keep both boys and girls for Christ.

- Building a united body of Christ for the kingdom service.
- Building a God-fearing and committed leaders /commanders to train the royal rangers

MEETINGS AND PROGRAMMES

This year, because the districts targeted to reunion the royal rangers and also empower the various outposts to grow in their numbers, the district organized programs as it was charged by the region.

1. We organized our first rally at power center A/G- Mankessim, on the 11th day of February 2017. We were been able to record eight(8) commanders and leaders, twenty-four(24) ranger boys and twenty-nine(29) ranger girls, which gave us a total attendance of fifty-three(53) rangers and commanders.

That rally was organized based on the agenda; HOW TO PROMOTE THE LOCAL OUTPOSTS AS WELL AS THE DISTRICT, everything went through as we planned.

2. Our second meeting was a prayer night at Resurrection power A/G- Enyan-Maim, also took place on the 12th may, 2017, six(6) commanders, two(2) pastors, thirty-one(31)ranger boys and eighteen(18) ranger girls. Adding up to get forty-nine (49) rangers and commanders, two (2) pastors. The all night was very powerful as the host pastor (Rev.Abeiku Acquah) led us in all prayers and sermon.
3. We also made it possible to send rangers to all various grounds of 2017 zonal Easter convention.

Below shows the number of rangers and commanders recorded from various zones:

4. The district also hosted the regional zonal camp meeting for Mfantseman east, Mfantseman west and K.E.E.K at Ekumfi Eyisam Methodist primary and J.H.S on the 15th to 19th August, 2017. The district (Mfantseman East) recorded a number of fifty (50) rangers and commanders out of fifty-two (52) campers.

5. The district also organized a training course {church leadership orientation (C.L.O) and Rangers Fundamentals (R.F)} for all commanders and leaders who are eighteen (18) years and above.

The program was hosted at OMEGA schools-Mankessim, kessim branch on the 22nd December, 2017; 6:30pm to 23rd December, 2017; 4:00pm.

Sixteen commanders and leaders registered from the district, five (5) girls and eleven (11) boys.

The provisional number of rangers includes all outpost staffs in the district. Therefore we can now say our membership this year has increased from 200 as at 2016 to 235 as at 2017, and we thank God for that Grace.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- We got sixteen (16) commanders and leaders who took part in the 2017 commanders training course (RF AND CLO).
- Six (6) outpost out of seven (7) have been charted (registered nationally) with certificate and numbers.
- We are proud to say that one (1) ranger had been enrolled in the Youth Employment Agency (YEA) in the field of Community Policing Protection under the service of Ghana Police.

CHALLENGES

Despite the achievement we have been faced with few challenges;

- ✓ The most challenged issue we are facing is lack of financial support from the local churches, Men Ministry and some Pastors. This tends to affect the activities of the District since only few make it to district programmes.

- ✓ Despite our effort to let greater people know about rangers in the district, it is surprising to know that even some men's ministry executive members are not aware of what royal rangers is and thus affect Royal Rangers in diverse ways.
- ✓ Due to lack of logistics , such as camping tent, large ropes, uniforms, evangelism tracts, etc. it make it difficult for the rangers to experience real camp out, since either the district, region, sector or the national is having a camping.

RECOMMENDATION

- Since finance has become the main challenged we recommend that a week in the month of January be given to Royal rangers to celebrate and promote Royal Rangers in the district (RANGERS PROMO). We believe this will help raise money for Royal Rangers activities.
- We would wish a day forum be organized for the men's ministry to abreast them with royal rangers programmes.
- We humbly appeal and recommend that the district Executives of Assemblies of God Church, Ghana would entreat all pastors and church board to support royal rangers the way they support the children ministry because it is a great tool for evangelism.

We first of all give our most appreciation to God almighty for his strength. It is our greatest pleasure to express our profound gratitude to the Men's Ministry for their moral support and advices.

Again to our district departmental representatives who has been our back bone since 2006 till date. We say may they never lack.
