It is such a rare opportunity to be part of history in the making as you are doing during the Camporama.



Contact was made with Bethel Assembly of Singapore, and we received our first letter from Senior Commander Steven Teo on 3rd October, 1981. The Royal Ranger office of United States and Australia also responded and encouraged us. On 31st August, 1982 we became the first Outpost in Malaysia to charter.

We started with 5 Pioneer boys and 23 leaders. We held our first Outpost campout on 3rd October, 1982 with an attendance of 32 rangers and 13 leaders.

By September 1982, we had 5 Pioneer Patrols and 2 Trailblazer Patrols.

On 27th August 1982, 5 of our leaders had the privilege to meet our founder Johnnie Barnes and his wife, at the first leaders conference. The privileged 5 were Chan Ching Chung, Elvis Chan, Arumugam, Benjamin Keng and Albert Ong.

By God's Grace, we have 95 rangers and 30 leaders with an outstation Outpost in Port Klang.




Royal Rangers Selangor Outpost #2

The Royal Rangers ministry was introduced in December, 1984 by Selangor Outpost #1. Our Sunday School Superintendent, Sis Evelyn decided to start this program and many Sunday School children joined the Royal Rangers. In April, 1985, Sis Prudence Kim was sent for training at the Leaders Renovous, Port Dickson.

The Outpost Council was formed in May, 1985 and we charted on 6th June, 1985. We started with six TrailBlazers, three Pioneer boys and three Pioneer girls. The Buckaroos Outpost was formed a year later. Commander Prudence was our first Senior Commander, the first lady Senior Commander in Malaysia.

Here are some tricks that will fool your own eyes. They're called optical illusions, which means you don't really see what you think you see.




Your Floating Finger




What Happened to Joe's Pie?



Trick Notecase




You can make a wallet for one pound notes to give to your mother or father, or a bigger folder to keep notepaper together. You can also make a pocket-size notecase to use as a trick. The two sides of the case have tapes across, which are parallel on one side and crossed on the other. You show the case with a note under the tapes at one side, then close the case and open it again and the note will be under the tapes at the other side. Or you put a note in the middle of the case on top of the tapes, then close the case and open it again. This time the note has got itself tucked under the tapes at one side! The case opens either way and to make the note change sides or tuck itself away you close the case and open it the other way.

The outsides can be made from postcards, which are the right size for one pound notes. Your mother will have some narrow tape - about 75cm of 12mm tape will be plenty. You need a fairly strong adhesive to stick the tape to the card.

Put two cards side by side. Put on the parallel tapes first, near the ends. Stick the tapes under the outside edge of one card and take them across to

stick under the inner edge of the other card. Now do the same the other way round with crossing tapes - stick them under the outer edge of the second card and under the inner edges of the first. Turn the whole thing over and stick two more cards over the backs to cover the tape ends. Put the case under a pile of books or some other heavy weight until the glue has set, then you are ready to try out the case on your friends.

If the case is to be kept as a trick, you could leave it at that, but for use as a notecase the outside can be covered with fancy paper or decorated by painting. You can use picture postcards for the outside and end up with an ideal Christmas present for your parents.



A Stranger's Gift

WHEN A MAN NAMED V. P. Menon first arrived in New Delhi, India, to seek a job in government, all his possessions were stolen at the railroad station. He would have to return home on foot, defeated. Because primates so closely resemble humans, many scientists



Paper Cutting Fun

Amaze your family and friends with new skills! Make a hole in a postcard large enough for you to climb through, for instance . . . PERCY W. BLANDFORD shows you how to do this great trick.





There are several ways of cutting paper so you finish with something bigger than you started with. For instance, tell your friends you will cut a hole the size of a coin and pass a larger coin through it. Draw around a 1p piece in the centre of a piece of paper and cut out that hole. Now, if you fold the paper across the hole and bend the paper back, you will make a gap wide enough to push a 2p piece through edgewise.

What about making a hole in a postcard large enough for you to get through? This needs practice as cutting must be carefully done, so try it a few times before using the trick to amaze your friends. Fold the postcard in half lengthwise. Start cutting with scissors into the card, as shown. The cuts next to the ends should be into the folded part. The more cuts you get in, the larger will be the finished ring to get through, but if you try to make too many cuts, the whole thing may break. When you have made all the cuts from the edges, cut along the fold, except for the end pieces. Now you can open the card out carefully and get through it!

If you make a long paper loop with the ends of a strip stuck together and you cut around its centre with scissors, you expect to get two narrow rings. Let a friend try this, then when you cut another loop tell him you will finish with one bigger loop. While he is wondering how you did it, tell him you will cut around the next loop and finish with two rings joined together.

Make the paper rings or loops fairly long, so what you have done to them will not show. If you stick the ends together without twisting the paper, a cut will produce two separate rings. For the next one, turn the paper over before you stick it, so the inside of one end is turned outside. That one finishes as a large ring. For the third one, give the paper a complete twist before sticking. The outsides of both ends are the same way, but around the ring there is a twist. That can be cut carefully so there are two interlocking rings.

TALES FROM A STORM

During the last 100 years, over 100,000 photographs have been taken of the heavens through a large telescope at the Royal Greenwich Observatory in England. Many of these photos have appeared in encyclopedias, textbooks, and other publications around the world.

It was in the news recently that a common housefly has halted the telescope's astronomical services. Somehow, the fly managed to get into the telescope's long tube through the eyepiece, became entangled, and broke the cross hairs. The cross hairs are used to align the telescope so that stars and planets will be centered precisely in the field of view.

The Scriptures tell us, dead flies can make a whole bottle of perfume stink (Eccles. 10:1), and one fly can also tear up an entire telescope.

Repairing those cross hairs is not easy. They are made of delicate strands of silk from a spider's web, and no one seems to know how to attach new cross hairs.

Additionally, there's the problem of locating the right kind of silk strands for cross hairs. All spiders have at least three different kinds of silk glands. Each gland will produce a certain type of silk for a particular purpose. Consequently, the silk threads will vary in texture, thickness, and stickiness.

When conditions are right, a spider will produce thin silk strands of even thickness that would be just right for cross hairs. But no one at the observatory seems to know what these specific conditions are, nor how to select the appropriate strands from a suitable web.

Using something other than spider's web for the cross hairs won't work either. One astronomer tried hair from his own head, but it was too thick. Under the viewfinder, human hair looks like telephone poles. Even super thin nylon will not work because it absorbs moisture and swells.

The Word of God is proven to be true again. "The spider taketh hold with her

hands, and is in king's palaces" (Proverbs 30:28). She also shows up in telescopes, and catches a fly with her web although the spider is not even there!

The British astronomers are trying to locate a retired scientist who knows how to repair the cross hairs and bring him out of retirement long enough to fix the telescope.

Just as the housefly became entangled in the web and lost its life, so are many becoming entangled in the web of sin, and will lose their own soul.
