Camporama 2000- what does that name make you think of? I have been in Royal Rangers for over 30 years and have attended at least nine Camporamas in at least three countries. I have shared a tent or cabin with other National leaders and even US-Indian style wig-wam with the late founder of the Royal Rangers, Johnie Barnes. Camporamas therefore for me remind me of standing in front of many thousands of Royal Rangers but better still of getting to know individuals on a one to one basis.

What do I see when I meet such Royal Rangers? Well in my Long life many things have changed-for instance when I was a child-there was no television, no video games, nor CD walkman, let alone computers, McDonald hamburgers, air-conditioned cars, office and even homes. Most people did not have a telephone in the house- let alone a mobile phone. One would have seem able to walk the streets of Malaysia safely without the threat of being run over by a car or a motorbike in one of Malaysia's busy street intersections. I can remember the first day I received a bicycle-now I can really travel. Imagine not having to learn about all these things?

However many things have not changed. The pleasure of being able to hike into the hills, and go swimming in a water hole that contained cool water from the mountain spring. Or the pleasure of visiting a beach or river and fishing or catching crabs or prawns-taking one catchs to the fire and enjoying fresh seafood, better than it does ever taste from the shop. Or the pleasure of paddling a canoe an 'off beaten track'rendezvous and camping under the stars, just as it was done 1000 years ago. Or again the pleasure of being able to lie in your tent at night (with the mosquitoes outside, of course) and hear the sounds of animals and insects moving around the campsite. Or the pleasure one experience of being able to help a small child or old person and one receives a very warm smile and quietly spoken 'thank you'.

What do I see when I meet such Royal Rangers? I see boys and girls, some small and some teenagers who are alive-in all four aspects, that is mentally, physically, socially and spiritually. I can enjoy talking to them about things that interest them, whether it be their computer or their swimming hole; I can't always match their ability to climb, and indulge in other healthy activities-but I can share their enjoyment in these: I love the social contact as I find Royal Rangers are friendly people, whether they are six or sixteen years old; but most importantly I fellowship with them and discuss how God is moving in their lives. I can share their great excitement in what God has done and is doing as their Christian experience grows.

So as this is the first Camporama 2000, aim to make the most of your time there. Make new friends- don't just find out the new friends name, but also where they come from, how big their outpost is, what they do at Royal Rangers meetings, what they enjoy and what they dislike. Make really good friends. A good Royal Rangers friend can stick closer than a brother can! I have friends in Royal Ranger whom I have first met over thirty years ago-I count some of them closer than a brother. I also have friends that I made at the very last camp I attended in March 2000. Go away from Malaysia's Camporama 2000 with many friends who you did not know when you arrived.

But most importantly share what Jesus is doing in your life-you will never know how much you can encourage other Royal Rangers (and even the leaders in your Outpost).

Make sure you leave the Camporama with the Lord Jesus in your heart.

All our rangers are boys.




KUALA LUMPUR # 10 FULL GOSPEL TABERNACLE







Air-conditioning robs the skin of essential moisture and can aggravate dryness. If you live in an air conditioned home buy a humidifier or place a bowl of water in the room. This will boost the moisture content in the air.

EIGHT: Helping Hand:

If you have a youthful complexion then aged hands can give the game away. Always wear hand cream enriched with sun filters. Before washing up, slather on hand cream, then put on the rubber gloves. The heat of the water will intensify the activity of the cream.

NINE: Health Brew:

Research confirms that green tea can have a significant effect on the ageing process. It is a rich source of anti-oxidants, which mop up free radicals within the body. For the maximum benefit, leave leaves or tea bag to steep for three minutes.

TEN: Sleep Well:

How you sleep can affect your looks. Dermatologists can identify which side of your face you sleep on by looking at your wrinkles. To help overcome this, sleep on a big, soft non-synthetic pillow with a satin pillowcase.

BASIC BEAUTY HINTS

Healthy Hair - 10 Useful Hints

ONE: Brush Strokes:

Before shampooing, brush your hair to remove surface dirt and any tangles. Forget the myth that brushing 100 strokes daily is beneficial. Over vigorous brushing can tear and generally weaken your hair shaft.

TWO: Cleanse Ease:

Take short cuts to remove any build-up of styling products in your hair. Massage shampoo into dry hair and rinse it out with warm water. This will be sufficient to remove impurities and your hair shouldn't need another wash.

THREE: Scalp Treat:

Massage your scalp to boost circulation, improve hair health and reduce stress. Knead your scalp gently using the pads of your fingers. Start at the front of your head and work down to the nape of your neck.

FOUR: Moist Hair:

Only apply conditioner to the ends and mid-lengths of your hair, (the hair near your scalp should have enough natural hydrating oils). Applying conditioner near the roots will make your hair feel greasy shortly after washing.

FIVE: Final Rinse:

Boost hair shine and remove tangles by using vinegar as a rinse after shampooing. Dilute one tablespoon of vinegar in 600ml tepid water and pour it over your hair. Comb it through and then rinse it out with warm water.



SIX: Water Works:

Hot water causes the cuticles to swell, creating an uneven surface and making locks appear dull. Use cold water to rinse your hair. The coldness of the water will close the cuticles, ensuring all over hair shine.

SEVEN: Squeeze Ease:

Never towel-dry your hair, as it robs the locks of moisture and destroys elasticity. Squeeze excess water from the hair using your fingertips and then blot hair with a towel. This helps to retain vital moisture.

EIGHT: Tangle Free:

Never brush wet hair. It is swollen to twice its normal size and is susceptible to damage. Use a wide-tooth comb and work through wet hair in sections, starting with the ends. Comb your hair until it is completely tangle-free.

NINE: Styling Sense:

Leave your tresses to dry naturally, as heated styling appliances damage your hair shaft. Twist long hair into a topknot and leave it to set as the hair dries. Apply a small amount of gel to short hair and comb it through.

TEN: Cuticle Tamer:

Once your hair is dry, spray a fine mist of hair spray onto a comb and run it through your hair. This will tame any stray cuticles of flyaway ends and give the hair a neat, polished finish, ensuring long-lasting perfection for your hairstyle.

LOSING WEIGHT – IS THERE A MAGIC DIET?

If there were this magic weight reducing diet, then obesity world wide would be decreasing. Unfortunately, the statistics in US, UK and Asia show that obesity is increasing, so all these wonderful diets, supplements and drugs which claim that you can lose weight have had no impact on the global obesity problem. In a series of articles, I will be discussing the various diets, drugs and supplements that have been tried over the last two decades. It is interesting to note the various diets; drugs and supplements, which hit UK in the 1980's, have now surfaced in Asia. I recall the Cambridge diet, which was used on very obese patients in the 1990's, was successful only to find that a few patients suffered from side effects resulting in heart problems. High protein diets come and go like the meal replacements. The truth is that long-term weight loss requires lifestyle changes, which people often find difficult to change. It is possible and with a few changes people are surprised with what they can achieve. It is a challenge for both the patient and the dietitian.



One of the reasons that high protein diets have been popular is that people lose weight quickly but it tends to be water. Stored carbohydrate contains large amounts of water and changing to a high protein, low carbohydrate diet results in the loss of these carbohydrate stores plus additional water and not the fat stores.

What about the side effects?

1. Constipation, fatigue and insomnia.
2. Dehydration and hypotension resulting from sodium loss and water imbalance
3. A high protein diet tends to be high in saturated fat and can increase atherosclerosis. Thickening of the blood arteries which can lead to a heart attack.
4. Excess protein can not be stored by the body, which means that kidneys require more water to excrete the urea. It is essential that enough water be drunk.
5. Uric acid levels can increase which may lead to gout.



Remember the British Diabetic Association, American Heart Foundation and the British Dietetic Association to name a few, all recommend fewer animal products and more complex carbohydrates and fibre.


Protein Damage

Protein is metabolized by the liver and excreted by the kidneys into the urine. As you get older, kidney function decreases and eating too much protein will affect the kidney's function. Even for diabetics, it is now recommended that they should eat less protein, 0.8g per kg rather than the normal 1g per kg recommended for adults to minimize renal complications later on in life. For e.g.. A 70kg adult would require 70g Protein per day.

2 eggs	14 g
6 oz (180g) Meat	42g
6oz (180) Meat	42g
1 glass of Milk	7g

High protein diets can cause serious metabolic changes that lead to bone loss and kidney stones. The Nurses Health Study found that women who consumed 95g of protein compared with those that consumed less than 68g a day have a 22% greater risk of forearm fractures.


