AGE: 6 - 8


Boys and girls in this age group engage in fun and exciting activities that allows them to grow their interests and needs as well as shaping their character.






DISCOVERY RANGERS

AGE: 12 - 14










EXPEDITION RANGERS

It's been a dream of Selangor #1 for over 20 years to carry the RR flag all the way to the top of Mount Kota Kinabalu, Sabah. Despite the earthquake that caused substantial damage in 2015, we were still determined to achieve this dream. And we made plans to do so in 2017.

Although we were initially doubtful that we could reach the summit, we were eager to try our best anyway, and so we spent our weekends training in Taman Rakyat, playing futsal and going to gym sessions which managed to build our confidence. We also did a practice run by hiking up Gunung Nuang (a challenging trail in Selangor), as we were told by an experienced hiker that "if you can conquer Nuang, you are ready for Mount Kinabalu!"

It was as difficult as we anticipated it to be. With two of us experiencing physical fatigue and having to give up halfway as we ascended, only half of our group made it to the top of Nuang's peak. It rained as we descended, making our hike more dangerous than the climb up. But none of us entertained the thought of giving up on our ultimate goal.

Finally, on 26 June 2017, we started our Mount Kinabalu hike a little after 9 a.m. It was surreal, the feeling of being on the verge of realizing the dream that we had for so long. We felt conflicting emotions - excited that we were there, yet afraid that we would fail at what we set out to do.

It was a long but exhilarating hike up. We wanted to reach Laban Rata (rest house) before dinner to rest before resuming our hike but we were delayed by a downpour. Our steps became shorter as we struggled to shield ourselves from the rain, lengthening our journey forward.

Being the oldest among us, Cmdr. William fell behind as we hiked up the steep slopes. However, he told us to move on ahead of him, saying he would catch up with us in due time. And sure enough, he did. His determination at this moment greatly inspired us to push ourselves beyond our limits.

We reached Laban Rata late, but we were glad to finally have the chance to rest. That night, the thrill of being so close to the summit made it difficult for us to fall asleep despite our weariness. We woke up at 3 a.m. It was dark and cold outside, but everyone's faces were lit up with excitement. After a light meal, our climb to the summit began.

The hike up was only 2 km but it felt much longer. In pitch darkness, we could barely see anything around us except for the silhouette of the person ahead of us. We did our best to keep up with the rest, but found ourselves left behind at times. The cold wind made us shiver. We kept our arms close to our bodies, in an effort to keep warm.

It became colder as we climbed higher. We found ourselves in an open area. All we could see were dim lights all around us. We battled with the exhaustion we felt, trying to resist the urge to give up. At that point, we just wanted to reach the summit no matter what time it was, even if we missed the sunrise. As we continued our hike, we started to see more people stopping to rest, the fatigue overwhelming them.

Suddenly we caught a glimpse of the summit from a distance. Our hearts leapt for joy. A dawning realization that we were reaching the finishing line made our strides longer. People who had already reached the peak, called out words of encouragement as they passed us by on their journey down.

Finally, we reached the summit. Just in time to see the sunrise. The view was breath-taking. People were taking photos of their surroundings, admiring the beauty of God's creation. We wished that we could have stayed there a little while longer.







ANSWERING THE CALL OF THE COMMUNITY

Since 1991, Rumah K.I.D.S has sheltered and rescued hundreds of displaced children from a life on the streets as well from broken homes. At this point Rumah Kids Shelters about 40 Children under our care. Through the last 25 years, Rumah Kids has housed, fed and nurtured over 500 children. In this safe and loving environment, shielded from the violence, abuse and neglect they once knew, many of these children grow up in the home, finish their education and are empowered to lead productive lives.
