SKILL-A-RAMA PATCH COLLECTION CHALLENGE:

- 1) Video Challenge Make an introductory video! You may post this video on the RR/FCF Patch Collectors Facebook or RR/FCF Patch Collectors MeWe group if you wish to post publicly. If you would prefer your video to be private and only viewed by the admins and moderator, you may upload the video file to the Skill-a-rama Google Drive link. Your video must meet the following criteria:
 - a) A Royal Ranger uniform, T-shirt, brag vest, or an FCF outfit must be worn during the video.
 - b) Open the video by announcing that you are meeting criteria for the 2022 Skill-arama Award.
 - c) An introduction of yourself and a brief history of your youth and/or adult service in the Royal Rangers and FCF.
 - d) Present your favorite RR or FCF patch from your collection. This can be an event you did or did not attend. Describe why it is your favorite (ex: good memories, good design, it was gifted to you, etc.)
 - e) Tell us which patch you don't currently have but you want very badly and why.
 - f) Tell us what it is that got you involved in collecting RR and FCF memorabilia.
 - g) Close the video with a word of encouragement and/or tips to new collectors.
 - h) Your video should not exceed 5 minutes in length.
