MOTION

BI-ANNUAL MEETING

Motion by Carl Thompson, that the Royal Ranger Executive Committee meet bi-annually and that they meet as a workshop committee. The Royal Ranger Executive Committee come at their own travel expense. Carl moved that the meeting be conducted over a weekend and that they begin in the fall of 1985 with the next meeting of the National Executive Committee be October 4-5, 1985, carried.

Motion by Silas Gaither, that the national office determine the wholesale and the district retail price of the Anniversary Patch, carried.

Motion by Alan Gell, that the Anniversary Patch be limited to one patch per person per Anniversary Event, which includes national, district, and etc., lost.

Motion by Fred Deaver, that the composition of the Camporama Patch be accepted and that the national office be permitted to change colors as they see fit, carried.

ROYAL RANGER OF THE YEAR

Motion by Paul Stanek, that the Royal Ranger of the Year document be tabled and be brought back to the next National Executive Committee Meeting for further detailed study, carried.

RANGER OF THE YEAR PINS

Motion by Carl Thompson, that the Royal Ranger of the Year document and Royal Ranger of the Year pins be studied and discussed at the next National Royal Ranger Executive Committee Meeting, carried.

SPECIFIC DESIGNATION

Motion by Alan Gell, that the national office standardize, design, determine colors of patches, hats, and etc. for jr. leader training events such as JLTC, JLTT, and etc., carried.

RECOMMENDATION

That a standing committee be appointed to study the uniform and patch consideration for jr. leaders training events and that this committee bring their recommendations to the next Royal Rangers Executive Committee Meeting.

Suggestion by Johnnie Barnes, that a survey be made during the breakaways concerning what type of jr. leaders training events and patches that the various districts are having and using.

NATIONAL APPOINTMENTS
