DISCUSSION: That more emphasis be placed on the ceremony for GMA winners such as: printed bulletin, letter from political figures such as Governors, Congressmen, Senators, the President, etc.

We would be better off using the time spent on this to more fully implement the overall goal of evangelism as well as developing the "Big Adventure" program for Gold Medalers as a research on their dedication.
