DISCUSSION: Finalize plans for National Camporama; including recap of headquarters staff assignments.

DISCUSSION: The need for a standardized policy on finances in each region.

PROPOSAL: That it become a stated policy, that all judges or those administering tests will automatically eliminate themsleves; when family members are among the contestants (this applies to all levels of Ranger of the Year program).

DISCUSSION: Discuss the possibilities of a joint convention involving the Men's Ministries Directors, the LFTL Council. Each council would run simmulataneously during the day with united meetings at night. Proposed dates are April 21-24, 1988, site pending.

DISCUSSION: Is there a need for a special award for Senior Commanders other than the Outpost Commander's Award modification they can now earn if all their commanders earn the Outpost Commander's Award.

PROPOSAL: That communications from the national office to the districts be accomplished through the regional officers as much as possible. To assure that all concerned parties are fully aware of the communications.

DISCUSSION: Discuss the possibility of making available the "Nature Bound" pocket field guide to our Royal Rangers.

PROPOSAL: Make available an O.D. campaign style hat for all Ranger leaders.

PROPOSAL: Give the committee information on the evaluation form to be used at national council.

DISCUSSION: An update on the training center, and the "Stake A Claim" project.

PROPOSAL: That a symbol be awarded for completing the District Leaders Training Course, and a symbol be given for completing the FCF Chapter Officers Training Corres
