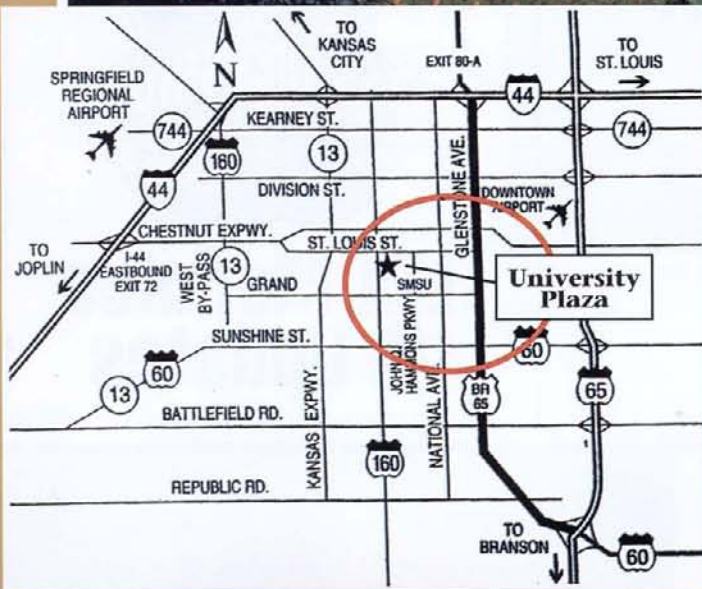

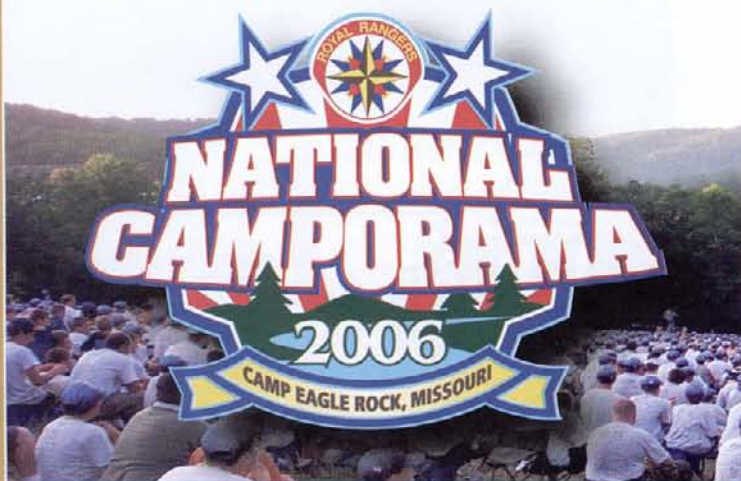

### NRA Black powder Instructor Certification Courses

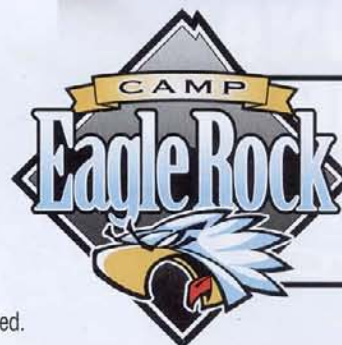
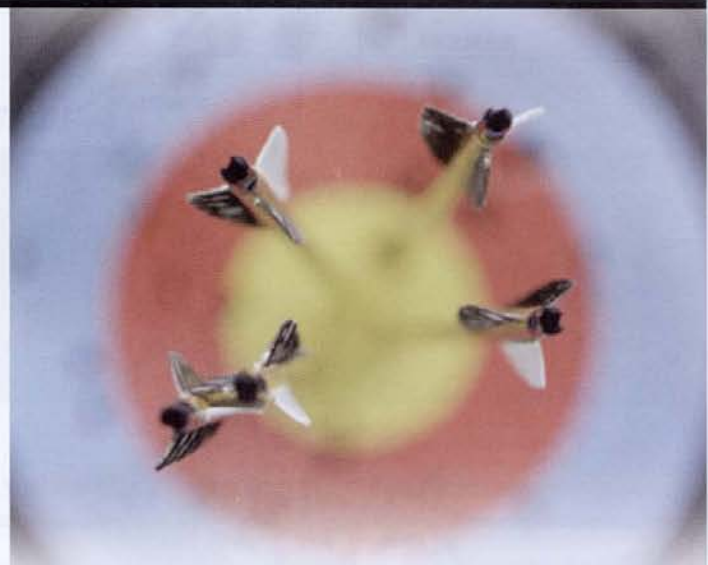
Expand your district team of shooting instructors through these NRA black powder instructor certification courses:

Applicants must have completed the NRA Black Powder Shooters Safety Course to attend the instructor course. Both courses may be taken consecutively.

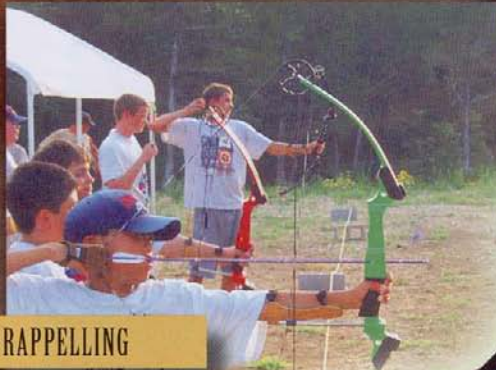
### Primitive Bow-Making Course – Monday & Tuesday

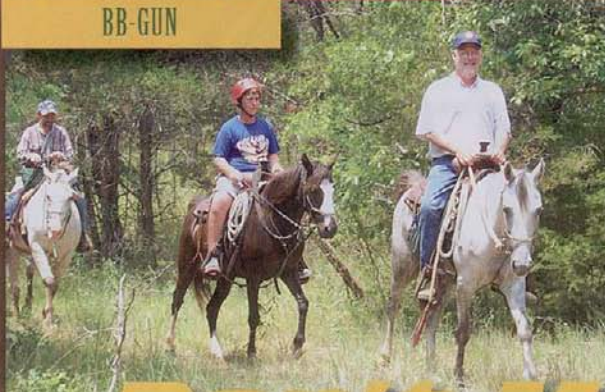
