3-Position 10-Meter Air Rifle Event

PURPOSE: The purpose of this postal match is to offer Royal Rangers from across the country an opportunity to participate in a nationwide air rifle shooting postal competition.

- **PREREQUISITE:** Recommend the completion of Firearm Safety and Marksmanship merits.
- **FIRING DATES:** Match may be conducted by the district, section, or outpost between January 1-October 31.
 - All entries must be postmarked by November 15.
- **LOCATION**: Match may be conducted indoor or outdoor.
- **ELEGIBILTY:** Individuals may enter this match only once per calendar year. All competitors must be members of a currently chartered outpost.
- **FEES:** \$5.00 per Individual / \$15.00 per Team (4 members per team)
 - All team members must enter as individuals.
- <u>ADMINSTRATION</u>: Contact the NRA Competitive Shooting Division to receive the score reporting forms. Direct questions to the Postal Program coordinator, at <u>Postal@nrahq.org</u> or (703) 267-1482.

- **RESULTS:** Results will be tabulated and released after December 31. Individual and team awards will be mailed soon after the release of the results.
- **CATAGORIES:** Competitors will enter in **only one** of the following categories.
 - o **Sub-Junior:** Competitors who will not reach their 15th birthday in the calendar year of competition.
 - **Intermediate-Junior:** Competitors who reach their 15th or 16th birthday in the calendar year of competition.
 - o **Junior:** Competitors who reach their 17th or 18^{th*} birthday in the calendar year of competition.
 - * To compete as an 18-year-old Junior, the competitor must be an Expedition Ranger and may not be serving as a Lt. commander in the outpost.
- <u>AWARDS</u>: The National Royal Ranger Ministries will present awards for 1st-3rd place in all categories, individual and team events.
- <u>INDIVIDUAL AWARDS</u>: Individual awards will be presented from the NRA Competitive Shooting Division for 1st place in each category. (There must be two competitors for 1st place to be awarded).
 - Additional awards will be provided for each additional ten competitors in a category. Second through fifth place will receive awards based on participation.
 - First place in each category for each position will also be awarded. Additional awards will be provided for each additional ten competitors in a category.
- <u>TEAM AWARDS</u>: A team match is an unfired match generated by the fired aggregate scores of four (4) individual participants. Team awards will be presented from the NRA Competitive Shooting Division for 1st place in each category. (There must be two teams for 1st place to be awarded).
 - One additional award will be provided for each five additional teams in a category.
 - The team category will be determined by the age of the oldest team member.
 - Any number of teams may be entered by each outpost.
 - Individuals may only be entered on one team per year.

- <u>RULES</u>: Rulebooks may be ordered by contacting NRA Sales at 1-800-336-7402. Ask for *Sporter Air Rifle Position Rulebook* (Item # CA 16320).
- **EYE PROTECTION:** Eye protection is required during this event by all Royal Rangers.
- **EQUIPMENT:** Sporter air rifle or any type of compressed air or CO₂ rifle of conventional appearance with the additional restrictions in rule 3.2 of the *NRA Sporter Air Rifle Position Rulebook*.
- <u>TARGETS</u>: AR-5/10 targets (10 record bull's-eyes/2 sighting bull's-eyes) are required. Only one shot is fired on each record bull's-eye. Shooter's name and the position being shot will be printed in the upper right hand corner of each target.
 - For information on where to purchase official targets, refer to the target suppliers' section of this document.
- <u>COURSE OF FIRE (30 shots)</u>: All targets are fired at 10 meters. Targets are to be shot in the order stated below:
 - o 10 shots Prone (15 minutes)
 - o 10 shots Standing (20 minutes)
 - o 10 shots Kneeling (15 minutes)
- **SCORING:** Each target must be scored by two individuals and in accordance with *NRA Sporter Air Rifle Position Rulebook*. All shots visually close to any scoring ring must be plugged. All targets are subject to review and rescoring by the NRA.

Note: Each year any qualified Royal Ranger, who whishes to compete at the annual International BB Gun Championship Match, sponsored by Daisy[®], in the individual 10-meter Sporter air rifle competition may do so.
