DISTRICT STRAIGHT ARROW & BUCKAROO AUXILIARY

The National Royal Ranger Department considers Straight Arrows and Buckaroos as an auxiliary of Royal Rangers. It was felt that by organizing this outreach on the District level, we would better be able to develop the overall program to reach, teach, and keep these young boys for Christ.

The District Staff of this Auxiliary will work closely with the District Commander and the District Royal Rangers Executive Staff and the overall Royal Ranger program within the District.

Because the philosophy and methods, and program for this age level boy differs from regular Royal Rangers it is necessary to develop an effective program for reaching them. The emphasis of the program is to excite the boys with their advancements and involve the whole family in its activities and program.

Great emphasis will be placed upon the local leaders to be trained in the new Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Leadership Training Courses and to go for their Teacher Certification. Special Workshops and Conferences will be set up for on-going training and leader encouragement.

DEPUTY DISTRICT COMMANDER of STRAIGHT ARROWS & BUCKAROOS

DEFINITION

The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos is a Royal Ranger officer that is responsible for the development of the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo ministry of the Royal Rangers in this District.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos must meet the qualifications as listed in the Leader's Manual for Royal Ranger Leaders.
2. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos must support his church with tithes, offerings, and faithful attendance.
3. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos must be thoroughly familiar with the overall Royal Ranger program, but specialize with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age boys, and be able to discuss said program with ease and understanding.
4. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos must demonstrate leadership ability and characteristics.
5. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos must devote time and energy to the Royal Ranger program, especially the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age level, and be willing to travel within the district on its behalf.
6. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos should hold an Instructor Training Certificate with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Leadership Training Course, or achieve this within one year of election, and attend the District Staff Training Course.
7. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos should not completely remove himself from his Local Outpost where he is serving in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo age group.
8. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos must serve in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo Outpost. He shall not be elected if serving in any other age division.

APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE

1. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall be elected from a list of no less than two names submitted by the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Auxiliary Executive Committee to the District Commander to be voted on by the District Royal Ranger Council.
2. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall serve for two (2) years.
3. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall wear the Silver Oak Leaf insignia.

DUTIES

1. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall supervise or co-ordinate all the Straight Arrow and Buckaroo activities within the District, with the help of the leaders of the same.
2. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall cooperate with and assist in every way possible the District Commander with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo activities.
3. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall study carefully all Straight Arrow/Buckaroo material plus the regular Royal Rangers materials and become completely familiar with all the aspects of the Royal Ranger ministry, specializing in Straight Arrows & Buckaroos.
4. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall cooperate with and assist the District, Divisional, Sectional, and Area Training Coordinators with the training of the Straight Arrow and Buckaroo leaders within the district, division, section, and area through the Leadership Training Courses or any special leaders workshops or conferences.
5. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall take the initiative to assist the local churches at their invitation to present, begin, charter Straight Arrow/Buckaroo age Royal Rangers.
6. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall maintain the highest degree of courtesy and respect toward pastors and the District Officers.
7. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrow & Buckaroos may wear the official Royal Rangers uniform (Khaki or Dress) when promoting Royal Rangers (even Straight Arrows or Buckaroos) in the church and public and always endeavor, through conduct,

appearance and attitude, to create the proper image of Royal Ranger's leadership. When on an outing with the boys or at a District, Divisional, or Sectional Straight Arrow & Buckaroo activity, you shall wear your Outpost Uniform, Cowboy or Indian.

8. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall be a member of the District SA/B Auxiliary Executive Committee, and shall make an effort to attend all said meetings.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING

1. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall oversee the District in Leadership Training classes for Straight Arrow and Buckaroo leaders.
2. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall meet the following requirements before teaching Leadership Training.
 - a. Earned the Leadership Training Instructors Certificate for the Training Courses designed especially for the Straight Arrow and Buckaroo leaders, that is issued by the National Royal Ranger's Department.
 - b. Or be under the direct supervision of a Certificate holder, and have already earned the Leadership Training Pin for that class. (He shall be considered an assistant instructor.)
3. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall be responsible to inform the District Commander and District Training Coordinator at least thirty (30) days in advance for the following: (1) the dates the Training Courses will be held; (2) the name(s) of the Instructor's; (3) the place of instruction.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

1. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall take full responsibility on checking with other programs in the District, and being sure not to schedule activities in conflict with other Department activities.
2. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos shall cooperate with all District programs.
3. The Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos has authority only this District.

RELATIONSHIP TO DISTRICT & OTHER COMMANDERS

1. A good, congenial relationship shall be maintained between the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos and Area, Sectional, Divisional as well as the District Commander, at all times. Each should respect the position of the other and extend proper courtesies.
2. It is proper procedure for the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos to encourage and suggest different District projects and activities, however, the actual initiation of these eventw will come from one of these Disteict officers, or those appointed by the District Commander.

DISTRICT ADJUTANT of STRAIGHT ARROWS & BUCKAROOS

DEFINITION

The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos is a Royal Ranger Leader assigned to the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos for specialized service performance, specifically as the Administrative Assistant, and for the purposes of promoting the SA/B Auxiliary ministry.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos must meet the qualifications as listed in the Leader's Manual for Royal Ranger Leaders.
2. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos must support his church with tithes, offerings, and faithful attendance.
3. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos must be thoroughly familiar with the overall Royal Ranger program, but specialize with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age boys, and be able to discuss said program with ease and understanding.
4. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos must devote time and energy to the Royal Ranger program, especially the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age division, and be willing to travel within the District on its behalf.
5. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos should not completely remove himself from his Local Outpost, where he is serving in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo age level.
6. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos must serve in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo Outpost. He shall not be appointed if serving in any other age division.
7. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos can be male or female.

APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE

1. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall be appointed by the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos and ratified by the District Royal Ranger Council.
2. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall be appointed to serve a one (1) year term.
3. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall wear the Gold Oak Leaf insignia.

DUTIES

1. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall assist the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos in his administrative duties and in promoting the SA/B Auxiliary.
2. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall be the recording secretary for the District SA/B Auxiliary Executive Committee.
3. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos may serve also as the District SA/B Auxiliary Treasurer, at the desire of the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos.
4. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall maintain the highest degree of courtesy and respect toward pastors and the District Officers.
5. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall perform other duties such as may be assigned to him by the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos.
6. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos may wear the official Royal Rangers uniform (Khaki or Dress) when promoting Royal Rangers (Even Straight Arrows or Buckaroos) in the church and public and always endeavor, through conduct, appearance and attitude, to create the proper image of Royal Ranger's leadership. When on an outing with the boys or at a District, Division, or Section SA/B Activity, you shall wear your Outpost Uniform, Cowboy or Indian.
7. The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall be a member of the District SA/B Auxiliary Executive Committee, and shall make an effort to attend all said meetings.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos has authority only as given him by the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos and it is to be for this District only.

RELATIONSHIP TO DISTRICT AND OTHER COMMANDERS

The District Adjutant of Straight Arrows and Buckaroos shall endeavor to uplift the position of the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos, as well as the District Commander at all times, and shall endeavor to maintain a harmonious working relationship with all Area, Sectional, & Divisional Commanders, the SA/B Auxiliary Executive Staff and the District Royal Ranger Executive Staff.

DISTRICT STRAIGHT ARROW/BUCKAROO TRAINING COORDINATOR

DEFINITION

The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator is a Royal Ranger Officer assigned to the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos for the specialized service of Training Leaders within the District.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator must meet the qualifications as listed in the Leader's Manual for Royal Ranger Leaders.
2. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator must carry a current Certified Instructor/Training Chief status, with the Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Courses.
3. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator must support his church with tithes, offerings, and faithful attendance.
4. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator must be thoroughly familiar with the overall Royal Ranger program, but specialize with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age boys, and be able to discuss said program with ease and understanding.
5. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator must devote time and energy to the Royal Ranger program, especially the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age division, and be willing to travel within the district on its behalf.
6. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator should not completely remove himself from his Local Outpost, where he is serving in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo age level.

DUTIES

1. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall be responsible to develop a District Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Leadership Training program with the SA/B LTC's and workshops.
2. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator must attend and complete the National/District Instructor-Trainer Seminar with the emphasis on the SA/B LTC's.
3. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall serve on the District L.T.C. Certification Committee.
4. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall encourage Straight Arrow and Buckaroo leaders who have completed their training to go for their Certified Instructor/Training Chief status, so there will be a staff of instructors within their sections.
5. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall make sure the instructors are following the national standards in teaching the L.T.C.'s.
6. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall periodically report to the District Commander, the Regional Training Officer, and the National Training Coordinator on the status of the training program in the District.
7. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall maintain the highest degree of courtesy and respect toward pastors and the District Officers.
8. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator may wear the official Royal Rangers uniform (Khaki or Dress) when promoting Royal Rangers (Even Straight Arrows or Buckaroos) in the church and public and always endeavor, through conduct, appearance and attitude, to create the proper image of Royal Ranger's leadership. When teaching in L.T.C.'s or on an outing with the boys or at a District, Division, or Section SA/B Activity, you shall wear your Outpost Uniform, Cowboy or Indian.
9. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Training Coordinator shall be a member of the District SA/B Auxiliary Executive Committee, and shall make an effort to attend all said meetings.

3. The District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Activities Coordinator must be thoroughly familiar with the overall Royal Ranger program, but specialize with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age boys, and be able to discuss said program with ease and understanding.

The District Buckaroo Specialist may wear the official Royal Rangers uniform (Khaki or Dress) when promoting Royal Rangers (Even Straight Arrows or Buckaroos) in the church and public and always endeavor, through conduct, appearance and attitude, to create the proper image of Royal Ranger's leadership. When on an outing with the boys or at a District, Divisional, or Sectional Straight Arrow and Buckaroo Activity, you shall wear your Outpost Uniform, Cowboy or Indian.
6. The District Buckaroo Specialist shall be a member of the District Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Auxiliary Executive Committee, and shall make an effort to attend all said meetings.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

The District Buckaroo Specialist has authority only as given him by the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos and it is to be for this District only.

RELATIONSHIP TO DISTRICT AND OTHER COMMANDERS

The District Buckaroo Specialist shall endeavor to uplift the position of the Deputy District Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos, as well as the District Commander at all times, and shall endeavor to maintain a harmonious working relationship with all Area, Sectional, & Divisional Commanders, the Straight Arrow/Buckaroo Auxiliary Executive Staff and the District Royal Rangers Executive Staff.

SECTIONAL ADJUTANT--STRAIGHT ARROW & BUCKAROO COORDINATOR

DEFINITION

The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator is a Royal Ranger Leader assigned to the Sectional Commander for aid in a specialized field, and has the responsibility for the development and coordination of the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo ministry of the Royal Rangers in their Section.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator must meet the qualifications as listed in the Leader's Manual for Royal Ranger Leaders.
2. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator must support his church with tithes, offerings, and faithful attendance.
3. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator must be thoroughly familiar with the overall Royal Ranger program, but specialize with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age boys, and be able to discuss said program with ease and understanding.
4. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator must devote time and energy to the Royal Ranger program, especially the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo age division, and be willing to travel within the Section on its behalf.
5. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator should not completely remove himself from his Local Outpost, where he is serving in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo level.
6. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator must serve in either a Straight Arrow or Buckaroo Outpost. He shall not be appointed if serving in any other age division.
7. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator can be male or female.

APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE

1. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall be appointed by the District Commander following his approval for nomination by the Sectional Commander.
2. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall serve for one (1) year.

3. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall wear the Blue Oak Leaf insignia.

DUTIES

1. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall cooperate with and assist in every way possible the Sectional Commander with the Straight Arrow & Buckaroo activities.
2. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall cooperate with and assist the Sectional Training Coordinator with the training of the Straight Arrow and Buckaroo leaders within the section through the Leadership Training Courses or any special leaders workshops. If he doesn't have a Sectional Leadership Training Coordinator who is a Certified Instructor with the new Straight Arrow/Buckaroo L.T.C.'s, he must qualify himself to be able to teach it.
3. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall coordinate all the Straight Arrow and Buckaroo activities --within the Section, with the help of the leaders of the same.
4. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall maintain the highest degree of courtesy and respect toward pastors and the Sectional and District Officials.
5. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator may wear the official Royal Rangers uniform (Khaki or Dress) when promoting Royal Rangers (Even Straight Arrows or Buckaroos) in the church and public and always endeavor, through conduct, appearance and attitude, to create the proper image of Royal Ranger's leadership. When on an outing with the boys or at a District, Divisional, or Sectional Straight Arrow and Buckaroo Activity, you shall wear your Outpost Uniform, Cowboy or Indian.
6. The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall be a member of the Sectional Council, and shall make an effort to attend all said meetings.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator has authority only as given him by his Sectional Commander within his Section.

RELATIONSHIP TO SECTIONAL, DISTRICT AND OTHER COMMANDERS

The Sectional Adjutant--Straight Arrow & Buckaroo Coordinator shall endeavor to uplift the position of the Sectional, Deputy District

Commander of Straight Arrows & Buckaroos, and the District Commander at all times, and shall endeavor to maintain a harmonious working relationship with all Area, Sectional, & Divisional Commanders, the SA/B Auxiliary Executive Staff and between all Sectional Executive Committee and Council members.
