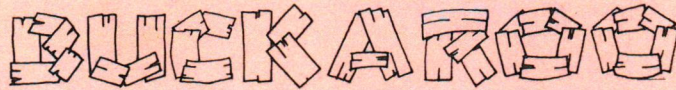

HANDWORK PACKET

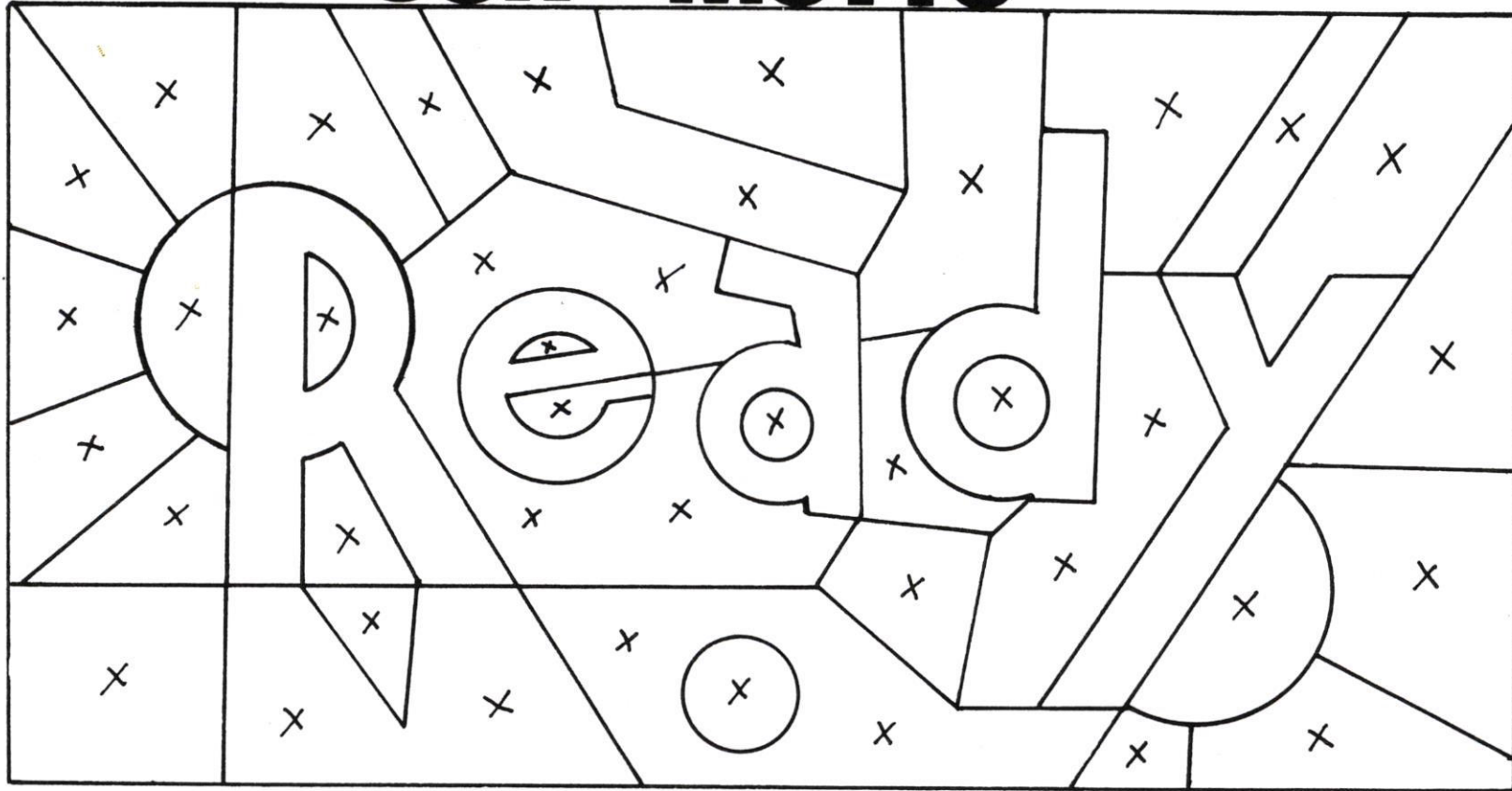

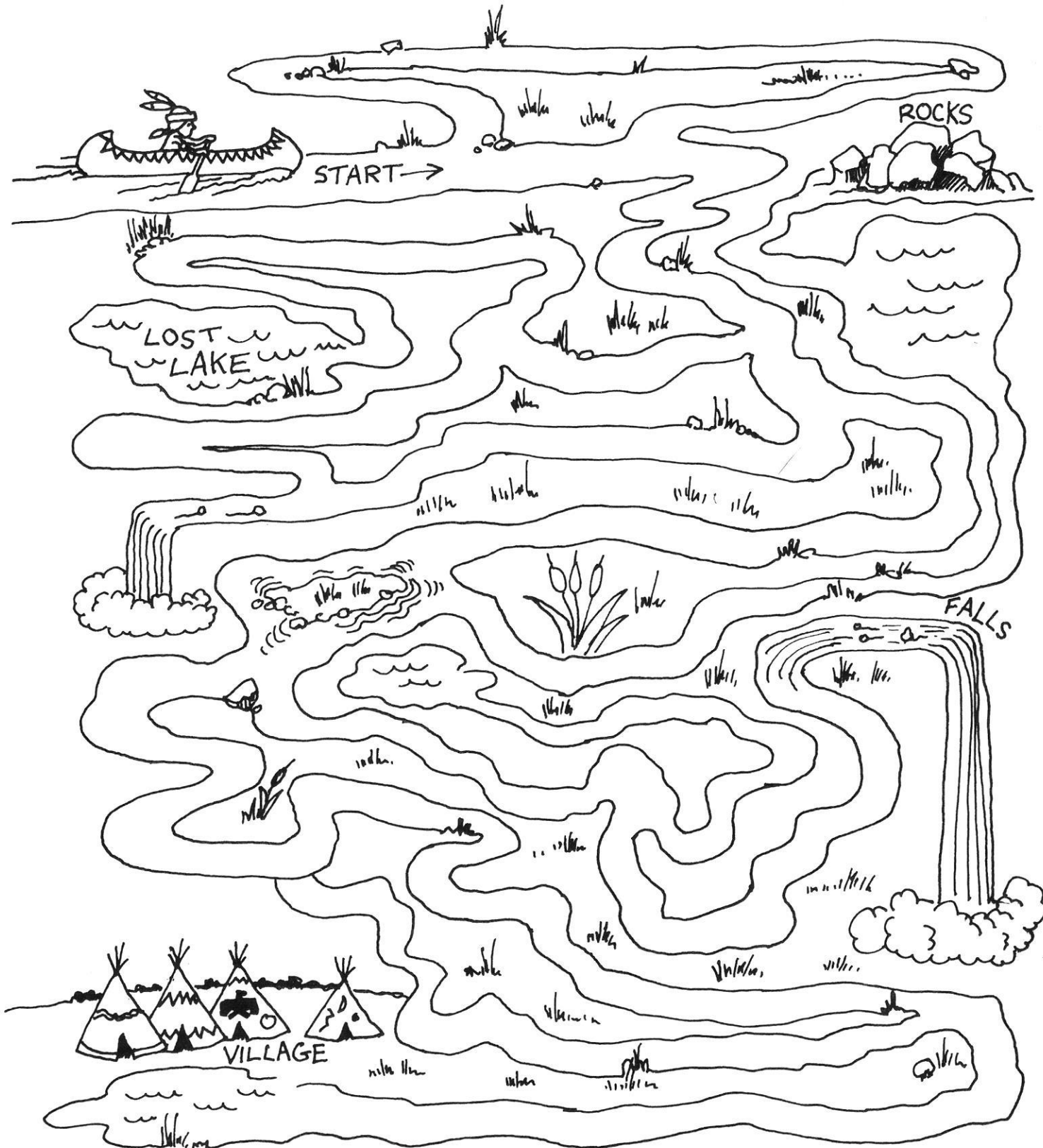

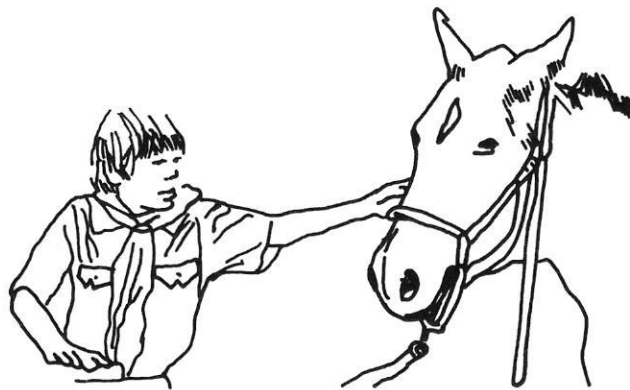

THE ROYAL RANGER CODE

THE RED POINTS

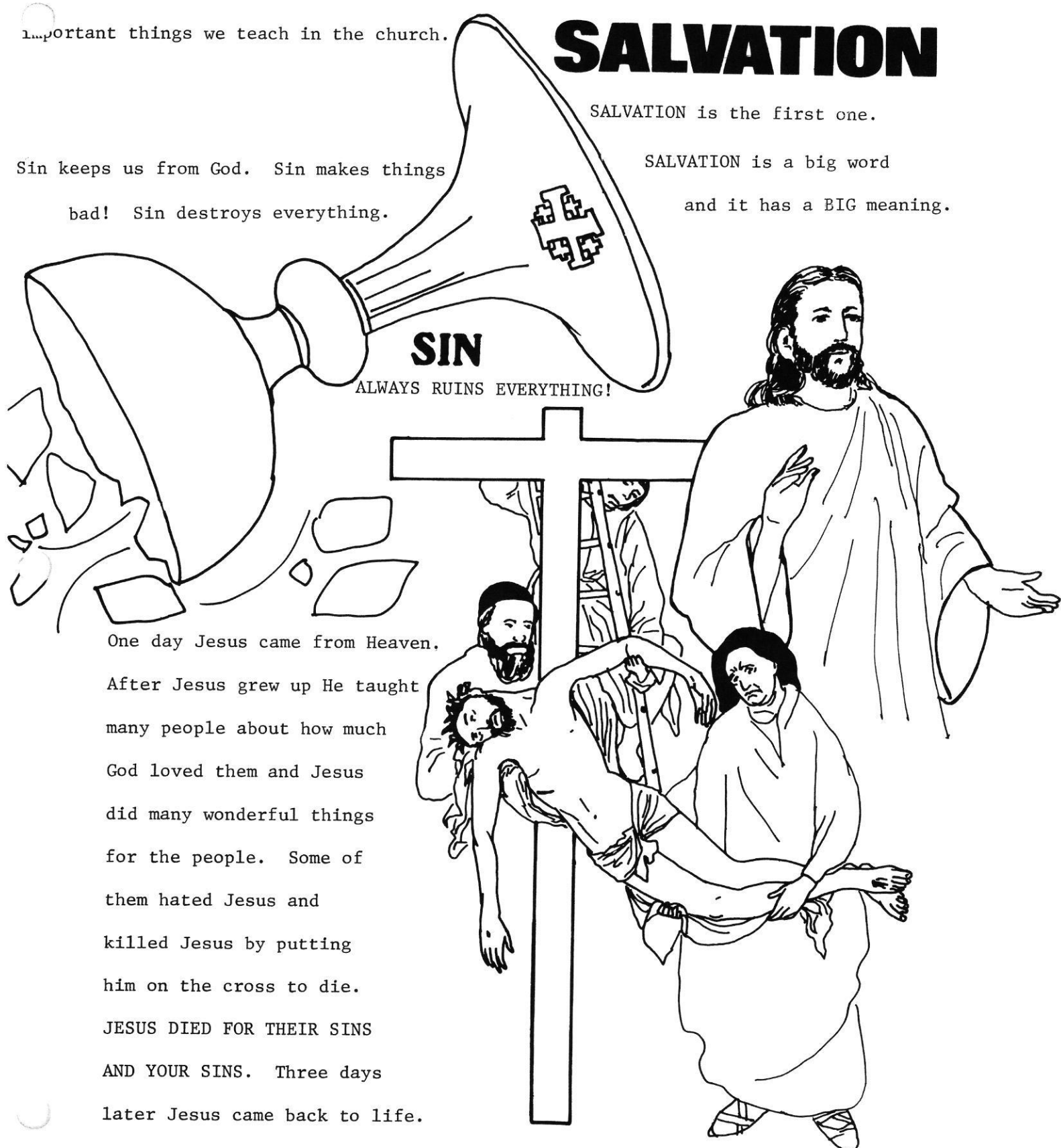
The 4 RED POINTS of the Royal Rangers Emblem remind us of the 4 most important things we teach in the church.

SALVATION

SALVATION is the first one.

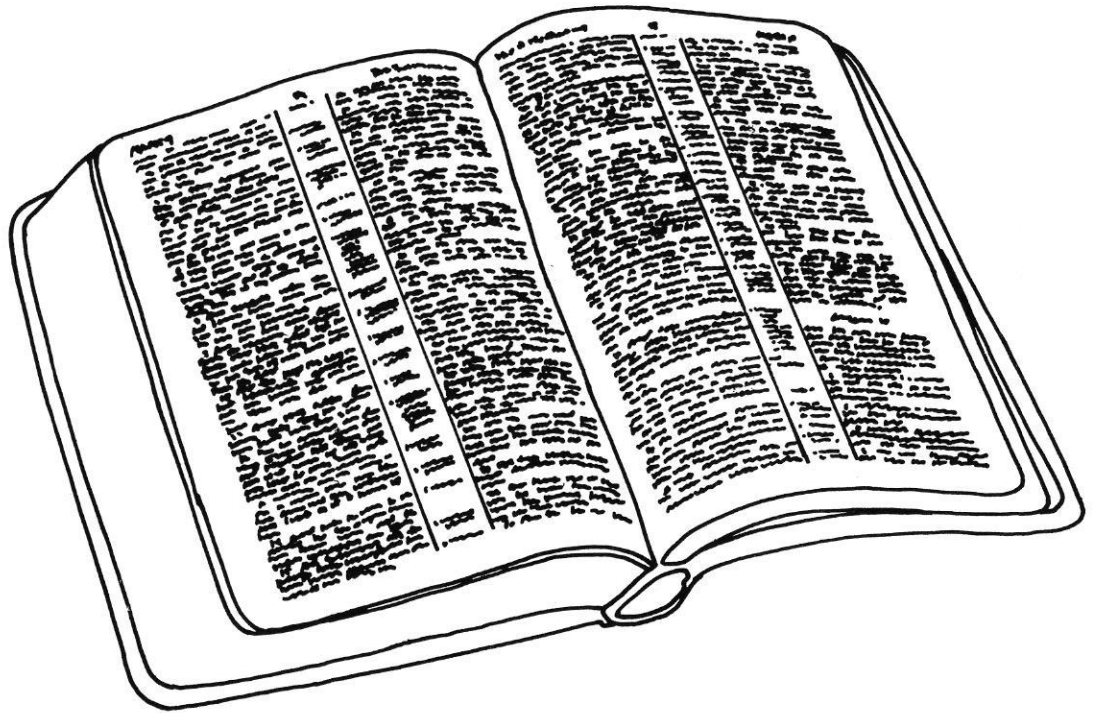
Sin keeps us from God. Sin makes things bad! Sin destroys everything.

SALVATION is a big word and it has a BIG meaning.



One day Jesus came from Heaven. After Jesus grew up He taught many people about how much God loved them and Jesus did many wonderful things for the people. Some of them hated Jesus and killed Jesus by putting him on the cross to die. JESUS DIED FOR THEIR SINS AND YOUR SINS. Three days later Jesus came back to life.

The Bible tells us WE all are sinners! It tells us that if we ask Jesus to come into our hearts and we learn to do what Jesus wants us to, Jesus is our Saviour!



Jesus will give you SALVATION and make you the best Buckaroo and help you to live just like Jesus wants you to live.

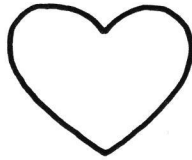

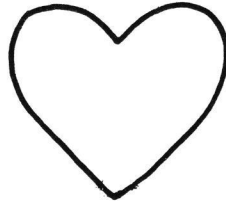
COLOR THE HEARTS

When you have done things that you know are wrong we call it SIN.

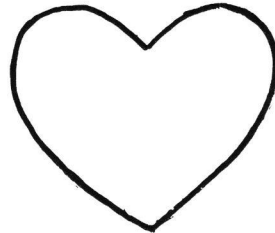
Sin makes everyone unhappy. Color this heart BLACK for sin.



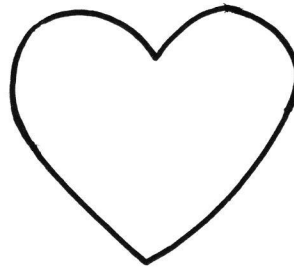
Jesus died on the cross for our sins. The Bible tells us that the blood of Jesus cleans our hearts from sin. Color this heart RED.



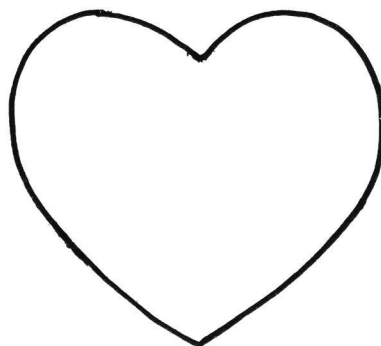
When our hearts are clean from sins what color are they? Red, black or white?

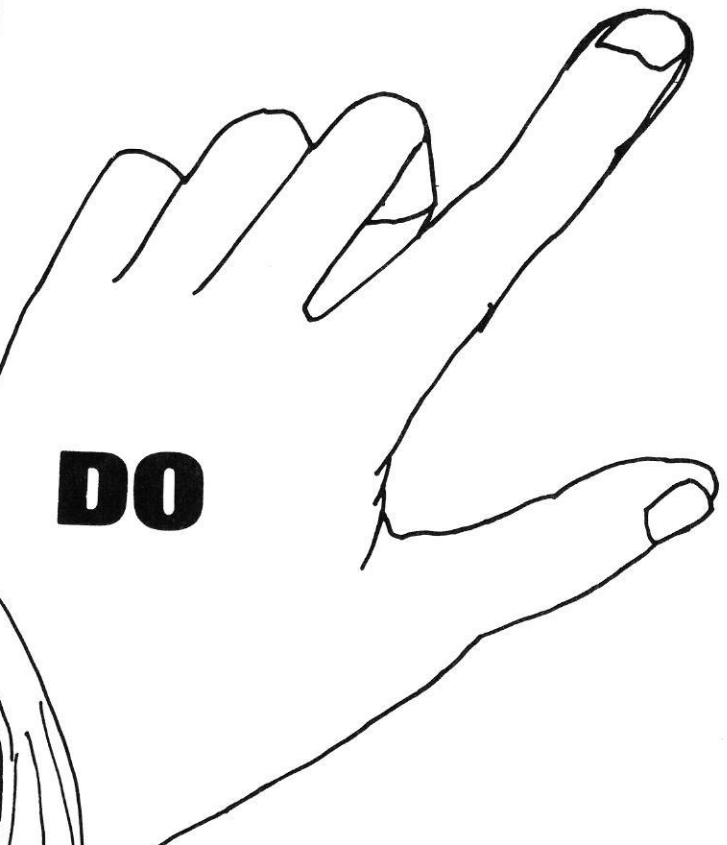

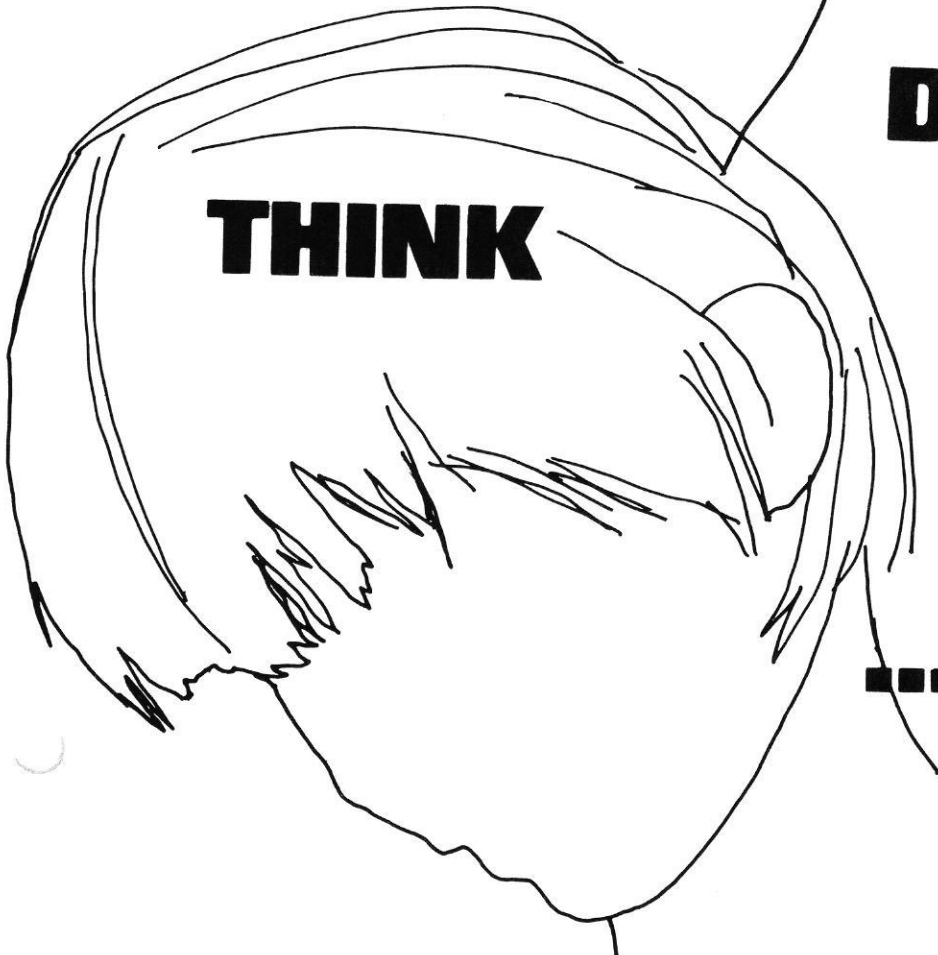

DIVINE HEALING

We invite others to church, Sunday school and Royal Rangers.

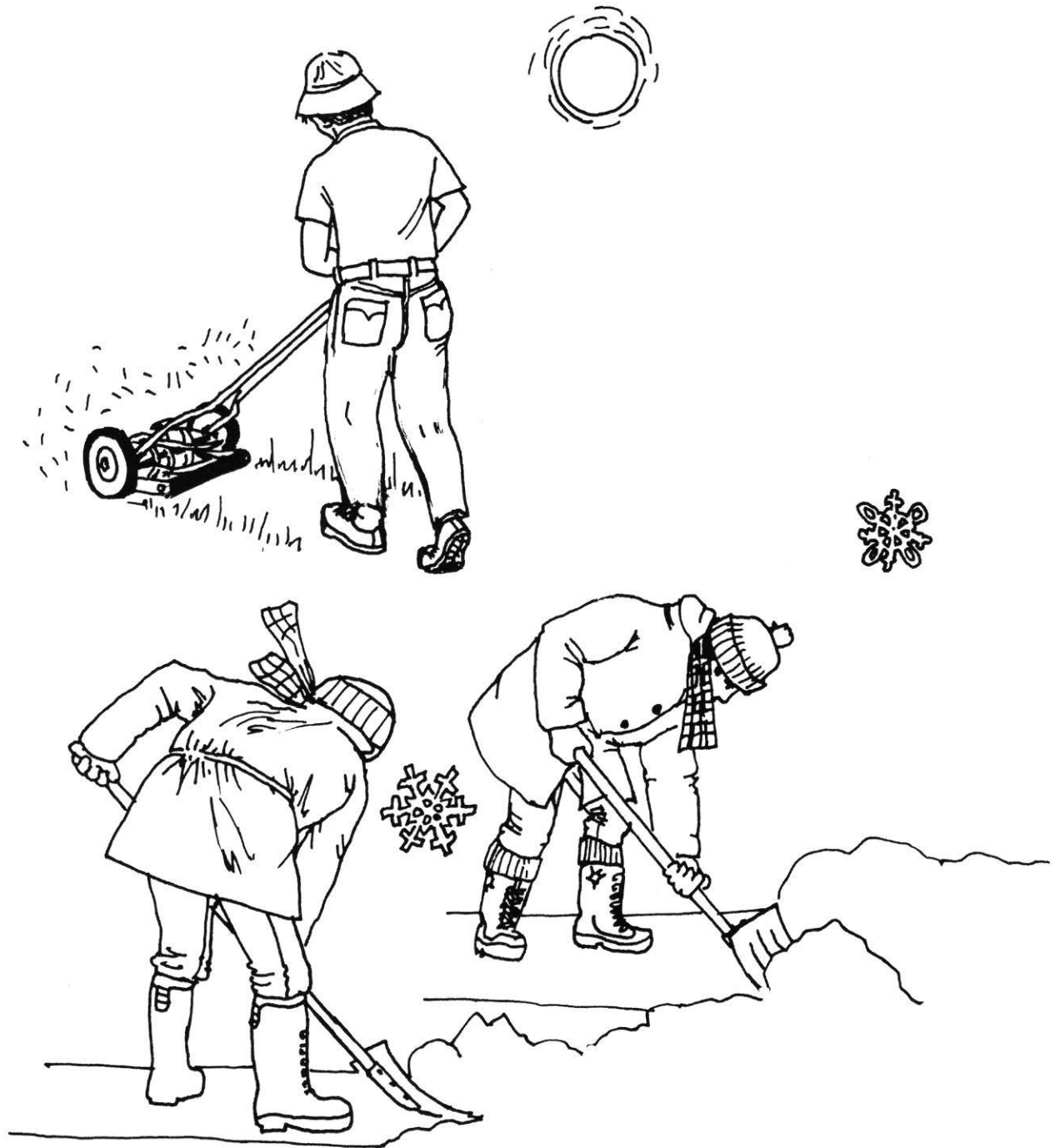
