SPEAKER BIOS

Our keynote speaker is Gregory L. Jantz, PhD, a licensed mental health counselor with a doctorate in counseling psychology. He is an acclaimed speaker and trusted author of twenty-one books, including *Raising Boys by Design*. With thirty years of studying and treating developmental behavior in children and young adults, Dr. Jantz's presentation combines unique insight and uncanny revelations that dramatically affect and improve relationships and lives.

Dr. George O. Wood is general superintendent of the Assemblies of God, USA, part of the largest Pentecostal denomination in the world. Wood was raised in a missionary family in China and Tibet. He holds a doctoral degree in pastoral theology from Fuller Theological Seminary and a juris doctorate from Western State University College of Law. He has also served as a senior pastor and authored several books. Wood will share about building healthy churches that influence healthy families to raise healthy sons.



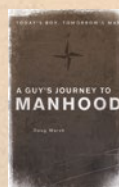
