*\*Target Group refers to the age group for which each level is targeted. This is the level at which each age group would most appropriately represent the Patrol System. Age groups should make it their goal to obtain the patrol system level appropriate for their group. However, it is understood that groups still in development may temporarily operate at a lower level until their target level can be attained. More experienced groups may operate the patrol system at a level higher than their target level but this is not expected. Groups will not be considered "inadequate" for not operating the patrol system above their target level.*
