SUBJECT: ROYAL RANGER BIBLE STUDY COURSES.

- (1) How to start your Ranger Bible Study Courses.
- (2) How to counsel with Rangers upon completion of courses.
- (3) How to grade Bible Study Courses.

I. HOW TO START THE ROYAL RANGER BIBLE STUDY COURSES IN YOUR OUTPOST.

- A. Have copies of the lessons run off by Ditto or Mimeo reproductions.
- B. Make extra copies to allow supply for new Rangers as they join.
- C. Each Commander must complete the courses in advance. There are no answer sheets.
- D. Explain the Bible Study Course program to your outpost. Be enthused yourself.
- E. Hand out Course I to everyone in the outpost. Explain to them that they should take it home and work on it in a room by themselves. Be sure to impress upon them that it is to be completed in one sitting. (If a boy takes more than one night to complete Course I the Holy Spirit will have a very difficult time convicting his heart.) Young Pioneers may have to get help from Mom or Dad. Unsaved parents could be led to Jesus by helping their boys with this lesson.
- F. Have boys return Course the very next meeting. Give recognition to those returning lessons each week. Keep interest high by making weekly reports to the outpost on those doing good work.
- G. Hand out Course Number II just before boys leave for home from the meeting. This keeps the lesson from getting lost, torn or wrinkled. Repeat each week.

2. HOW TO COUNSEL WITH RANGERS UPON COMPLETION OF COURSES.

- A. Request that all study courses be turned in when boys first arrive at meetings.
- B. One by one call boys into private room for personal counsel pertaining to the completed course. (This would only have to be done once and should be the first week (meeting) after they have completed Course Number I.)
- C. Review and discussion of other courses can be held on an outpost basis with a short period for questions and answers.
- D. Before interviewing and counselling with boy, check his lesson (Course I) and see if he has accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior. If he has, again go over the lesson and make sure he has understood everything answered. If he did not accept Christ then this will provide you with the opportunity of going over the lesson, (in detail) and leading him to make the decision for Christ. (You should know these scriptures by heart.)

3. HOW TO GRADE THE ROYAL RANGER BIBLE STUDY COURSES.

- A. (All courses, regardless of the number of questions, can be graded as follows:)

<u>NUMBER WRONG</u>	<u>GRADE</u>	<u>NUMBER WRONG</u>	<u>GRADE</u>
0	A plus	5	B minus
1	A	6	C plus
2	A minus	7	C
3	B plus	8	C minus
4	B	9 or more	PASSING

- B. Record boys grades in RANGER OUTPOST RECORD BOOK and return lessons to boys.
