

COMMEMORATIVE DISTRICT PATCH SERIES

PATCH DESIGN

Each district will be given the opportunity to submit the suggested design for it's District's Commemorative patch.

It will be understood that the submission is "suggested" and not guaranteed. The design may be slightly altered by the National Patch Review Committee. However, the original design will as true as possible to the original submission.

Districts may choose any method they desire----some suggestions are:

1. A contest for boys only
2. A contest for men or boys
3. A contest for anyone in the district to enter
4. Design by district staff
5. District Commander's wife (who just happens to be good at drawing designs?)

Final submission of suggested patch design MUST ARRIVE by the deadline date. It must be sent with a letter or other "certification" from the District Commander or designated District Staff Officer. Patch designs will not be accepted from a district "at random". The design must be approved by the District Commander or District Staff for submission.

If the suggested patch design does NOT arrive by the deadline date, a patch will be designed by the National Patch Review Committee. Time is of the absolute essence--districts can NOT be late. It is recommended that the design be chosen and submitted IN ADVANCE of the deadline date to the maximum extent possible.

MINIMUM SIZE: 2½ inches across in any direction

MAXIMUM SIZE: 3½ inches across in any direction

RECOMMENDED: stay with what is referred to as a 3" patch size.

COLORS: Maximum of 4 embroidery colors PLUS border color PLUS background color

OUTLINE/SHAPE: Please attempt to stay away from difficult shapes & outlines.

MANUFACTURER: District will NOT have any input into the ordering and/or manufacturing. This is only for suggested design submission.

Each patch must have the designation: NRRTC and at a minimum an "RR" on it. (No dates)

MONTHLY ISSUE ORDERS

The individual issue of each District Commemorative patch will be limited to the number of orders received by the deadline date cutoff.

(NOTE: This includes those orders received as "pre-issue orders".)

COST: \$ 6.00 each (includes all postage & handling)

Orders must be RECEIVED no later than the cut-off deadline. Any order received after the cut-off date for a particular patch will be returned.

Districts are encouraged to utilize the issue of "their" patch in some special way--such as a special award for all those registering on time, attending a special function, etc.

It is recommended that Districts should order a sufficient number of "extra" patches for their district to use in the next few years as special gifts, prizes, or whatever. It is anticipated that these will become "instant" collector's items, valuable for trading, selling, or gift-giving.

COMMEMORATIVE DISTRICT PATCH SERIES

"PRE-ISSUE ORDERS"

There will be a special limited-edition of "pre-issue orders".

These orders will have prepared a special certificate, numbered, designating the set as such. The certificate will not be sent until the set has been completed and all patches issued. The number of sets receiveing the official, numbered certificate will be limited to the number of subscriptions received during the time period allotted.

ORDER PERIOD: April thru September 1988

FINAL CUT-OFF DATE: September 30, 1988

TOTAL COST: \$ 270.00 (for 54 patches & certificate, including postage and hadling)

- PAYMENT OPTIONS:
1. Cash with order
 2. \$90 with order
\$90 in 60 days
\$90 by 120 days (total to be paid NLT 9/30/88)
 3. \$90 with order
\$100 NLT 9/30/88
\$100 NLT 12/31/88 (total of \$290 must be paid prior to issue of first patch)

If any payments are received after the 12/31/88 deadline, the order will be voided as a "Pre-Issue Numbered Set" and all monies will be applied to the monthly patch ordering, one each, at the monthly prevailing rate, until such monies have been depleted.
