



#### SIGNIFICANCE OF EMBLEM


Four Gold Points - Four phases of a boy's development Physical, Spiritual, Mental, Social

Alert, Clean, Honest, Courageous, Loyal, Courteous, Obedient, Spiritual







live, etc.


