AWARDS SYSTEM

Because of the unavailability of the awards mentioned in the Chi Omega Rho handbook at this time, these different colored belts will be used with the member's medieval outfit.

Knight Esquire

When a person achieves membership, he/she can wear a brown belt with his/her Chi Omega Rho outfit.

Knight Bachelor

When a member completes the requirements of this step, he/she may wear a red belt with his/her Chi Omega Rho outfit.

Knight Baronet

When a member completes the requirements of this step, he/she may wear a white belt with his/her Chi Omega Rho outfit.


Design of the Belts

The belts can be made of leather or a heavy cloth. It is to be 2" wide and as long as needed to go arouns the member's waist with a 15" tail after tied on. There is to be no tooling on the leather belt or decoration on the cloth. The knight's name can be written on the inside of the belt. The belt is worn around the waist with the knot on the upper right thigh off-centered. The belt can be used to carry different items that the knight may carry such as his personal dagger, money pouch, etc.



NEWSLETTER

A newsletter can be utilized to unify the Chi Omega Rho group at your college. It can be 1 page long or like the one below, 10 pages long or more. With one page newsletters, all information for the group should be on it. It can be put out once a week easily. With a larger newsletter, important information should be included plus stories, poems, helpful Ranger hints, cartoons, etc. can be included. This type of newsletter might get out once a month. Always include dates and official national, district, and sectional information in either type of newsletter.



The Chapter's Scribe (secretary) should be responsible for getting the newsletter out. A person could be specifically assigned this task. A newsletter will give the group a chance to express themselves and have alot of fun at the same time. Newsletters can be sold to persons outside of Chi Omega Rho to help keep the public informed about what your group is doing and other activities.
