WHITE (CLEAN)

reminds us that our hearts can be made clean and pure if we believe Jesus died for us and receive Him as our own personal Savior.



The Bible tells us that when we receive Jesus by believing in Him, we are born into God's family and become His child. And because our sins have all been paid for, we can know that we will go to God's wonderful Heaven and live with Him forever!

— John 1:12, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 John 5:13

You can receive the Lord Jesus as your Savior right now! Pray a prayer like this, and if you really mean it, you can be forgiven of all of your sins right now.

"Dear God, thank you for loving me. I admit that I have sinned and broken your law. I now ask you, Lord Jesus, to come into my life and forgive me of my sins and be my Lord and Savior. Thank you for making me a child of God and help me to be a good and obedient child and always try to please and honor him. In Jesus name I pray, Amen."


