# Royal Rangers PREMIER ADVANCEMENT SYSTEM

### The advancement structure is a merit-based system.

The **Ranger Kids** will advance along trails to greater excitement and knowledge. They will have the opportunity to earn additional achievement badges, which now number fifty-one.

The merit patches for older boys feature colored edges for age distinction. **Discovery Rangers** use red, blue and orange colored merits; **Adventure Rangers** use gold, green, and brown merits; **Expedition Rangers** use silver merits and Spirit Challenge lessons for advancements. Bible merits are study lessons designed to teach the books of the Bible. Boys will be challenged to love the Word of God and learn the reality of its power and application. Studying the Bible will become a joy instead of a chore for earning merits.

Every merit has been reviewed in detail. Individual merit requirements have been updated, repetitive requirements in multiple merits have been eliminated, and new areas of emphasis have been added to several merits. For example, the requirements for the Bachelor merit have been updated to include budget development and money management.

So, what's new for Rangers? A new excitement, an enhanced challenge, a modernized and updated merit system, and a flexible program with lots of options awaiting every church.


# LEADERSHIP TRAINING

The training and retention of leaders is the most vital key to the foundation of Royal Rangers. The key will provide a training opportunity available for all commanders interested in helping at the local outpost. Ranger Basics is an eight-hour course that can be taken as a 1 or 2-day course, or through correspondence and internet study. Comprehensive handbooks will be used at all the training camps and events. The LMA, Leaders Medal of Achievement, maintains the tradition of thorough

instruction and can be earned after 20 hours of specific-age group training. The national camps will continue to provide hands-on activity based training for all com-

in a variety of settings and formats. The men will be encouraged to attend the challenging NTC. It will be a required camp for those who wish to learn advanced skills in winter camping (WNTC),

hiking (NTT), water sports (NCE), and camping (ANTC).






The National Academy will prepare leaders to be instructors for the national camps, NTC, ANTC, WNTC, NTT, and NCE. The Advanced Academy will prepare men to run national camps in the roles of Senior Guide and Camp Commander. Academy Instructor is the designation given to specific trainers certified to teach at the National Academy and Advanced Academy.


