Over the last several years, the National FCF Action team has been looking at the FCF reporting system. Approximately 12 years ago the star rating system was instituted. While our main goal is not numbers, the number of those who are ministered to is important. The best way the FCF has to measure the numbers is that star rating system. It is our goal that as we gather the numbers from the chapters this will be the most accurate way to measure the success and growth of each chapter. When the star rating was instituted, it was determined that earning a 5 star would be a great and significant effort. Over the years a chapter may earn a 5 star rating while doing well in but a couple of the 10 categories. A successful chapter should be a well -rounded chapter. Therefore the reporting process will be changing. The chapters will be evaluated in much the same process and the star rating will remain in place. Please get familiar with the attached form. The attached form will provide you information on the new reporting criteria and the adjusted scoring.

Over the next month you will receive information about a number of different document formats and methods in which you will be able to complete the Chapter President's report.
